**भर्तुमेष्ट** often shortened into **मेष्ट** a poet who lived under Mātṛigupta. Rājat. 3, 260—62. He is mentioned by Mañkha in Črikanṭhacarita 2, 53, by Kshemendra in Suvṛittatilaka 3, 16. Cp. p. 59. 74. 77. Skm. Sbhv.
