(-णं) gentle heat. -जीत्तुरुक्तव a. slackened in eagerness, cast down, disinclined ; मंदैत्तुरुक्तोऽस्म नारायनं प्रति S. 1.

-कर्ण a. slightly deaf ; (Proverb:— बनिराजन्दकर्णे अप्यन् 'something is better than nothing'). -कांतिः the moon. -करितु a. acting slowly or foolishly -गः Saturn. -गति, -गप्ति a. walking slowly, slow of pace. -चैतस् a. 1. dull-witted, silly, foolish. -2 absent-minded. -3 fainting away, scarcely conscious. -छाय a. dim, faint, lustreless. -रः 1 N. of a mountain (used by the gods and demons as a churning-stick when they churned the ocean for nectar) ; पृष्ठैर्मिद्दोद्धौः क्षोरोर्मय इवाच्युतं R. 4. 27 ; अभिराजनसुरर षृग्मार्द गृ Git. 1. शोभेत् मंदरक्षव्यभूमेतांविष्फर्ना Si. 2. 107 ; Ki. 5. 30. -2 A necklace of pearls (of 8 or 16 strings). -3 Heaven. -4 A mirror. -5 One of the five trees in Indra's paradise ; see मंदर. -रं ind.
