

**अकृत** *a.* [ कृ-कर्मणि क्तः, न. त. ] 1 Not done, undone, unperformed; सर्वान् बलकृतानर्थानकृतान् मनुरब्रवीत् Ms. 8. 168; कृतं चाप्यकृतं भवेत् 8. 117. -2 Wrongly or differently done; कृताकृतावेक्षणादौ ब्रह्मा ऋषिष्व नियुज्यते इति याज्ञिकाः. -3 Incomplete, not ready (as food); अकृतं च कृताक्षेत्रात् (अदोषवत्) Ms. 10. 114. not cultivated (अनुत्पश्यम् Kull.); कृतानं चाकृतानेन (निर्मातव्यम्) 10.94 (सिद्धानं चामात्रेण Kull.). -4 Uncreated. -5 One who has done no work. -6 Not developed or perfected, unripe, immature. -**ता** One not legally regarded as a daughter and placed on a level with sons, (पुत्रिकात्वेन अकल्पिता); अकृता वा कृता वापि यं विन्देत्सदृशात्सुतम् Ms. 9. 136; according to some, a daughter who is not by a formal declaration but only mentally appointed to supply an heir for her father (अभिसंधिमात्रकृता वागव्यवहारेण कृता; कृता = यदपत्यं भवेदस्यां तन्मम स्यात्स्वधाकरम् इत्यभिधाय कन्यादानकाले वराणुमत्या या क्रियते Kull.). -**तम्** An unperformed act; non-performance of an act; an unheard-of deed; अकृतं वै प्रजापतिः करोति Ait. Br. -**Comp.**-**अर्थे** *a.* unsuccessful. -**अस्त्र** *a.* unpractised in arms. -**आत्मन्** *a.* 1 ignorant, foolish, having an uncontrolled mind. -2 not identified with Brahma or the Supreme Spirit. -**उद्वाह** *a.* unmarried. -**एनस्** *a.* not sinful or guilty, innocent. -**कारम्** *adv.* as has not been done before; <sup>०</sup>रं करोति Kās. III. 4. 36. -**ज्ञ** *a.* ungrateful. -**धी-****बुद्धि** *a.* ignorant; पश्यत्यकृतबुद्धित्वान्न स पश्यति दुर्मतिः Bg. 18. 16 through unrefined understanding. -**व्रणः** -1 N. of a commentator on the Purāṇas; V. P.; of a companion of Rāma Jāmadagnya; Mb. -2 not wounded.

**अकृतिन्** *a.* [ न. त. ] Not skillful or clever, clumsy, awkward; unfit for doing anything.

**अकृत्य** *a.* Unfit to be done. -**त्यम्** 1 A crime, an improper act. -2 That which cannot be done; न हि वचनस्य किञ्चिदकृत्यमस्ति ŚB. on MS. 6. 1. 44.

**अकृत्त** *a.* [ न. त. ] Uncut, undiminished or unimpaired; <sup>०</sup>रुच्यं of unimpaired splendour.

**अकृत्रिम** *a.* [ न. त. ] 1 Natural, not man-made. -2 Spontaneous. -3 Valid, true.

**अकृत्वा** *ind.* Without doing; अकृत्वा परसंतापमगत्वा खलनम्रताम् | Udbhāṭa.

**अकृप** *a.* [ न. ब. ] Pitiless, cruel.

**अकृपण** *a.* [ न. त. ] Not wretched, not miserly.

**अकृश** *a.* [ न. त. ] Not slender or weak, full, entire, strong. -**Comp.**-**अश्वः** N. of a king of Ayodhyā. -**लक्ष्मी** *a.* endowed with full prosperity. -**क्ष्मीः** great splendour or property; अकृशमकृशलक्ष्मीश्वेतसा शंसितं सः Ki. 5. 52.

**अकृष्ट** *a.* [ न. त. ] Not tilled; not drawn. -**Comp.**-**पच्य** *a.* [ अकृष्टे क्षेत्रे पच्यते ] growing or ripening in unploughed land, growing exuberant or wild; <sup>०</sup>च्या इव सस्यसंपदः Ki. 1. 17; so <sup>०</sup>च्या ओषधयः; <sup>०</sup>च्यम् अशनं धान्यम्, &c. -**पच्या** (applied especially to) the earth yielding food grains, fruit etc. without being tilled; very fertile; अकृष्टपच्या पृथिवी विबभौ चैत्यमालिनी Mb. Crit. Ed. 12. 29. 21; 12. 216. 16. -**रोहिन्** = <sup>०</sup>पच्य; बीजं च बाल्यमकृष्टरोहि R. 14. 77.

**अकृष्ण** *a.* [ न. त. ] Not black, white, pure. -**ष्णः**

[ नास्ति कृष्णं मले यस्य ] 1 The spotless moon; चन्द्रमा वै ब्रह्मा <sup>०</sup>कृष्णः इति श्रुतिः -2 Camphor. -**Comp.** -**कर्मन्** *a.* virtuous, free from black deeds, innocent.

**अकेतु** *a.* [ नास्ति केतुश्चिह्नं यस्य ] Unconscious (अज्ञान); केतुं कृष्वन्नकेतवे Rv. 1. 6. 3. (अज्ञानाय); shapeless (?)

**अकेश** *a.* [ अविद्यमानाः अल्पाः अप्रशस्ता वा केशा यस्य ] Hairless, bald; having very few or very bad hair.

**अकोटः** [ न कुटति वक्रीभवति स्कन्धादिषु ] The betel-nut palm, Areca (Mar. -सुपारी) (without a कोट or bend, as it grows with a straight stem).

**अकः** A corner of a house; अके चेन्मधु विन्देत किमर्थं पर्वतं व्रजेत् |

**अक्का** [ अक्-क, अच्यते इत्यक्, अञ् क्विप् गतिः तस्यै कायति, कै-क वा Tv. ] A mother. (Voc. अक).

**अक्त** See under अञ्.

**अक्ता** *f.* (Ved.) Night; कृष्णेभिरक्षोषाः Rv. 1. 62. 8.

**अक्तु** *m. f.* (Ved.) [ अञ् गतौ-क्तु ] 1 Night; darkness, gloom. -2 Light, ray. -3 Ointment.

**अक्त्रम्** [ अञ्-बा० कत्र ] An armour (वर्मेन्).

**अक्र** *a.* (Ved.) [ अञ् गतौ-रक् ] 1 Inactive, steady, firm (स्थिर). -2 Bootless, profitless. -**क्रः** A fortification or rampart (प्राकार); banner (?); Nir. 6. 17.

**अक्रतु** *a.* [ नास्ति क्रतुर्यस्य ] 1 Without sacrifices. -2 Devoid of energy, powerless; unwise. -3 Devoid of will or volition (संकल्परहित), epithet of God.

**अक्रम** *a.* [ नास्ति क्रमः पादः क्रमणं वा यस्य ] 1 Devoid of order, confused. -2 Without the power of going or moving (पादशून्य, आक्रमणशून्य). -**मः** 1 Want of order, confusion, irregularity (क्रमाभावः); एहोहि पुत्र, अयमक्रमः Pañc. 1. -2 Absence of motion or movement. -3 Breach of propriety or decorum; कमकमं कर्तुमभूदपेक्षा वैलक्ष्यभाजां न महीपतीनाम् Vikr. 10. 3; कन्यान्तःपुरमक्रमात् प्रविशता Mv. 2. 50 indecently, immodestly; बलीमुखचक्रमक्रममुच्चलितं Mv. 6. in disorder. -4 N. of a concept in Kashmir Śaivism.

**अक्रान्त** *a.* [ न. त. ] Unsurpassed; unconquered. -**ता** [ न क्रम्यते कष्टकावृत्तत्वात् क्रम-क्त, न. त. ] The egg plant (बृहती), Solanum Melongena (Mar. डोरलें वांगें).

**अक्रिय** *a.* [ नास्ति क्रिया यस्य न. ब. ] 1 Inactive, dull, torpid. -2 Without essential works. -3 Abstaining from religious rites. -4 Without action of any kind, epithet of God. -5 Worthless, good-for-nothing. -**या** [ न. त. ] Inactivity; neglect of duty; प्रधानस्याक्रिया यत्र साङ्गं तत्क्रियते पुनः । तदङ्गस्याक्रियायां तु नावृत्तिर्न च तत्क्रिया ॥

**अकूर** *a.* [ न. त. ] Not cruel. -**रः** N. of a Yādava, a friend and uncle of Kṛiṣṇa. [ It was he who induced Balarāma and Kṛiṣṇa to go to Mathurā and kill Kāṁsa. He told the two brothers how their father Ānaka-<sup>०</sup>duḍbhi, the princess Devakī and even his own father Ugrasena had been insulted by the iniquitous demon Kāṁsa, and told them why he had been despatched to them. Kṛiṣṇa consented to go and promised to slay the demon within 3 nights, which he succeeded in doing. ]
