

**औपाध्यायक** *a.* (-की *f.*) [ उपाध्याय-बुञ् P. IV. 3. 77 ]  
Coming or obtained from a teacher.

**औपानह्य** *a.* [ उपाहन-ह्य ] 1 Used for making shoes.  
-2 To be tied or bound on (as leather &c.).

**औपायिक** = औपयिक *q. v.*

**औपासन** *a.* (-नी *f.*) [ उपासन-अण् ] 1 Relating to गृह्याग्नि or household fire. -2 Belonging to worship or service; holy, sacred. -**नः** 1 A fire used for domestic worship. -2 A small rice-ball (पिण्ड) offered to the manes.

**औपेन्द्र** *a.* Belonging to Upendra; नरेन्द्रैरौपेन्द्रं वपुरथ विशदाम वीक्षांभूवे Śi. 20. 79.

**औम्** *ind.* The sacred syllable of the Śūdras (for औम् which is forbidden to be uttered by them).

**औम** *a.* Relating to the goddess Umā.

**औम, औमिक, औमक** (-मी, -की *f.*) [ उमा-अण्-बुञ् वा ]  
Flaxen.

**औमीनम्** (-यम्) [ उमानां क्षेत्रं खञ् ] A field of flax.

**औरग** *a.* (-गी *f.*) [ उरग-अण् ] Serpentine, relating to a serpent. -**गम्** The constellation आश्लेषा.

**औरभ्र** *a.* (-भ्री *f.*) [ उरभ्र-अण् ] Belonging to or produced from a ram; Ms. 3. 268. -**भ्रम्** 1 Mutton; औरभ्रसुत्तरायोगे यस्तु मांसं प्रयच्छति Mb. 13. 64. 32. -2 Woollen cloth, coarse woollen blanket ( <sup>भ्रः</sup> also ).

**औरभ्रकम्** [ उरभ्राणां समूहः बुञ् ] A flock of sheep, *a.* free from a wolf (in the midst of) a flock of sheep (?) Kau. A 1. 17.

**औरभ्रिक** *a.* [ उरभ्र-ठञ् ] (-की *f.*) Belonging to sheep. -**कः** A shepherd; Ms. 3. 166.

**औरस** *a.* (-सी *f.*) [ उरसा निर्मितः अण् ] 1 Produced from the breast, born of oneself, legitimate; Ś. 7; V. 5; इत्थं नागस्त्रिभुवनपुरोरौरसं मैथिलियम् R. 16. 88. -2 Physical, bodily; विद्याबलमुपाश्रित्य न ह्यस्त्यस्यौरसं बलम् Mb. 3. 11. 31. -3 Natural; निदर्शयन् वै सुमहच्छिञ्चौरसकृतं बलम् Mb. 7. 37. 20. -4 Manly, virile; Mb. 12. 65. 5. -**सः**, -**सी** A legitimate son or daughter; औरसो धर्मपत्नीजस्तत्समः पुत्रिकासुतः Y. 2. 128.

**औरस्क** *a.* Excellent, distinguished.

**औरस्य** = औरस *q. v.*

**और्जित्यम्** [ ऊर्जित-घ्यञ् ] Greatness; कैलासोद्धारसार-त्रिभुवनीव्रजयौर्जित्यनिष्णातदोषः Mv. 2. 16.

**और्ण, और्णक, और्णिक** *a.* (-र्णी, -की *f.*) [ ऊर्णा-अण्, बुञ् वा ] Woollen. राङ्गवाणि तथौर्णानि..... । Śiva. B. 30. 21. -**Comp.** -**स्थानिकः** An officer in charge of woollen articles; EI, XXIII, P. 159.

**और्ध्वकालिक** *a.* (-की *f.*) [ ऊर्ध्वकाल-ष्ठञ् ] Relating to subsequent or later time.

**और्ध्वदेहम्** [ ऊर्ध्वदेह-अण् ] A funeral ceremony; और्ध्वदेहनिमित्तार्थमवतीर्थोदकं नदीम् Rām. 2. 83. 24.

**और्ध्वदे (दे) हिक** *a.* (-की *f.*) [ ऊर्ध्वदेहाय साधु ठञ् P. IV. 3. 60 Vart. 1 ] 1 Relating to a deceased person, funeral, performed in honour of the dead (as a rite); <sup>०</sup>क्रिया obsequies, funeral rites; Pt. 1. -2 Pertaining to ब्रह्म; जनको जनदेवस्तु मिथिलायां जनाधिपः । और्ध्वदेहिकधर्माणा-मासीद्युक्तो विचिन्तने ॥ Mb. 12. 218. 3. -**कम्** Funeral rites, obsequies. भृत्यानामुपरोधेन यत्करोत्यौर्ध्वदेहिकम् Ms. 11. 10. -2 Requisite for future world (such as यज्ञ, दान); अधर्मा-पाजितैर्यैर्यः करोत्यौर्ध्वदेहिकम् Mb. 5. 39. 67.

**और्ध्वस्रो (श्रो) तसिकः** = शैवः, a Śaiva or an adherent of the sect.

**और्व** *a.* (-वी *f.*) [ ऊर्व-अण् ] 1 Relating to Aurva. -2 Produced from the thigh. -3 Relating to the earth. -**वः** 1 N. of a celebrated Rishi. [ He was a descendant of Bhrigu, (the son of Chyavana by his wife Āruṣī, and grandson of Bhrigu). The Mahābhārata relates that the sons of Kārtavīrya, with the desire of destroying the descendants of Bhrigu, killed even the children in the womb. One of the women of the family, in order to preserve her embryo, secreted it in her thigh ( *ūru* ), whence the child at its birth was called Aurva. Beholding him, the sons of Kārtavīrya were struck with blindness, and his wrath gave rise to a flame which threatened to consume the whole world, had he not, at the desire of his Pitris, the Bhārgavas, cast it into the ocean, where it remained concealed with the face of a horse; cf. Vāḍavāgni. Aurva was afterwards preceptor to king Sagara of Ayodhyā ]. ऊरोर्यथौर्वस्य पृथोश्च हस्तान् मान्धातुरिन्द्रप्रतिमस्य मूर्ध्नः Bu. Ch. 1. 29. -2 Submarine fire; त्वयि ज्वलत्यौर्व इवाम्बुराशौ Ś. 3. 3; Ve. 3. 7. so <sup>०</sup>अनलः -**वम्** Fossil salt.

**और्वर** *a.* Earthly; किमपैति रजोभिरौर्वरैरवकीर्णस्य मणेर-हार्धता Śi. 16. 27.

**औलानम्** 1 Support. -2 Reservoir of water.

**और्वशोयः** [ उर्वश्याः अपत्यं ठञ् ] N. of Agastya.

**औलूकम्** [ उलूकानां समूहः अञ् ] A collection of owls.

**औलूक्यः** [ उलूकस्यापत्यं, यञ् ] N. of Kaṇāda, the propounder of the Vaiśeṣika philosophy; (see औलूक्य-दर्शन in Sarva. S. ).

**औलूखल** *a.* (-ली *f.*) [ उलूखले क्षुण्णं अण् ] Coming from, pounded or ground in, a mortar; औलूखले यावकः Mbh. IV. 3. 25.

**औल्वपयम्** [ उल्वण-घ्यञ् ] Excess, superabundance, virulence.

**औवैणकम्** A kind of song; Y. 3. 113.
