2. **ऋज** *aja*. 1. m. A he-goat. 2. f. *jā*. A she-goat.—Comp. *Vana-*, m. a wild goat.—Cf. *alξ*, of which the base is *āγ+ι*.

**ऋजगर** *ajagara*, i.e. *aja-gṛi+a*, m. A large serpent, Boa constrictor.

**ऋजननि** *ajan+ani*, f. Privation of birth, used as imprecation, Pañch. i. d. 355.

**ऋजर्य** *a-jarya* (vb. *jri*), n. Friendship, Ragh. 18, 6.

**ऋजस्त्र** *ajas+ra*, adj., f. *râ*. Continual. acc. *ram*, adv. Continually, always, Man. 1, 57.

**ऋजात** *a-jāta* (vb. *jan*), adj., f. *tâ*. 1. Unborn. 2. As former part of comp. adj., Not having, e.g. *ajāta-vyañjana*, adj. beardless. *ajāta-çatru*. 1. Having no enemies. 2. One with whom nobody can contend; epithet and name of Yudhishthira and others.

**ऋजाविक** *ajāvika*, i.e. *aja-avi+ka*, n. sing. Goats and sheep, Man. 8, 235.

**ऋजिन** *ajina* (perhaps derived from 2 *aja*), n. The hide of any animal, particularly of the black antelope, used as a covering, Man. 2, 64, as purse, Daçak. 191, 16.—Comp. *Krishṇa-*, n. the hide of the black antelope.

**ऋजिर** *aj+ira*, n. A court, Pañch. 138, 1.—Comp. *Rāṇa-*, n. a field of battle.

**ऋजिह्वग** *a-jikma-ga*. I. adj. Advancing in a straight path, Man. 6, 31. II. m. An arrow.

**ऋजीगर्त** *ajigarta*, m. The name of a Rishi or saint, Man. 10, 105.

**ऋजीर्णिन्** *ajīrṇin*, i.e. *a-jirṇa+in* (vb. *jri*), adj. Suffering from indigestion.

**ऋज्जुका** *ajjukâ*, f. 1. A courtesan (Mṛichchh. 27, 2, Prâkṛ.; in the Ssk. translation *ajjû*). 2. (in Prâkṛ. *ajjû*, and in the Ssk. translation *ajjukâ*, Çâk. p. 105, 3.) A mother.

**ऋज्ञता** *a-jñā+tâ*, f. Ignorance.

**ऋज्मन्** *aj+man*, n. Battle, Chr. 297, 17 = Rigv. 1, 112, 17.—Cf. Lat. agmen; -*ayma* in *kárayma*, etc.

**ऋज्र** *aj+ra*, m. A field.—Cf. ἄγρος; Lat. ager; Goth. akrs; A.S. acer.

**ऋच्छ** *AÑCH* (cf. *añha*), i. 1, Par. Âtm. 1. To go. 2. To ask. 3. To speak indistinctly. 4. To bend, to curve, Nal. 12, 45. 5. To honour, Ragh. 9, 24. 6. i. 10 (rather Caus.). To make clear, to manifest, Gît. 10, 11.—With the prep. उद् *ud*, To rise, Râjat. 5, 362.

**ऋच्छन** *añch+ana*, n. Bending, curving.

**ऋच्छल** *añch+ala*, m. The end or border of a cloth.
