

काश्मय *kâṣa + maya*, adj., f. *yî*,
Made of Kâṣa-grass, Bhâg. P. 3, 22, 31.

काशि *kâṣi*, I. m. **1.** A proper name, Hariv. 1734. **2.** The king of Kâṣi, Chr. 19, 6. **3.** pl. The name of a people, MBh. 13, 1949. **II.** f. *ṣi* and *ṣî*. **1.** The name of Benares, Râm. 1, 12, 22. **2.** *ṣî*, A proper name, Hariv. 9204.

ऽकाशिन् *-kâṣ + in*, adj., f. *nî*, latter part of comp. adj. Shining like, e.g. *matta-*, Like one delighted, charming, Râm. 5, 18, 37. **2.** Shining on account of, e.g. *jaya-* and *jita-*, On account of victory, victorious, proud on account of triumphs, Bhâg. P. 4, 10, 15; Chr. 16, 12.—Cf. *hâsin*.

काशिष्णु *kâṣ + ishṇu*, adj. Resplendent, Bhâg. P. 4, 30, 6.

काशेय *kâṣeya*, i.e. *kâṣi + eya*, I. m. A son of Kâṣi, Hariv. 1734. **II.** f. *yî*, A daughter of Kâṣi, MBh. 1, 3785.

काश्मरी *kâṣmarî*, i.e. *kâṣ + man + î*, f. A plant, Gmelina arborea, Râm. 2, 94, 9.

काश्मर्य *kâṣmarya*, i.e. *kâṣ + man + ya*, m. A plant, Gmelina arborea, MBh. 13, 2773.

काश्मीर *kâṣmîra*, i.e. *kaṣmîra + a*, I. adj., f. *rî*. **1.** Trained in Cashmere, MBh. 4, 254 (a horse). **2.** An inhabitant of Cashmere, MBh. 3, 5032. **II.** m. **1.** A king of Cashmere, Mudrâr. 18, 17. **2.** Cashmere, Râm. 4, 43, 32. **III.** n. Saffron, Bhartṛ. 1, 48.

काश्मीरक *kâṣmîra + ka*, adj. Belonging to Cashmere, MBh. 2, 1025 (the inhabitants); 2, 1271 (the king).

काश्मीरिक *kâṣmîrika*, i.e. *kâṣmîra + ika*, adj. Referring to Cashmere, Chr. 245, l. 2.

काश्य *kâṣya*, i.e. *kâṣi + ya*, adj., and f. *yâ*. **1.** Belonging to the Kâṣis; a king of the Kâṣis, MBh. 1, 4128. **2.** f. A daughter of the king of the Kâṣis, MBh. 1, 3829.

काश्यप *kâṣyapa*, i.e. *kaṣyapa + a*, f. *pî*. **I.** adj. Belonging to Kaṣyapa, MBh. 13, 7237. **II.** patron. m. A descendant of Kaṣyapa, Râm. 1, 9, 28.

काश्यपेय *kâṣyapeya*, i.e. *kaṣyapa + eya*, patron. m. A name of the Âdityas, MBh. 13, 7094; of the sun, 1, 1247.

काषाय *kâshâya*, i. e. *kashâya + a*, adj., f. *yî*. **1.** Red, Sâv. 3, 18. **2.** s. A red cloth, Râm. 3, 52, 9.

काष्ठ *kâshṭha*, I. n. A piece of wood, Man. 8, 372. **II.** m. A proper name, MBh. 2, 415. *kâshṭhâ*, q.v.—**Comp.** *Daṇḍa-*, n. a wooden staff, Çâk. 21, 1. *Danta-*, n. a small piece of wood for cleaning the teeth, MBh. 13, 4998.

काष्ठकूट *kâshṭhakûṭa*, m. A kind of bird, probably = *kâshṭha-kutṭa*, Pañch. 80, 12.

काष्ठभारिक *kâshṭhabhârîka*, i. e. *kâshṭha-bhâra + ika*, m. One who carries wood, Kathâs. 6, 42.

काष्ठमय *kâshṭha + maya*, adj., f. *yî*. Made of wood, Man. 2, 157.

काष्ठलोष्टमय *kâshṭha-loshṭa-maya*, adj., f. *yî*, Made of wood or clay, Man. 8, 289.

काष्ठा *kâshṭhâ*, f. **1.** Aim, MBh. 3, 10424; limit, boundary, Kumâras. 5, 28. **2.** Place, Bhâg. P. 3, 18, 12. **3.** A quarter or point of the compass, Bhâg. P. 4, 24, 1. **4.** A lunar station, Bhâg. P. 1, 12, 31. **5.** A measure of time, MBh. 1, 1292. **6.** A proper name, Bhâg. P. 6, 6, 25.
