**जाया** *jāyā*, i.e. *jan + yā*, f. A spouse, Man. 9, 8.—Cf. Lat. *gaja*.

**जायात्** *jāyā + tva*, n. The condition of a *jāyā*, the name *jāyā*, Man. 9, 8.

**जायिन्** *-jāyin*, i.e. *ji + in*, adj. Conquering, MBh. 3, 1383.

**जार्** *jāra*, i.e. *jṛī + a*, m. 1. A lover, Chr. 295, 11=Rigv. i. 92, 11. 2. A paramour, an adulterer, Yājū. 2, 301.

**जारज्** *jāra-ja*, m. A son begotten by an adulteress, Pañch. Pr. 6.

**जारता** *jāra+tā*, f. Adultery, Daçak. in Chr. 182, 10.

**जारासंधि** *jārāsaṁdhi*, i.e. *jarā-saṁdha*, a proper name, +*i*, patronym. A descendant of Jarāsaṁdha, MBh. 2, 966.

**जारूथी** *jārūthī*, f. The name of a river, Rām. 6, 109, 50.

**जारूथ्य** *jārūthya*, m. A kind of sacrifice, Rām. 6, 113, 10.

**जायक्** *jāryaka*, m. A certain animal, Rājat. 5, 321.

**जाल्** *jāla*, n. 1. A net, Pañch. 78, 14. 2. A coat of mail, MBh. 6, 725. 3. A lattice, Rām. 3, 61, 13. 4. A window, Man. 8, 132. 5. A dense multitude, Rām. 1, 28, 23. 6. **जाल्म** *jālma*, m. and f. *mī*. 1. Wicked, Vikr. 5, 14. 2. Contemptible, MBh. 5, 4518.

**जाल्मक** *jālma+ka*, adj. Wicked, MBh. 7, 9023.

**जाल्य** *jālya*, i.e. *jāla+ya*, adj. Exposed to nets, MBh. 12, 10417.

**जाङ्गव** *jāhnava*, i.e. *jahnu+a*, patron. A descendant of Jahnu, Bhāg. P. 9, 22, 9. f. *vi*, A name of the Gaṅgā, Kir. 5, 15.

**जाङ्गवीय** *jāhnavīya*, i.e. *jāhnavī+iya*, adj. Belonging to the Gaṅgā, MBh. 13, 1857.
