तच् *TAKSH*, i. 1, Par. (also Åtm.), and ii. 5, *takshnu*, Par. **१.** To slice (wood), MBh. 5, 4161. **२.** To cut to pieces, to wound, MBh. 3, 1585. **३.** To prepare, to form (ved.). **४.** † To cover with a hide.—With the prep.
