

त्रैदशिक

त्रैदशिक *traidaśika*, i.e. *tridaśa + ika*, adj. Referring to the *tridaśas*, Man. 2, 58.

त्रैध *traidha*, i.e. *tri-dhā + a*, adj. Triple; acc. sing. n. ^o*dham*, adv. In three different manners, MBh. 3, 1233.

त्रैपुर *traipura*, i.e. *tri-purā* or *rī + a*, m. 1. pl. The inhabitants of Tri-purā and Tripurī, i.e. the Chedis, Hariv. 7443; MBh. 6, 3855. 2. A prince of the Chedis.

त्रैपुरुष *traipurusha*, i.e. *tri-purusha + a*, adj. Comprising three generations, MBh. 13, 4322.

त्रैफल *traiphala*, i.e. *tri-phalā + a*, adj. Coming from the three myrobalans, Suçr. 2, 45, 7.

त्रैमासिक *traimāsika*, *tri-māsa + ika*, adj. Three months old, Bhāg. P. 2, 7, 27.

त्रैयम्बक *traiyambaka*, i.e. *tryam-baka + a*, adj. Referring or dedicated to Tryambaka, MBh. 7, 169.

त्रैलिङ्ग *trailinga*, i.e. *tri-liṅga + a*, adj. Being of three genders, MBh. 12, 11353.

त्रैलोक *trailoka*, i.e. *tri-loka + a*, m. A name of Indra, MBh. 12, 10106.

त्रैलोक्य *trailokya*, i.e. *tri-loka + ya*, n. The three worlds, Man. 11, 236.

त्रैवर्गिक *trairargika*, i.e. *tri-varga + ika*, adj., f. *hi*, Referring, attached to the three classes of ends, viz. virtue, pleasure, and interest, Bhāg. P. 2, 4, 4; 3, 32, 18.

त्रैवर्ग्य *traivargya*, i.e. *tri-varga + ya*, adj. Belonging to the three classes of ends, viz. virtue, pleasure, and interest, Bhāg. P. 4, 22, 35.

त्रैम्बक

त्रैवार्षिक *traivārshika*, i.e. *tri-var-sha + ika*, adj. Sufficient for three years, Man. 11, 7.

त्रैविक्रम *traivikrama*, i.e. *tri-vikra-ma + a*, I. adj. Belonging to Vishṇu, Ragh. 7, 32. II. n. Going three steps, Hariv. 3168.

त्रैविद्य *traividya*, i.e. *tri-vidyā + a*, I. n. 1. The three Vedas, Man. 2, 28. 2. An assemblage of Brāhmaṇas skilled in the three Vedas, Yājñ. 1, 9. II. adj. Skilled in the three Vedas, Man. 12, 111.

त्रैविद्य *traividhya*, i.e. *tri-vidha + ya* (cf. *vidhā*), n. Triplicity, Bhāshāp. 12.

त्रैविष्टप *traivishṭapa* and **त्रैविष्टपेय** *traivishṭapeya*, i.e. *tri-vishṭapa + a* and *eya*, m. A god, Bhāg. P. 1, 11, 8; 8, 8, 19.

त्रैवृत *traivṛita*, i.e. *tri-vṛit + a*, adj. Coming from the plant Ipomoea turpe-thum, Suçr. 2, 378, 11.

त्रैवेदिक *traivedika*, i.e. *tri-veda + ika*, adj. Relating to the three Vedas, Man. 3, 1.

त्रैशङ्कव *traiṣaṅkava*, i.e. *tri-ṣaṅku + a*, patronym. A descendant of Tri-ṣaṅku, Hariv. 755.

त्रैशीर्ष *traiśirsha*, i.e. *tri-śirsha + a*, adj., f. *shā*, Referring to Triśirsha, MBh. 5, 335.

त्रैस्रोतस *traisrotasa*, i.e. *tri-srotas + a*, adj. Belonging to the Gaṅgā, Ragh. 16, 34.

त्रौटक *troṭaka*, n. A kind of drama, Vikr. 3, 8.

† **त्रौक्** *TRAUK*, i. 1, Ātm. To go, to move.

त्रैम्बक *tryambaka*, i.e. *tri-ambaka*, m. Epithet of Rudra-Çiva, MBh. 2, 403.
