P. 5, 16, 27. **II.** f. *gī*, A female elephant, Suçr. 1, 178, 1. **III.** adj., f. *gī*. **1.** Consisting of serpents, MBh. 8, 2586. **2.** Produced from an elephant, Suçr. 1, 194, 1. **IV.** f. *gā*, A proper name, Rājat. 7, 293.—Comp. *Dīgnāga*, i.e. *dīç-*, m. an elephant supposed to support a quarter of the world, Megh. 14. *Cīgu-*, m. a kind of Rākshasa or demon, Rām. 3, 76, 28.

नागमय *nāga+maya*, adj., f. *yī*, Consisting in elephants, Hariv. 9379.

नागर *nāgara*, i.e. *nagara+a*, I. adj. **1.** Belonging to a town, MBh. 1, 5682; m. A citizen, Rām. 1, 17, 34. **2.** Referring to a town, MBh. 2, 256. **3.** Polite, Çāk. 94, 10 Ch. **II.** f. *rī*, A crafty woman, Haeb. Anth. 351, 16. **III.** n. Dry ginger, Suçr. 1, 161, 2.—Comp. *Deva-nāgarī*, f. the name of the character proper to Sanskrit.

नागरक *nāgara+ka*, m. The chief of a town, Çāk. 73, 1, v.r.

नागरिक *nāgarika*, i.e. *nagara+ika*, I. adj. Inhabiting a town, Sch. ad. Çāk. d. 51. **II.** m. **1.** A citizen, Vikr. 77, 12. **2.** Polite, Çāk. 60, 2. **2.** A superintendent of the police, Daçak. 195, 13.

नागवन्त *nāga+vant*, adj., f. *vati*, Consisting in elephants, MBh. 5, 5703.

नागिन् *nāgin*, i.e. *nāga+in*, adj. Surrounded by serpents, Hariv. 14844.

नागजित *nāgnajita*, i.e. *nagnajit+a*, patronym. f. *tī*, A descendant of Nagnajit, Bhāg. P. 3, 3, 4.

नाटक *nātaka*, i.e. *nāt+aka*, I. m. A mime, Rām. 1, 5, 18. **II.** n. A drama, Rām. 2, 69, 4.

नाटितक *nātita+ka* (vb. *nāt*), n. A gesture, Çāk. 73, 4.

नात्य *nātya*, i.e. *nāta+ya*, n. **1.**

The art of acting or dancing, scenic art, Bhāg. P. 4, 15, 19. **2.** Mimical representation, Mṛichchh. 88, 4. **3.** The attire of an actor, Bhāg. P. 1, 8, 19.

नाडिका *nādikā*, i.e. *nādi+ka*, f.

1. A measure of time, $\frac{1}{60}$ of a sidereal day, an Indian hour, Bhāg. P. 3, 11, 3. **2.** A measure of length, half a *daṇḍa*, Mārk. P. 49, 39. **3.** An Indian clock, Kām. Nītis. 5, 51.

नाडी *nādi*, i.e. *nāda+a+i*, also

नाडि *nādi* (Bhāg. P. 3, 5, 11), f. **1.**

The stalk or culm of any plant. **2.** Any tubular organ of the body, as an artery, a vein, an intestine, etc., MBh. 3, 13974; Ragh. 10, 59 (the rays of the sun, supposed to be hollow). **3.** A fistulous sore, Suçr. 1, 284, 11. **4.** =*nādikā* 1, Sūryas. 1, 12.—Comp. *Garbha-nādi*, f. the navel-string, Suçr. 1, 368, 13.

नाणक *nāñaka*, n. A coin, Yājñ. 2, 240.

नाथ *NĀTH*, and **नाध** *NĀDH* (akin to *nam*), i. 1, Ātm. (also Par., MBh. 3, 12630). To beg, MBh. 12, 1365 (with gen. of the object, MBh. 3, 12630).

नाथ *nāth+a*, m. **1.** A protector, MBh. 2292. **2.** A master, a lord, Pañch. v. d. 90; Rām. 1, 76, 19. **3.** A husband, Ragh. 12, 75.—Comp. *A-*, adj., f. *thā*, having no protector, helpless, Rām. 6, 23, 21. *Kāla-*, m. a name of Cīva, MBh. 12, 10368. *Ku-*, 1. m. a bad protector, Bhāg. P. 9, 14, 28. **2.** adj. having a bad guide, 5, 14, 2. *Gaurī-*, m. a name of Cīva, Bhartṛ. 3, 87. *Chamū-*, m. a commander of an army, Bhāg. P. 4, 26, 3. *Jagat-eka-*,
