

पञ्चदशहिक *pañchadaśāhika*, i.e. *pañchadaśan-aha + ika*, adj. Lasting fifteen days, Yājñ. 3, 323.

पञ्चधा *pañchadhā*, i.e. *pañchan + dhā*, adv. In five parts, five-fold, Yājñ. 3, 9.

पञ्चन् *pañchan*, numer. adj. Five, Man. 2, 43.

पञ्चपुष्पमय *pañchapuṣhpamaya*, i.e. *pañchan-puṣhpa + maya*, adj., f. *yī*, Consisting of five flowers, Kathās. 34, 232.

पञ्चम *pañchama*, i.e. *pañchan + ma*, I. ordinal number, f. *mī*, Fifth, Man. 2, 37, II. acc. n. *mam*, adv. Fifthly, Man. 8, 125. III. with *añṣa*, A fifth part, Man. 9, 164. IV. m. 1. One of the seven musical notes, originally the fifth, afterwards the seventh, MBh. 14, 1419. 2. One of the modes of music, Gīt. 10, 13. V. f. *mī*. 1. The fifth day of the half month, Hariv. 10241. 2. The name of a river, MBh. 6, 333.—Comp. *Ardha-*, adj. four and a half, Man. 4, 95.

पञ्चमक *pañchama + ka*, adj. Fifth, Çrut. 29.

पञ्चमय *pañchamaya*, i.e. *pañchan + maya*, adj., f. *yī*, Consisting of five (elements), Mārka. P. 37, 39.

पञ्चवट *pañchavaṭa*, i.e. *pañchan-vaṭa*, n. and f. *ṭī*, The name of a locality near the Godāvarī, Rām. 1, 3, 18 (13 Gorr.).

पञ्चवर्षीय *pañchavarshīya*, i.e. *pañchan-varsha + iya*, adj. Five years old, Çatr. 14, 137.

पञ्चविंशक *pañchaviñśaka*, i.e. *pañchan-viñśa + ka*, adj. 1. Twenty-fifth, Bhāg. P. 3, 26, 15. 2. Twenty-five (years old), Rām. iii. p. 469.

पञ्चविंशतिका *pañchaviñśatikā*, i.e. *pañchan-viñśati + ka*, fem.; in *vetāla-*, Twenty-five tales of a Vetāla; the title of a work.

पञ्चशस् *pañchaśas*, i.e. *pañchan + śas*, adv. Five [by five, Bhāg. P. 3, 10, 13.

पञ्चष *pañchasha*, i.e. *pañchan-shash*, adj. Five or six, Rājat. 5, 333.

पञ्चा *pañch + ā*, f. Spreading; in *chañchatpañcha*, i.e. *chañchant-*, adj. Shaking in all its parts, Utt. Rāmach. 120, 3 (v.r.).

पञ्चाग्नित्व *pañchâgnitva*, i.e. *pañchan-agni + tva*, n. An aggregate of five fires (or passions), Kathās. 28, 32.

पञ्चाल *pañchāla*, m. 1. pl. The name of a people and their country, Man. 2, 19. 2. A prince of the Pañchālas, MBh. 12, 13262.

पञ्चालक *pañchāla + ka*, I. adj. Referring to the Pañchālas; with *rājan*, A prince of the Pañchālas, MBh. 5, 7504 (perhaps to be changed to *pañchā-laka*). II. m. 1. pl.=The Pañchālas, Bhāg. P. 9, 22, 3. 2. A certain poisonous insect, Suçr. 2, 288, 3.

पञ्चाश *pañchāśa* (cf. *pañchâśat*), ordinal number, fem. *śī*, Fiftieth, Chr. 73, 3.—Comp. *Eka-*, fifty-first, Chr. 76, 21. *Dvâ-* and *dvi-*, fifty-second, Rām. 4, 52; Chr. 81, 9. *Tri-*, fifty-third. *Chatuḥpañchāśa*, i.e. *chatur-*, fifty-fourth. *Pañchapañchāśa*, i.e. *pañchan-*, fifty-fifth.

पञ्चाशत् *pañchâśat*, i.e. *pañchâ-daśanti* (cf. *chatvâriñśat*), numeral, f. Fifty, Man. 8, 297.—Comp. *Dvâ-* and *dvi-*, fifty-two, Hariv. 13076; MBh. 2, 52. *Chatuḥpañchâśat*, i.e. *chatur-*, fifty-four.—Cf. *πεντήκοντα*; Lat. quinquâ-ginta.
