**३५२** वैश्वासिक *vaiçvāsika*, i.e. *viçvāsa+ika*, adj. Trustworthy, Daçak. in Chr. 180, 10.

**३५३** वैश्वी *vaiçvī*, i.e. *viçva+a+i*, f. The name of the twenty-first lunar mansion.

**३५४** वैषम्य *vaishamya*, i.e. *vishama+ya*, n. **1.** Inequality, unevenness. **2.** Solitariness. **3.** Difficulty. **4.** Misery, distress, Nal. 9, 20.—Comp. *Ati-*, n. situation in a place of very difficult access, Hit. iii. d. 55.

**३५५** वैष्टुत *vaishṭuta*, i.e. *vi-stuta* (vb. *stu*), +a, n. The ashes of a burnt offering.

**३५६** वैष्ट्र *vaishṭra*, n. The world.

**३५७** वैष्णव *vaishṇava*, i.e. *vishṇu+a*, I. adj., f. *vī*, Relating or belonging to Vishṇu, Johns. Sel. 95, 70; Rājat. 5, 125; Arj. 4, 30. II. m. A follower of Vishṇu, Rājat. 5, 43. **III.** f. *rī*. **1.** One of the *Mātris*, the personified

energy of Vishṇu. **2.** Durgā. **3.** A flower, *Clitoria ternatea*. **4.** Sacred basil, *Ocymum sanctum*.

**३५८** वैष्णवत *vaishṇava+tva*, n. Faith in Vishṇu, Rājat. 5, 124.

**३५९** वैसारिण *vaisāriṇa*, i.e. *visārin+a*, m. A fish.

**३६०** वैहायस *vaihāyasa*, i.e. *vihāyas+a*, adj. Being in the air, aërial, Pāraskara, Gr. S. ii. 2 in Journ. of the German Oriental Society, vii. 533, 23; suspended in the air, Johns. Sel. 39, 30.

**३६१** वैहासिक *vaihāsika*, i.e. *vihāsa+ika*, m. A comic actor.

**३६२** वोटा *vōṭā*, f. A female slave.

**३६३** वोड्र *vodra*, I. m. **1.** The boa-constrictor. **2.** A sort of fish. II. f. *rī*, The fourth part of a *Pāpa*.

**३६४** वोढृ *vodhṛi*, i.e. *vah+tri*, m. **1.** A porter, one who carries or draws, Pañch. 8, 16. **2.** A charioteer. **3.** A bull. **4.** A guide, a leader, Lass. 97, 10= Rigv. vi. 64, 3 (ved. *volhā*, nom. sing.). **5.** A bridegroom, Man. 8, 204.—Comp. *Dhúrvodhṛi*, i.e. *dhur-*, m. a beast of burthen, Pañch. ed. orn. 4, 7.—Cf. **३६५** वोरुखान *vorukhāna*, m. A horse described as of red and white colour.

**३६८** वोहित्य *vohittha*, n. A vessel, a ship.

**३६९** वौषट् *vaushat* (= *vashat*, q. cf.; *vashat* has first become *voshat* by the influence of the *v*, as in *vodhṛi*),
