

**श्रीकर** *cikara* (cf. 1. *cik*), I. m. 1. A drop of water, Ragh. 16, 62; of rain, Çâk. d. 166. 2. Thin rain, Rit. 1, 15; Kir. 5, 15 (also *sikara*, MBh. 14, 2201). 3. Spray, Mâlat. 147, 14. II. n. A sort of pine, or its resin.—Comp. *Kara-* and *karin-*, m. water expelled by an elephant's trunk, Kir. 16, 9.

**श्रीकरिन्** *çikarin*, i.e. *cikara+in*, adj. Sprinkling, Utt. Râmach. 63, 5.

**श्रीघ्र** *çighra*, adj. 1. Quick, speedy, Vikr. d. 140 (*mañdala-çighra-châra*, Turning round quickly). 2. Violent, Paúch. iii. d. 52. 3. <sup>o</sup>ram, adv. Swiftly, Paúch. 128, 4. Comparat. <sup>o</sup>ratara+m, adv. As quickly as possible, Paúch. 88, 6.—Cf. A.S. higian, To make haste; *kixárw*.

**श्रीत्** *çit*, An imitative sound expressing pleasure, Bhart. 1, 49 (cf. *sit*), and trembling, Böhtl. Ind. Spr. 738.

**श्रीत** *çita* (probably an old pteple. pf. pass. of *ço*), I. adj. 1. Cold, Hit. i. d. 79, M.M.; chilly. 2. Apathetic. 3. Idle. 4. Stupid. II. n. 1. Coldness, Paúch. 169, 14. 2. Water.—Comp. *A-*, adj. hot, Bhâshâp. 25.

**श्रीतता** *çita+tâ*, f. Coldness, Paúch. i. d. 287.

**श्रीतल** *çita+la*, I. adj. Cold, cool, Paúch. ii. d. 58; figurat., Vikr. d. 90. Comparat. <sup>o</sup>latara, Cooler, Çiç. 9, 4. II. m. 1. The moon. 2. A sort of camphor. III. m., f. *lâ*, and *li*, and n. The name of several plants. IV. n. 1. Coldness. 2. A pearl.—Comp. *A-*, adj. hot, Çiç. 9, 86. *Ati-*, adj. very cool, Hit. iii. d. 45. *Su-*, adj. very cool, Hit. i. d. 96, M.M. *Hima-*, adj. very cold.

**श्रीत्कार** *çit-hâra*, m. 1. Making the sound *çit*, sighing on account of pleasure. 2. A frown, Amar. 31 (Sch.).—

Comp. *Sa-çithâra+m*, adv. with sighs, Vikr. d. 103.

**श्रीधु** *çidhu*, m. and n. Rum distilled from molasses, intoxicating spirits, Çiç. 9, 87; wine, Böhtl. Ind. Spr. 3322 (cf. *sidhu*).

**श्रीन** *çina*, see *gyai*.

**श्रीर** *çî+ra*, m. A snake, boa-constrictor, Paúch. 203, 6.

**श्रीर्णता** *çirña+tâ*, f., and **श्रीर्णल** *çirña+tra*, n. (vb. *çri*), Emaciation, withering.

**श्रीर्वि** *çirvi*, i.e. *çri+vi*, adj. Hurtful, destructive.

**श्रीष** *çirsha*, i.e. curtailed *çirshan* (cf. *çiras*), n. The head, Utt. Râmach. 40, 2 (-*chhedyâ*, adj. One who must be beheaded), Bhart. 2, 27.—Comp. *Go-*, I. adj. shaped like a cow's head, MBh. 7, 8097. II. n. a kind of sandal, Râm. 4, 41, 59. *Tri-*, adj. having three heads, MBh. 1, 2162. *Daçaçirsha*, i.e. *daçan-*, m. 1. a name of Râvaña, Râm. 4, 10, 22. 2. a spell, ib. 1, 30, 5. *Pâñcha-*, adj. having five heads, Bhâg. P. 4, 25, 21. *Pûrva-*, adj., f. *shâ*, with the head turned to the east, MBh. 13, 463. *Myiga-*, m. the fifth lunar mansion, Lass. 16, 18.—Cf. probably O.H.G. and A.S. hals; Lat. collum; see *çiras*.
