

of some mss.); MSV i.264.2; esp. of a *road, way* (usually *mārga*) over which a distinguished person is to pass; *pratijāgratha* (impv.), *prepare, adorn, decorate*, Mv ii.150.2; <sup>o</sup>jāgaretha (opt.) 153.14; <sup>o</sup>jāgarīyāmāh iii.323.10; ppp. <sup>o</sup>jāgrta- Mv i.258.16 (amātyehi ca sarvam <sup>o</sup>jāgrtam yathā ānattam; could belong to 3 above, like Mv ii.180.6, but the king's command was to *adorn* the road); ii.111.8 (amātyehi . . . sarvam <sup>o</sup>jāgrtam mahatā samṛddhiye pratyudgamanam kṛtam; situation like prec.); devehī mārgo <sup>o</sup>jāgrto iii.324.10; <sup>o</sup>jāgritam Mv i.270.13; ii.150.8; mārgam <sup>o</sup>jāgramsu (v.l. <sup>o</sup>jāgrsuh; § 32.76) Mv i.259.3; in Mv i.231.11 some form of this verb seems to be intended, (*daśakrośamārgam*) *pratijāgrhansuḥ* (Senart, almost as one ms. which has <sup>o</sup>jagrhanṣuh; v.l. *pratigrahetsuh*); Senart suggests contamination with *prati-grah-*, but this hardly makes sense; what was done is shown by the following (they made the road level, clean, adorned, etc., for the Buddha Dipamkara to pass over).

**pratijāgraka**, adj. (to prec. plus -aka), *attending to, in charge of*: *prahāṇa*-<sup>o</sup>ko bhikṣuh MSV iv.77.11.

[*pratijñmbhitā*, see *pravijñ*<sup>o</sup>.]

**pratijñā** (= Pali *paṭiññā*, ifc. Bhvr. *-paṭiññā*, in *samaṇa-pa*<sup>o</sup> . . . *brahmacāri-pa*<sup>o</sup> Vin. ii.236.25, same phrase as below), *claim, profession* (to be something, with implication of falseness and presumption; cf. Skt. jñā with *prati* in BR, mg. 4), only noted in comp., *pratijñā-bhikṣu* Mvy 8751, *a monk by (his own) claim (only)*, Tib. here and below *khā hche ba, promise with the mouth*; otherwise only at end of cpds., esp. in cliché (as in Pali above) *āśramaṇaḥ śrāmanapratijñāḥ, abrahmacāri brahmacāri-pratijñāḥ* Mvy 9143 and 9144 (text <sup>o</sup>cāri-prati<sup>o</sup>, both edd.; Mironov <sup>o</sup>pratijñāḥ both times, as if pl!); Śiks 67.20; MSV i.50.8; plural thruout, same phrase, Śiks 64.4-5; *sat̄ śāstrpratijñāḥ, the six false, self-alleged teachers, Pūraṇa* (q.v.) etc., Av ii.134.10; *sat̄ śāstāra-pratijñā(h)* (id.) Mv iii.383.15; gen. *saṇṇām śāstārapratijñānām* 17.

**pratijñā-kāraka**, m., sc. *vinaya*, or in MSV nt. with *karman* (= Pali *paṭiññātā-karanaṁ*, MN ii.248.21 ff., with description, cf. Childers s.v. *paṭiññātā*), (procedure) *which effects confession* (of the erring one), one of the 7 *adhikarana-śamatha*: Mvy 8637; MSV ii.207.12.

**pratijñottaraka**, adj. (*pratijñā-ut<sup>o</sup>?*), Mvy 1796, perh. *surpassing one's promise; exceeding expectations*; context indicates something like *zealous, energetic*. Tib. *kha ḥog tu lus ḥkhrus pa, bathing the body with face downward!* (!); but Chin. *bathing the body with lower part covered, that is, observing propriety even when alone* (a famous Confucian precept).

**pratitādayati**, *beats in return*: tādito na <sup>o</sup>dayati KP 107.2; Śiks 185.5; *tādītāḥ <sup>o</sup>dayati* Bbh 170.20; *tādītena* (Bhik <sup>o</sup>tāyā) na <sup>o</sup>ditavyam Mvy 8712; Bhik 31a.4.

**pratitālaka**, nt., *key*: Mvy 5906 = Tib. *lde mig*. Cf. *tālaka*.

**pratiṣṭhati** (virtually = Skt. id.), *bases oneself on, relies on* (loc.; pw 7.211; *believes in*, acc. to Müller, SBE 49.2 p. 114, n. 1, = *depends on, or accepts as real*): Vaj 21.7-11, 20 (see *nimitta* 1); cf. SP 63.10 *upāyakauśalya* (uninflected stem form?) *pratiṣṭhīhitvā* (?).

**pratidakṣiṇa**, adj. (= the usual *pradakṣiṇa*), with *karoti*, *(makes so as to be) on the right hand*: *pranamya pādau pratidakṣiṇam ca kṛtvā mām tasthur ihāgrato me* LV 7.7 (vs). (No v.l. for *prati<sup>o</sup>*).

**pratidiṣati** (= *pratideśayati*, q.v.), *confesses*: *sarvam pratidiṣamy agham* Sādh 29.1 = 106.13 (vs; m.c.?).

**pratideśa**, m., *message, or direction, instruction*: rājñā <sup>o</sup>śo dattah, nirviśākā tiṣṭha MSV ii.24.3.

**pratideśanā** (to *pratideśayati* with -anā), *confession*: Sūtrāl. xi.62, comm.

**pratideśanikā** (adj., sc. *vipatti* or *āpatti*), = next: MSV iii.109.20 <sup>o</sup>nikayā.

**pratideśaniya**, gdve. (to next; = Pali *pātidesanīya*),

*requiring confession*, as adj. with *dharma*: (four) <sup>o</sup>niyā dharmāḥ Prāt 525.1; (sc. *dharmāḥ*) Mvy 8361; as nt. subst., referring to the same set of four offenses, <sup>o</sup>niyāni Mvy 8518 (listed in the sequel).

**pratideśayati**, (1) (= Pali *paṭideseti*; cf. *pratidiśati*), *confesses* (a sin): tam (sc. *pāpam*) *pratideśayami* ahu sarvam Bhād 8; also with obj. *pāpam* Suv 34.4; Kv 31.5; Mmk 146.4; (*pāpakam karma . . .*) <sup>o</sup>yāmi Sādh 55.14 (prose), etc.; with *āpattim* Śiks 65.6; misc. LV 379.13 (see s.v. *aryaya*); Bbh 263.21; gdve. impersonal, <sup>o</sup>sayitavyam Prāt 525.5, *he must confess*; (2) *renounces, rejects*; only noted in AsP 328.6 *bodhicittam* (so read) <sup>o</sup>saya *pratinihṣra* (q.v.; the two are synonyms here), and 14 yad etat tvayā pūrvam śrutam tat *pratideśaya*, yat tvayā pūrvam parigṛhitam tat *pratinihṣra* (thus Māra tempts Bodhisattvas).

**pratidvandvayati** (denom. to Skt. *pratidvandva, rival, rivals, acts as a rival*: ko 'yam asmābhiḥ sārdham <sup>o</sup>yat̄ alokajñāḥ Divy 403.18.

**pratidvāra** (= AMg. *paṭiduvāra*), *small gate, wicket-gate*: svakasya niveśanasya <sup>o</sup>dvāre asthāsi, bhagavantam . . . *pratipālayamāno* Mv i.324.18.

**pratinayina** (m.? cf. *pratinayaka*, acc. to pw 7.389 *Ebenbild, Gegenstück*), *imitation, matching, copying* (but I have not found *prati-ni*, or MIndic equivalent, recorded in this ing.): (seeking the company and advice of good friends, *kalyānamitra*) *tad-guṇa-pratinayēṣu prayujyā-māno (and applying yourself to the imitation of their virtues)* na *parikhidyase . . .* Gv 386.8.

[*pratināvā* or <sup>o</sup>vā, acc. <sup>o</sup>vam, see *pratinau*.]

? *pratinirvāti*, may be error, = *parinir<sup>o</sup>*: <sup>o</sup>vāsyāmi MSV i.259.12; in the context *parinir<sup>o</sup>* occurs. Cf. however § 2.47.

**pratinivārayate** (cf. noun *pratinivāraṇa*, once in late Skt., BR), *wards off, keeps away*: (*vihiṁsācittān, Bhvr.*) <sup>o</sup>yamānān Gv 87.7, *keeping away those minded to injuriousness*.

**pratinivāsana**, nt. (= Pali *pati<sup>o</sup>*, wrongly transl. in PTSD; see SBE 13.155), (*monk's*) *undergarment*: Mvy 8939 = Tib. *śam thabs kyi gzan*; Chin. *underpiece for a monk's garment* (lining?); Kalpanāmaṇḍitikā, Lüders, Kl. Skt. Texte 2, p. 44.

**pratiniviṣati**, ger. <sup>o</sup>viṣya (recorded only in ppp. <sup>o</sup>viṣṭa, BR, *ganz mit Etwas beschäftigt, nur für Eines Sinn habend*), perh. *taking a keen interest*: tatra (sc. nagare) *praviṣya (having entered there) pratiniviṣya nagaram* *nagarakriyāsukham anubhavet Laṅk 143.16.*

**pratinisaṇṇa**, *severally seated*: *vaḍūryāsaneṣu* (mss. <sup>o</sup>sane; Tib. plur.) <sup>o</sup>ṇṇān Suv 20.5 (prose).

-**pratinisēvana(-tā)**, ifc., *cultivation (of), adherence (to), severally, in each case* (prati): (*karmanāḥ . . .*) <sup>o</sup>vajena (to), cited as so sor bsten cin, read ciñ) samudā-nayanam Bbh 107.27; pañcāṅgāpramāda-<sup>o</sup>na-tayā 187.5.

**pratiniskrānta**, ppp. (= AMg. *paṭinikkhanta*), *returned*: MSV iii.17.17; 18.1.

**pratinisargā, pratinisṛjati**, see *pratinisṛ*.

**pratinistarati**, *accomplishes, fulfills (in a way corresponding to) promise, prati*: *pratiṣṭhām <sup>o</sup>retā* Divy 102.14.

**pratinisarana** (nt.; cf. Pali *paṭinissarati*, *escapes*; see next), *escape, in duḥ-prati* (Bhvr.), *hard to escape from*: duḥ<sup>o</sup>ṇam copādānam (see *upādāna* 3) RP 48.6.

[*pratinisṛsarati*? mss. reading at Mv i.192.1; Senart em. *pratinisṛṣja*, see s.v. *pratinisṛjati*.]

**pratinisṛgā**, m., also written <sup>o</sup>nisarga (to next; = Pali *patinissagga*), *abandonment, renunciation*: in LV 31.21 text <sup>o</sup>sṛgāyai, as if f., but best ms. <sup>o</sup>sṛga-tāyai, so read, in cpd., *saropadhipratinisṛgā*, m. (except here, in LV 31.21; note synonym *parivarjanā-tāyai* LV 31.16); Mv ii.285.20; iii.314.4-5 (em.; but certain); Mvy 2549 (<sup>o</sup>nisargah); of dristi, or wrong opinions, Av ii.188.1; 190.2 (both <sup>o</sup>nisargo); Prāt 516.2; of ṭṛṣṇā, Mv iii.332.9; Samy. (both <sup>o</sup>nisargo).
