चिमिषु a. having quick arrows.

चीक्ष a. diminished, wasted, exhausted, broken down, thin, emaciated, feeble; abstr. ०ता f., ०त्व n.

चीक्षकत्व a. freed from sins.

चीक्षवृत्ति a. whose means of subsistence are exhausted.

चीक्षावृत्त a. whose life is (nearly) ended.

चीव & चोव a. drunk, intoxicated, excited; abstr. ०ता f., ०त्व n.

चीरं n. milk (also of plants).

चीरचय m. the diminution of milk (in the udder).

चीरधि & ०निधि m. the ocean (lit. milk-receptacle).

चीरमीर (०—) milk and water.

चीरप a. drinking milk; m. a suckling baby, infant.

चीरभूत a. paid with milk.

चीरवन् a. full of milk.
