- चिदश्ता** f., वत्स n. divinity.
- चिदश्पति** m. the chief of the gods (Indra).
- चिदश्त्रेष्ठ** m. the best of the gods (Brahman or Agni).
- चिदश्चाधिप** m. = चिदश्पति.
- चिदश्चाधिपति** m. E. of Çiva (lit. = prec.).
- चिदश्चामुख** n. the divine bow, the rainbow.
- चिदश्चारि** m. an Asura (foe of the gods).
- चिदश्चालय** m. the residence of the gods, i.e. heaven.
- चिदश्चालय** m. a dweller in heaven, a god.
- चिदश्चन्द्र** & ऋश्च m. = चिदश्पति.
- चिदश्चर** m. = prec., also E. of Agni, Varuna, & Yama.
- चिदिक्ष** n. the third i.e. highest heaven (in Veda always w. gen. दिवस्).
- चिदिवेश्वर** m. lord of the third heaven (Indra).
- चिदिवीक्ष** m. an inhabitant of the third heaven, a god.
- चिद्धा** adv. in three ways, in (into) three parts; at three times.
- चिद्धातु** a. tripartite, triple; n. = चिजग्न.
- चिद्धामन्** a. = prec. adj.; m. E. of Viṣṇu & Brahman.
- चिद्धामन्** n. = चिदिक्ष.
- चिन्दन** a. three-eyed, m. E. of Rudra-Çiva.
- चिपक्ष** n. three fortnights.
- चिपद्वाशः**, f. है the fifty-third, consisting of 53.
- चिपण** n. the triple path (the sky, earth, & atmosphere or lower world)
- चिपह** or **चिपह** (०पादः), f. चिपदी = seq., also making three steps; s. three quarters, m. E. of Viṣṇu.
- चिपद** (f. चिपदा or चिपदा) three-footed or consisting of three Pādas.
- चिपद्य** a. tripartite.
- चिपाटिन** a. studying the three (Vedas).
- चिपादक**. f. ऋद्धका three-footed.
- चिपिट्क** n. the three baskets (i.e. collections of Buddhistic writings).
- चिपिष्ठी** f. the three sacrificial cakes.
