- प्रसिद्ध a. accomplished, brought in order, arranged, settled; famous, celebrated; abstr. °ता† f., °त्वा† n.
- प्रसिद्धि f. success, accomplishment, perfection; celebrity, notoriety.
- प्रसृत a. flowing forth (from the press); f. continued pressing of Soma.
- प्रसृत a. (having) pressed out continually; n. = prec. f.
- प्रसृति f. = prec. n.
- प्रसृप a. sleeping, asleep.
- प्रसृत a. fallen asleep, sleeping, senseless, at rest.
- प्रसू n. bearing, bringing forth (—°), fruitful. f. mother; shoot, young grass or herb.
- प्रसूत a. born, brought forth (f. चा also act.), produced, sprung from (abl., gen., or —°), in (loc.); sent forth, impelled, bidden, allowed.
- प्रसूति f. bringing forth, bearing, birth, production, coming forth, growth; f. father or mother, child, offspring, grown fruit; urging, impelling, bidding, permission.
- प्रसूतिक्वा f. having brought forth recently.
- प्रसूतिविकल a. having no progeny.
- प्रसून n. bud, blossom, fruit.
- प्रसूनमाला f. garland of flowers.
- प्रसूनन्त & प्रसूवन् (f. प्रसूवरी) furnished with flowers.
- प्रसृत a. streamed or broken forth, spread, extensive, mighty, strong, widely spread, common, usual; run away, fled. — m. the stretched out and hollowed hand (also as a measure.)
- प्रसृति f. streaming, flowing, also = prec. m.
- प्रसेक m. flowing forth, discharge; the bowl of a spoon or ladle.
- प्रसेन & °जित् m. names of sev. princes
- प्रसन्न a. stiff, rigid.
- प्रसार m. stramentum, layer, straw; bunch of grass (r.); surface, plain; stone, rock.
- प्रसव m. praise, eulogy.
- प्रसार m. spreading, extension, high degree; straw, cushion, bed, layer, plain, surface.
- प्रसारपङ्क्ति f. N. of a metre.
- प्रसारिन् a. spreading, stretching over (—°).

- प्रस्रिग्ध a. very slippery, soft, or delicate.
- प्रस्फुट a. manifest, clear.

- प्रस्रन्दिन् adj. to prec.
- प्रस्रव m. the flowing forth, esp. of the milk from the udder, also the milk itself; guak, flood, stream
- प्रस्रवण n. flowing forth, efflux; spring (also m.).
- प्रस्रवद् a. pleasant, charming.
- प्रस्रिद् m. sweat, perspiration.
- प्रसृति f. stroke, throw.
- प्रहर m. a watch i.e. a period of about 3 hours (lit. a stroke, scil. on a gong).
- प्रहरण n. striking, beating, fighting, war, battle, weapon.
- प्रहर्तव्य a. to be struck or assailed; n. impers.
- प्रहर्त m. sender, striker, assailant, champion.
- प्रहर्ष m. great joy, delight, rapture.
