C. bring to fall, deprive of (abl.). **वि** fail, have no success in (loc.); turn away from, abandon (abl.). भङ्ग f. stiffness.
भम्, **भमति** (°ते), **भाम्यति**, pp. **भाम** (q.v.) roam, wander, stroll; go through, perambulate (acc.); fly about, flutter; move round, rotate; stagger about, waver, go astray, be perplexed or mistaken. C. **भमयति & भामयति** (°ते) cause to roam etc., whirl round, swing, roll; cause to err, perplex, embarrass, confuse; pp. **भमित** fasely taken for or confounded with (—°)*. I. **वक्ष्मीति & वक्ष्म्यते** wander about or through, the latter also w. pass. mg. —
