मुहुरण n. sealing up, closing.
मुहुर्य, **०यति**, pp. **मुहुरित** seal, stamp, shut, print. — **उद्** unseal, open. **वि** seal up, shut.
मुद्रा f. seal, seal-ring, ring i.g., stamp, print, mark, impression; shutting, closing, lock, mystery.
मुद्राङ्क & **०ङ्कित** a. stamped, sealed, marked with (—०).
मुद्राराक्षस n. Rākṣasa (a minister) and the seal-ring, T. of a drama.
मुद्रिका f. seal-ring, signet.
मुद्रिताक्ष, f. **दृ** having closed eyes.
मुघा adv. in vain, for nothing.
मुनि m. impulse or a man driven by (inward) impulse; an inspired saint or seer; ascetic, devotee, hermit, monk, esp. one who has taken the vow of silence; pl. the seven stars of the Great Bear (cf. **चक्षु**).
मुनिनया f. the daughter of a Muni.
मुनिदीहि m. the grandson of a Muni.
मुनिपत्नी f. the wife of a Muni.
मुनिपुत्र m. the son of a Muni.
मुनिवन n. a hermit's grove.
मुनिवर m. the best of the Munis, E. of Vasiṣṭha.
मुनिवेश m. a hermit's garment; also = seq.
मुनिवेशधर a. wearing a hermit's garment.
मुनिव्रत a. keeping a Muni's vow (i.e. the vow of silence).
मुनिसूत m. = **मुनिपुत्र**.
मुनीश, **मुनीश**, & **०श्वर** m. the chief of Munis, i.e. a great sage or ascetic.
मुन्यन्न n. pl. the food of ascetics.
मुमुक्षा f. desire of liberation.
मुमुर्षु a. desirous of freeing (acc. or —०) or of being freed, esp. from mundane existence.
मुमुक्षुता f., **०त्व** n. desire of liberation or final emancipation.
मुमुषा f. desire of death.
- मुमुषु** a. wishing to die, moribund.
मुमोक्षयिषु & **०क्षयिषु** a. wishing to liberate.
मुर m. N. of a demon slain by Kṛṣṇa.
मुरज m. a kind of drum or tambourine.

मुषितक n. stolen property.
मुषीवन् m. robber, thief.
मुष्क m. testicle, du. the vulva.
मुष्कदेश m. the region of the scrotum.
मुष्कभार a. having testicles.
मुष्कर & **मुष्कवन्त** a. = prec.
मुष्टि f. fist, handful; handle, esp. of a sword.
मुष्टिप्रहार m. blow with the fist.
मुष्टिसुड n., **०हृत्वा** f. a fight with fists, hand to hand engagement.
मुष्टिहन् m. fighting hand to hand.
मुष्टी कृ clench the fist.
मुसल m. n. pestle, mace, club, bell-clapper.
