 *शर्धय a. thicket of reeds; m. pl. N. of a region in Kuruksetra.
 शर्ध्यावन्त m. pond, lake (cf. prec.), fig. of the Soma-vat.
 शर्धहन् m. archer (killer with arrows).
 शर्धात & शर्धाति m. names of men.
 शर्व m. N. of a god killing with arrows, in l. l. = Rudra-Çiva.
 शर्वपत्नी f. Çarva's wife i.e. Pārvati.
 शर्वपर्वत m. Çarva's mountain, i.e. Kailāsa. (*शर्व a. spotted); f. शर्वरी pl. the spotted deer (of the Maruts); sgl. the (starred) night.
 शर्वाचल m. = शर्वपर्वत.
 शर्वाणी f. N. of the wife of Çarva or Çiva.
