

- संदाह** *m.* milking; abundance, plenty.  
**संदाहन** *a.* milking, yielding.  
**संद्रष्टव्य** *a.* to be seen.  
**संद्रष्टु** *a.* who sees or beholds.  
**संध** *n.* junction, union.  
**संधय**, **०यति**, *pp.* **संधित** (*q.v.*) put together, join with (*instr.*); be reconciled, make peace. —  
*Cf.* **अतिसंधित**, **अनुसंधित**, & **अभिसंधित** (*add.*).  
**संधर्तु** *m.* who holds together.  
**संधा** *f.* agreement, covenant, promise; limit, boundary, term.  
**संधातव्य** *a.* to be joined or allied with.  
**संधानु** *a.* who puts together.  
**संधान** *a. & n.* putting together; *n.* also joining, fixing (an arrow on the bow-string); mixing, compounding; joint, commissure, point of contact, meeting, assembling; propitiation, reconciliation, league, alliance, treaty, peace with (*instr.* ≠ **सह**); also = **संधि** (*g.*).  
**संधानीय** *a.* = **संधातव्य**.  
**संधायिन्** *a.* fixing an arrow, taking aim.  
**संधारण** *a. & n.* holding together, supporting; *n.* also bearing (in the womb), restraining, keeping back; *f.* **आ** posture, attitude; thought, reflection.  
**संधार्थ** *a.* to be borne, kept, observed, restrained.  
**संधि** *m.* putting together, junction, connection; union or intercourse with (*instr.*); compact, agreement, alliance, peace between (*gen.*), with (*instr.* ≠ **सह**); joint, commissure, suture, fold; anything that joins or lies between, as dawn, dusk, twilight (between day and night), wall (between two rooms), also interval, pause, opening, hole, breach, gap; euphonic combination of words and sentences (*g.*).  
**संधिच्छिदन** *n.* house-breaking.  
**संधित** *a.* put together, joined, fixed on the bow-string (arrow); allied.  
**संधित्सु** *a.* wishing to make peace.  
**संधिदूषण** *n.* breach of peace.  
**संधिन्** *m.* a minister for alliances; *f.* **०नी** a cow in heat.  
**संधिनीचीर** *n.* the milk of a cow in heat.  
**संधिवन्ध** *m.* cement, plaster (also = *seq.*\*).  
**\*संधिवन्धन** *n.* join-band, i.e. tendon, nerve.\*  
**संधिवियह** *s.* peace and war; **०क** *m.* minister for p. & w.  
**संधिविपर्यय** *m.* du. peace and its opposite (war).  
**संधिवेला** *f.* time of twilight.  
**संधुक्षण** *a. & n.* kindling, inflaming (*l. & f.*).  
**संधृति** *f.* holding together.  
**संधय** *a.* to be put together; to be propitiated or won over.  
**संध्य** *u.* lying on the point of contact or transition, relating to the euphonic combination. — *f.* **संध्या** time of junction or transition, morning or evening twilight (also = **संध्याकार्य**); the twilight at the beginning or end of a Yuga; *N.* of a river.  
**संध्यक्षर** *n.* compound vowel, diphthong.  
**संध्याश** & **०क** *m.* the twilight of a Yuga.  
**संध्याकार्य** *n.* morning or evening devotion.  
**संध्याकाल** *m.* twilight-time.  
**संध्यापयोद** *m.* rain-cloud in the evening.  
**संध्याबलि** *m.* a twilight-oblation.  
**संध्यासमय** *m.* = **संध्याकाल**.  
**संध्यध** *n.* = **संध्यापयोद**.  
**संध्याय**, **०यते** be like the twilight.  
**संध्यावन्दन** *n.* morning or evening prayer.

**सन्नख** *a.* with joined or closed nails; *w.* **मुष्टि** *m.* a closed fistful.  
**सन्नत** *a.* bent, curved; stooping, bowing to (*gen.*); depressed, deepened, straightened; *du.* yielding to or harmonizing with each other.  
**सन्नति** *f.* depression (*lit. & fig.*), humility, modesty, kindness, favour, complaisance.  
**सन्नतिमन्** *a.* humble, modest.  
**सन्नद्ध** *a.* bound together or round, fastened,
