सूर्मि or सूर्मी f. channel (for water); a tubular vessel serving as a candle-stick.

सूर्थ m. the sun or its deity; f. सूर्था the Sun personified as a female, a cert. hymn of the Rigveda.

सूर्थकर m. a sun-beam.

सूर्थकाम m. the sun-stone (lit. -beloved, a fabulous gem, cf. चन्द्रकाम).
