**Andhra**, pl. (<sup>o</sup>āh), a people. § 284 (Sahadeva): II, 31a, 1175 (in the South).—§ 458 (Kali-yuga): III, 188, 12839.—§ 569 (Bhagavadyānap.): V, 140 $\beta$ , 4751.—§ 571 (Ulukadūt.): V, 160, 5510 (Draviḍā <sup>o</sup>kāñcyaiḥ; C. <sup>o</sup>Andhak<sup>o</sup>); 161, 5555 (do.).—§ 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9 $\mu$ , 357 (a country in Bhārata-varsha).—§ 589 (Dronap.): VII, 4 $\beta$ , 122 (Kalingā<sup>o</sup>, have been vanquished by Karna).—§ 641 (Rājadh.): XII, 65 $\theta$ , 2439 (<sup>o</sup>Madrakāh; among the people mentioned by Indra in setting forth the kshattriya duties).—§ 744 (Ānuçāsanik.): XIII, 48 $\gamma$ , 2587 (<sup>o</sup>rahigrāma-pratiçrayāh, a mixed caste sprung from the Vaidehika).—§ 785 (Anugītāp.): XIV, 83, 2476 (towards the southern ocean). **Āṅga**<sup>1</sup>, pl. (<sup>o</sup>āh), a people (country) descended from Āṅga. § 208 (Astradarçana): I, 136, 5414 (<sup>o</sup>vishaya; Duryodhana installed Karṇa king of Āṅga), 5415 (<sup>o</sup>rājyasya); 137, 5422 (<sup>o</sup>rājyābhishakādrām, i.e. Karna), 5425 (<sup>o</sup>rājyañ *ea*), 5435 (<sup>o</sup>rājyām), 5441 (<sup>o</sup>çvaraṁ, i.e. Karna).—§ 249 (Arjuna-vanavāsap.): I, 215, 7820 (<sup>o</sup>Vāṅga-Kalingeshu).—§ 290 (Çīçupālavadvadhap.): II, 44, 1527 (<sup>o</sup>Vāṅga<sup>o</sup>-vishayādhyaśām, i.e. Karna).—§ 295 (Dyūtāp.): II, 52, 1872 (among those who brought tribute to Yudhishtīra).—§ 391 (Rshyaçṛīga): III, 110, 10008 (<sup>o</sup>ānām īçvara Lomapādāh), 10018 (<sup>o</sup>patir = Lomapāda); 113, 10077 (<sup>o</sup>ādhipateh, i.e. Lomapāda), 10084 (<sup>o</sup>rājām = do.), 10087 (<sup>o</sup>patiñ = do.).—§ 512 (Ghosha-yātrāp.): III, 247, 15052 (<sup>o</sup>rājāñām = Karna).—§ 515 (Karnādigvijaya): III, 254, 15243.—§ 547 (Kundalāharanap.): III, 309, 17167.—§ 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9 $\mu$ , 353 (country in Bharatavarsha).—§ 576 (Bhagavadgītāp.): VI, 17, 664 (<sup>o</sup>patinā = Karna's son Vṛshaketu, PCR).—§ 589 (Dronābhishhek.): VII, 11, 396 (had been vanquished by Kṛṣṇa).—§ 595 (Paraçu-Rāma): VII, 70 $\beta$ , 2436 (Ānya-Vāṅga-Kalingāñ *ea*, slain by Paraçu-Rāma).—§ 599 (Jayadrathavadvadhap.): VII, 93, 3368 (they and the Kalinga king, on elephants, fought against Arjuna, who caused a great carnage among them, on the fourteenth day of the battle).—§ 604 (Karnap.): VIII, 8, 236 (caused by Karna to pay tribute to Duryodhana, cf. § 515).—§ 605 (Karnap.): VIII, 17, 671 (Kalinga-Vāṅga-Nishādāvīrah, attacked Arjuna with a division of elephants, which is broken, on the sixteenth day of the battle); 22 $\rho$ , 863 (fought against Dhṛṣṭadyumna, etc., on the sixteenth day of the battle), 881.—§ 608 (Karnap.): VIII, 70, 3500 (Kalinga-Vāṅga<sup>o</sup>-Nishāda-Māgadāh, were being slain by Bhīma on the seventeenth day of the battle).—§ 621 (Rājadh.): XII, 5, 134 (Karna became king not only of the A., but forthwith

also over Campā, having vanquished Jarāsandha).—§ 641 (Rājadh.): XII, 122, 4469 (Āṅgeshu rājā Vasuhomo, discourse between him and king Māndhātṛ at Muñjapṛshṭha).

**Āṅga**<sup>5</sup>. § 768b (Kṛṣṇa Vāsudeva): XIII, 147, 6828 (*Manoh* putrah, incarnation of Kṛṣṇa).

**Āṅga**<sup>6</sup>. § 772c (Kaçyapa): XIII, 155, 7232 (wished to give away the whole earth to the brahmans; cf. Āṅgāh, XIII, 7214).

**Āṅga**<sup>7</sup>, the Āṅga king at the time of Yudhishtīra. § 264 (Sabhākriyāp.): II, 4 $\beta$ , 119, 120 (among the kings present when Yudhishtīra entered his palace).—§ 342 (Indralokābhig.): III, 51, 1988 (*sa*-Bangāñān mahipālān).—

§ 592 (Samçaptakavadvadhap.): VII, 26, 1142 (called Mlecca king; was slain by Bhimasena on the twelfth day of the battle).—§ 605 (Karnap.): VIII, 22, 873 (called Mlecca king, and was slain by Nakula on the sixteenth day of the battle), 877, 878. Cf. Āṅgaputra.

**Āṅga**<sup>8</sup>, the Āṅga country or adj. § 170 (Dirghatamas): I, 104, 4220 (Āṅgasyāṅgo'bharad dēço).

**Āṅga**<sup>9</sup>, one or the other of the Āṅga kings of the past. § 277 (Jarāsandhavadvadhap.): II, 21, 804 (<sup>o</sup>Vāṅgādayah rājānāh).

**Āṅgada**<sup>1</sup>, a monkey chief, son of Vālin. § 534 (Hanūmat-pratyāgam.): III, 282, 16224 (*Vāli-putro*).—§ 535 (Setubandhana): III, 283 $\beta$ , 16287 (protected the army of Rāma), 16322 (was sent by Rāma as his envoy to Rāvana).

—§ 536 (Laṅkāpraveça): III, 284, 16329, 16341 (his deportation in Laṅkā).—§ 540 (Indrajīdyuddha): III, 288, 16451, 16453 (fought Indrajit).—§ 541 (Indrajīdvadha): III, 289 $\alpha$ , 16468, 16477 (was among those who surrounded Rāma and Lakshmana against Indrajit).—§ 542 (Rāvapavadha): III, 290 $\alpha$ , 16500 (attacked Rāvana).—§ 543 (Rāmābhiseka): III, 291, 16589 (was installed as yuvarāja in Kishkindhyā).
