**Bālhīka<sup>7</sup>** (pl. °āḥ), a people (probably Balkh, VP.). § 279 (Arjuna): II, 27, 1030 (conquered by Arjuna).—§ 295 (Dyūtāp.): II, 52, 1869 (*Kairatā Daradā Darvāḥ . . . Pārāda Vāhlikaiḥ saha*, etc.; bring tribute to Yudhiṣṭhīra).—§ 559 (Prajāgarap.): V, 39, 1525 (*malam prthivyā Vāhlikāḥ, etc.*).—§ 573 (Ambop.): V, 195, 7607 (*Vindānuwindāv Āvāntyau Kaikeyā Vāhlikaiḥ saha | prayayuh sarva evaite Bhāradrājapurogamāḥ*).—§ 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9 $\mu$ , 361 (in Bhāratavarsha).—§ 576 (Bhagavadgītāp.): VI, 205, 1750 (in Bhīṣma's division were all the Dhārtarāshṭras with Vāhlikānām *ekadeṣaḥ Čalaḥ ca*, etc.); VI, 2084, v. Bālhīka. —§ 583 (Bhīṣmavadhāp.): VI, 75 $\gamma$ , 3293 (Kṛtavarmān, accompanied by *Kāmbogavara-Vāhlikaiḥ*, was

in the head of Bhīṣma's crane-array on the sixth day of the battle); VI, 3533, v. Bālhīka<sup>3</sup>; VI, 4666, v.
