**Kaikeyī**<sup>1</sup> ("daughter of the Kekaya king") = Sunandā, the wife of Sarvabhauma: I, 11, 3769 (S<sup>o</sup>, mother of Jayatsena).

**Kaikeyī**<sup>1</sup> (do.), wife of Ajamīḍha. § 156 (Pūrvavāṇī.); I, 95, 11, 3790.

**Kaikeyī**<sup>1</sup> (do.) = Kumāri, the wife of Bhīmasena Pārikshita: I, 11, 3796 (K<sup>o</sup>, mother of Pratiçravas).

**Kaikeyī**<sup>1</sup> (do.), wife of Daçaratha. § 525 (Rāmopākhyānap.): III, 274, 15879 (mother of Bharata); 277, 15960, 15961, 15975, 15989 (prevailed upon Daçaratha to banish Rāma and install Bharata as heir apparent. Bharata, however, would only keep the realm for Rāma).
