

Kālikeya, a Kuru warrior, son of Subala. § 593 (Abhimanyuvadhap.): VII, 49, 1933 (*Subaladāvāndam*, defeated by Abhimanyu).

Kalinda, a warrior of Skanda. § 615u (Skanda): IX, 45 γ , 2566 (only C., B. has *Kalingah*).

Kalinda, pl. (XIII, 2104) v. *Kalinga*, pl.

Kalinga¹. § 170 (Dirghatamas): I, 104, 4219 (son of Dirghatamas on Sudeshnā the wife of King Bali), 4220 (*Kalingavishaya caiva K°ya ca sa smṛtah*).

Kalinga² (B. often *Kā*), the king of the Kalingas at the time of Yudhishtira. § 232 (Svayamvarap.): I, 186, 6993 (also B., present at the svayamvara of Draupadi).—§ 562 (Bhagavadyānap.): V, 95 ν , 3403 (also B., in the army of Duryodhana).—§ 579 (Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 54 ν , 2235 (B., *Kā*), 2252 (do.), (12), 2301 (do.), 2302 (do., named Çrutāyus), 2307 (do.).—§ 589 (Dronābhishhekap.): VII, 7 γ , 179 (also B., on the right wing of Drona's array).—§ 596 (Pratijñāp.): VII, 74 β , 2629 (*udāyudhah*, will protect Jayadratha; B. has *Kā*).—§ 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 93, 3369 (*pramukhā nṛpāḥ*, attacked Arjuna).—§ 600 (Ghaṭotkacavadvaph.): VII, 155, 6703 (*oṣya sutah*, fought with Bhimasena; B. has *Kā*).—§ 604 (Karnap.): VIII, 5, 123 (*oṣyakau bhrātarau* (?)). Cf. *Kalinga*.

(*oāh*), a people. § 130 (Ampāvat.): I, 67, 2701 (*eshu narādhipah*, named Kuhara (?), among the incarnations from the Krodhavaça gana).—§ 170 (Dirghatamas): I, 104, 4220 (*oishaya caira Kalingasya ca sa smṛtah*).—§ 249 (Arjunavanavāsap.): I, 215, 7820 (*Anga-Vāṅga-K°eshu yāni tīrthāni kānicit*, visited by Arjuna), 7821 (*rāshtradvāreshu*), 7823.—§ 284 (Sahadeva): II, 31, 1175 (vanquished by Sahadeva on his digvijaya).—§ 295 (Dyūtap.): II, 52, 1874 (among the peoples who brought tribute to Yudhishtira).—§ 392 (Tirthayātrāp.): III, 114, 10097 (on his tirthayātrā Yudhishtira came to the country of the *K.*), 10098.—§ 515 (Karnadigvijaya): III, 254, 15243 (vanquished by Karṇa on his digvijaya).—§ 554 (Sainyodyogap.): V, 4 γ , 87 (*oānam īvaraḥ*, among the princes to whom the Pāṇḍavas ought to send messengers).—§ 556d (Sahadeva): V, 23, 1708 (Sahadeva had vanquished the *K.* in Dantakūra).—§ 561e (Krishna Vāsudeva); V, 48, 1883 (Krishna had destroyed the *K.* in Dantakūra).—§ 561e (Bhimasena): V, 50, 1986 (had been vanquished by Bhimasena).—§ 561g (Sahadeva): V, 50, 1997 (had been vanquished by Sahadeva).—§ 561 (Yānasandhip.): V, 50, 2002 (had been vanquished by Çikhandin).—§ 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9 μ , 347 (only C., B. has *Pulindāḥ*), 349 (only B., C. has *Bhuīngāḥ*), 353, (o), 376 (in the north-east (!) of Bhāratavarsha).—§ 576 (Bhagavadgitāp.): VI, 17, 668 (*patih sarva - K°ānām*, in Duryodhana's army).—§ 579 (Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 53 ϵ , 2231 (*senā K°ānām*, attacked Bhimasena), (o), 2234 (fought with Bhimasena); 54 ν , 2238 (*oānām mahācamānum*), 2239, 2241 (*oānām janādhipah*, i.e. Çrutāyus), 2249, (o), 2250, 2252, 2259 (*oānām mahārathah*, i.e. Çrutāyus), 2270 (*oānām varūthinīm*), (o), 2299 (*senā K°ānām*), 2300 (*oānām*), 2302, 2311, 2312, 2314, 2315 (o), 2329, 2336, 2337 (headed by Çrutāyus the *K.* fought with Bhimasena who slew them).—§ 580 (do.): VI, 56 δ , 2409 (in Bhishma's gāruḍavyūha).—§ 585 (do.): VI, 87 δ , 3854 (followed Bhagadatta).—§ 587 (do.): VI, 117 ρ , 5483 (attacked Arjuna).—§ 589 (Dronābhishhekap.): VII, 4 β , 122 (*oāndhrāḥ*, had formerly been vanquished by Karna); 11 ν ,

397 (had formerly been vanquished by Krishṇa).—§ 592 (Samçaptakavadvaph.): VII, 20 γ , 798 (in the neck of Drona's gāruḍavyūha), (o), 802 (in the back of do.).—§ 595 (Shodacarāj., v. Rāma Jāmadagnya); VII, 70 β , 2436 (*Anga-Vāṅga-K°ān*, have been vanquished by Rāma Jāmadagnya).—§ 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 141, 5851 (fought with Sātyaki), 5852.—§ 600 (Ghaṭotkacavadvaph.): VII, 155, 6703 (*oānām ca sainyena*), 6705 (Bhimasena fought with the *K.*, headed by the son of their slain king, and slew also the latter).—§ 603 (Nārāyaṇāstramokshap.): VII, 193 β , 8905 (*oānāta-Bāhlikaiḥ*, followed Kṛtavarman).—§ 604 (Karnap.): VIII, 5 ζ , 127 (*Çibayah . . . K°saḥitāḥ*, have been vanquished in the battle); 8 η , 237 (had formerly been vanquished by Karṇa).—§ 605 (do.): VIII, 17, 671 (*o-Vāṅga-Nishādavīrāḥ* attack Arjuna); 22 ζ , 864 (attack Dhṛṣṭadyumna) (o), 882 (attack Nakula).—§ 608 (do.): VIII, 68λλλ, 13390 (it had been prophesied that Arjuna would subjugate the *K.*, etc.); 70πππ, 3500 (slain by Bhimasena).—§ 613 (Gadāyuddhap.): IX, 33 η , 1913 (had been slain in the battle).—§ 621 (Rājad.): XII, 4, 109 (*oishaye*, ruled by Citrāngada).—§ 739 (*Ānuçāsanik.*): XIII, 33 a , 2104 (among the kshatriyas who have been degraded to cūdras). Kalinga¹ ("the king of the Kalingas," named Çrutāyudha or Çrutāyus). § 264 (Sabhākriyāp.): II, 4 β , 121 (*Çrutāyudhah*, in the palace of Yudhishtira).—§ 290 (Çicupālavadvaph.): II, 44, 1540.—§ 561 (Yānasandhip.): V, 62ββ, 2426 (*Āvantya-K-Jayadratheshu*).—§ 576 (Bhagavadgitāp.): VI, 16 a , 623 (*Çrutāyudhah*, commanded one *akshauhiṇi* of Duryodhana's army); 17, 662 (*Paurava-K°āh*, in the van of Duryodhana's army).—§ 579 (Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 53 ϵ , 2230; 54 ν , 2236 (i.e. Çrutāyus, proceeded against Bhimasena), 2254, 2258 (*oṣya sutah*, i.e. Çukradeva), 2262, 2265, (o), 2305, 2308 (is slain by Bhimasena); 2309 (the protectors of his wheels are slain).—§ 619 (Strīvilāpap.): XI, 25 κ , 711 (mentioned among the slain). Cf. *Kalinga*.

Kalingādhīpati(do.): § 582 (Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 71 γ , 3132 (supported Çakuni). Cf. *Kalinga*.

Kalingaka(do.): § 576 (Bhagavadgitāp.): VI, 17, 670 (= Çrutāyudha ?). Cf. *Kalinga*.

Kalingaka(do.): § 287 (Rājasūyikap.): II, 34, 1270 (came to the rājasūya of Yudhishtira). Cf. *Kalinga*.

Kalingarāja(do.): § 579 (Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 54, 2354 (i.e. Çrutāyus, slain by Bhimasena). Cf. *Kalinga*.

Kalingī¹ ("daughter of the king of the Kalingas") = Karambā: I, 1775 (*K°*, wife of Akrodhana).
