Kampa² = Çiva (1000 names¹).

Kamsa, son of Ugrasena, king of Mathurā, enemy of Krshna. § 10 (Anukram.): I, 2, 357 (°vadhaḥ, related in Harivamṣa). — § 130 (Amçāvat.): I, 67, 2703 (*Ugrasenāsutaḥ*, incarnation of the Asura Kālanemi). — § 273 (Rājasūyārbambhap.): II, 14, 594 (married Asti and Prāpti, the daughters of Jarāsandha), 598 (Kamsa and [his brother] Sunāman were slain by Krshna and Balarāma), 610 (°bhāryā, the widow of *K.* urged Jarāsandha to attack Mathurā). — § 275 (do.): II, 19, 761 (nihate Vāsudevena tādā K°e). — § 276 (do.): II, 20, 768 (hataḥ). — § 290 (Çīcupālavadvadhap.): II, 41, 1443 (*yaaya cānena*—i.e. by Krshna—*dharmajña bhuktam annam bahyacāḥ sa cānena hataḥ K°a*). — § 298 (Dyūtap.): II, 62, 2100 (the Andhakas, the Yādavas, and the Bhojas abandoned *K.* who was then slain by Krshna). — § 549f (Durgā): IV, 6, 180 (°vidrāvaṇakarīm, sc.
