

Having repeatedly comforted *Duryodhana*, they retired headed by *Açvathāman*. *Karṇa* did not lose his splendour. D., R., etc., retired. The portents that were seen at *Karṇa's* fall. *Arjuna* and *Kṛṣṇa* blew their conches, at which the *Kauravas* left the field, deserting *Calya* and *Duryodhana*. D., G., men, Cā., M.-r., Y., and M.-U. congratulated *Kṛṣṇa* and *Arjuna* (VIII, 94). Enumeration of the *Kauravas* retiring from the field (*av'*). Urged by *Kṛṣṇa* (*aφ'*), who told *Dhrṣṭadyumna*, etc., etc. (*ax'*), to stand there with care, *Arjuna* presented himself to *Yudhiṣṭhīra*, who, rising from his bed, greeted *Arjuna* and *Kṛṣṇa*; *Kṛṣṇa* congratulated *Yudhiṣṭhīra* (*ay'*), who ascribed his success to *Kṛṣṇa's* influence (*aw'*). *Yudhiṣṭhīra*, with *Kṛṣṇa* and *Arjuna*, came back to the field to have a look at *Karṇa's* body. The kings, filled with joy, approached *Yudhiṣṭhīra* and gladdened him greatly; so *Nakula*, etc. (*ba'*). *Dhṛtarāshṭra* and *Gāndhāri* swooned away and were comforted by *Vidura*, *Saṅjayā*, and the *Kuru* ladies. [**Karnasambhava**] (“the origin of *Karṇa*”). § 175 (Sambhavap.): *Karṇa's* birth, etc. Indra's asking for his natural armour (repetition from §§ 131 (v. *Kunti*) and 131b (v. *Karṇa*); cf. also § 547) (I, 111).

**Karnasuta**<sup>1</sup> (“the son of *Karṇa*”) = Vṛshasena: VII, 6363 (*V°*), 6408, 7540; VIII, †4329, †4343. Cf. *Karnaputra*, *Karnātmaja*, *Karṇi*.

**Karnasuta**<sup>2</sup> (do.) = Bhānuṣena: VIII, 2262. Cf. *Karnaputra*.

**Karnasuta**, dual. (*au*). § 604 (Karnap.): VIII, 7, †211.

**Karnāṭa**: III, 16352 (read with B. *karnāṭṭa*<sup>o</sup>).

**Karnāṭaka**, pl. (*āḥ*), a people. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9<sub>v</sub>, 366 (in the south).

**Karnātmaja**<sup>1</sup> (“the son of *Karṇa*”) = Vṛshasena: VII, 626, 627; VIII, †4281, †4282, †4292, †4336. Cf. *Karnaputra*, *Karnasuta*, *Karṇi*.

**Karnātmaja**<sup>2</sup> (do.) = Satyasandha: VIII, †210 (*S°*).

**Karnātmaja**<sup>3</sup> (do.) = Sushena: VIII, †3816. Cf. *Karnaputra*.

**Karnātmaja**<sup>4</sup> (do.) = Prasena: VIII, †4183 (*P°*). Cf. *Karnaputra*.

**Karnikāramahāsragvin** = Īśa (1000 names<sup>2</sup>).

**Karnikārasrajapriya** = Īśa (1000 names<sup>1</sup>).

**Karoṭaka**, a serpent. § 47 (Sarpanāmak.): I, 35, 1553 (enumeration).

**Karpata**, v. Pañcakarpata.

**Kṛṣṇa**, adj. (“composed by *Kṛṣṇa*, i.e. Vyāsa”). § 7 (Anukram.): I, 1, 261 (<sup>o</sup>m *vedam*, i.e. the Mahābhārata).—

§ 72 (Ādīvācāvataranap.): I, 62, 2300 (do.).—§ 795 (Svargārohanap.): XVIII, 5, 188 (do.).

**Kārshṇi**<sup>1</sup>, a Devagandharva. § 191 (Arjuna): I, 123, 4812 (among the Devagandharvas who sang at the birth of Arjuna).

**Kārshṇi**<sup>2</sup> (“the son of *Kṛṣṇa* [Vāsudeva]”) = Pradyumna: III, †10233, †10270; V, †668 (<sup>o</sup>pratimāṁ, sc. Sātyaki); VII, 4263 (*Makaradvajah*).

**Kārtasvara**, a Daitya (?). § 673b (Bali-Vāsavasamav.): XII, 227a, 8264 (among the ancient rulers of the earth).

**Kārtavirya** (“the son of Kṛtavirya”) = Arjuna, the Haihaya king: I, 444 (<sup>o</sup>vadhaḥ), 4794 (<sup>o</sup>samāḥ, sc. Arjuna Pāṇḍava); II, 321 (in the palace of Yama), 649 (became emperor (*samrāj*) by the energy of his asceticism), 877 (among the kings who met with destruction, having disregarded their superiors); III, 141 (had delivered his people by means of tapas), 492 (<sup>o</sup>samāḥ, sc. Bhoja), 8273 (<sup>o</sup>ārjuno yathā), 8465 (<sup>o</sup>sya, sc. lokān), 10134 (*Haihayādhipateḥ*), 10142, 10189, 10193, 10197, 10201, 10202 bis, 10889 (<sup>o</sup>samāṇ yudhe . . . *Phalgunam*); V, 2377 (*sadr̥çāṇ bāhuvinīyona K°syā Pāṇḍavam*, i.e. Arjuna), 3157 (*ishvastre sadr̥co rājñāḥ K°syā*, sc. Arjuna Pāṇḍava); VII, 2429 (is slain by Rāma Jāmadagnya), 3648, 6032 (<sup>o</sup>samo yudhi, sc. Cūra), 8971 (<sup>o</sup>samo virye, sc. Aṣvathāman); VIII, 144 (*K°cā rāmēna Bhārgavēna yathā hataḥ*), 1263 (<sup>o</sup>samāṇ virye *Karnam*), 4397 (<sup>o</sup>samau, sc. Karna and Arjuna Pāṇḍava), 4743 (<sup>o</sup>samo yudhi, sc. **Kārtayuga**, adj. (“relating to Kṛtayuga”). § 149 (Yayāti): I, 90, †3600 (<sup>o</sup>pradhāna, sc. Yayāti).—§ 641 (Rājadh.): XII, 69, 2681 (*dharmān*).—§ 717b (Nārāyaṇīya): XII, 341, 13062 (<sup>o</sup>dharma<sup>o</sup>).
