

**Konvaçira**, pl. (<sup>o</sup>āh), a people. § 739 (Ānuçāsanik.): XIII, 35<sub>e</sub>, 2158 (have been degraded to qūdras).

**Kopavega**, a muni. § 264 (Sabhākriyāp.): II, 4a, 111 (waited upon Yudhishthira).

**Kosala** (C. Koç<sup>o</sup>), pl. (āh), a people. § 273 (Rājasūyārambhap.): II, 14, 591 (*pūrvāh*, fled before Jarāsandha).—§ 276 (Jarāsandhavadhap.): II, 20, 795 (*pūrvām ca Koçalān*, only B., C. has *pūrvām ca Koçalām*).—§ 280 (Bhīmasena): II, 30, 1077 (*uttarān*, vanquished by Bhīmasena on his digvijaya).—§ 281 (Sahadeva): II, 31, 1117 (*prāk-Kōān nrpān*, so C., B. has *Prākotakān nrpān*, vanquished by Sahadeva on his digvijaya).—§ 347 (Nalopākhyānap.): III, 61, 2319 (only B., C. has *Koçalām*).—§ 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9<sub>μ</sub>, 347.—§ 578 (Bhīshmavadhap.): VI, 51<sub>v</sub>, 2105 (in the army of Duryodhana).—§ 589 (Dronābhishhekāp.): VII, 11<sub>v</sub>, 397 (*Kāçi-Kōān*, have formerly been vanquished by Krshna, C. has -*Kauç<sup>o</sup>*).—§ 592 (Samçaptakavadvadhap.): VII, 21<sub>θ</sub>, 877 (*Matsya-Karūsha-Kōāh*, attack Drona); 24<sub>σ</sub>, 1052 (have sided with Yudhishthira).—§ 593 (Abhimanyuvadhap.): VII, 47, 1879 (<sup>o</sup>ānām adhipāh, i.e. Brāhadbala), 1881 (<sup>o</sup>ānām bharārām—B. *adhipam*—*rājaputraṇ Brāhadbalām*).—§ 599 (Jayadrathavadvadhap.): VII, 125<sub>μμ</sub>, 5069 (*Kāçi-Kōāh*, attack Drona).—§ 600 (Ghatotkacavadvadhap.): VII, 156<sub>ι</sub>, 6779 (*Cedi-Karūsha-Kōāh*, follow Arjuna against Drona).—§ 604 (Karnap.): VIII, 5<sub>ζ</sub>, 110 (<sup>o</sup>ānām adhipatih, i.e. Brāhadbala has been slain by Abhimanyu, C. has by error *Kailasānām*); 8, 236 (*Kāçi-Kōān*, had been vanquished by Karna for Duryodhana).—§ 605 (do.): VIII, 128<sub>ββ</sub>, 459 (in the army of Yudhishthira); 22<sub>ξξ</sub>, 864 (attack Dhṛṣṭadyumna).—§ 607 (do.): VIII, 44<sub>μ</sub>, 2084 (know the eternal religion, *dharmaṇ*); 45<sub>v</sub>, 2105 (*prekṣhitajñāh*).—§ 608 (do.): VIII, 49<sub>χ</sub>, 2334 (*Kāçi-Kōāh*, attack Karna); 54<sub>ηη</sub>, 2564 (are slain by Arjuna).—§ 619 (Strīvilāp.): XI, 25<sub>κ</sub>, 715 (<sup>o</sup>ānām adhipatiṇ Brāhadbalām).—§ 641 (Rājadh.): XII, 82, 3060 (<sup>o</sup>ānām adhipatiṇ, ruled by Kshemadarçin).—§ 744 (Ānuçāsanik.): XIII, 44<sub>β</sub>, 2441 (had been vanquished by Bhīshma at the svayamvara of Ambā, etc.).—§ 785 (Anugītāp.): XIV, 82, 2464 (*Puṇḍrān sa-Kōān*); 83, 2469 (vanquished by Arjuna when he followed the sacrificial horse). **Kosala** = Rūparṇa: III, 2897 (so B., C. has *Kauçalāh*).

**Kosalā** (C. Koç<sup>o</sup>) = Ayodhyā. § 276 (Jarāsandhavadhap.): II, 20, 795 (v. Kosala, pl.).—§ 347 (Nalopākhyānap.): III, 61, 2319 (v. Kosala, pl.).—§ 353 (do.): III, 78, 2978 (the residence of king Rūparṇa).—§ 370 (Tirthayātrāp.): III, 85, 8152 (*Rshabham tīrtham āśādyā Kōāyām*), 8153 (<sup>o</sup>ān tu samāśādyā *Kālatīrtham upaspr̄cet*).—§ 515 (Karnadigvijaya): III, 254, 15246 (conquered by Karna on his digvijaya).—§ 530 (*Vīçvāvasumokshaṇa*): III, 279, 16077 (<sup>o</sup>ātām, sc. Rāma Dāçarathi).—§ 615<sub>i</sub> (Saptasārasvata): IX, 38, 2208 (*uttare Kōbhage*, there Uddalaka performed a sacrifice, at which the River Sarasvatī appeared as Manorāmā).

**Kosalādhīpa<sup>1</sup>** (C. Koç<sup>o</sup>) ("the king of the Kosalas") = Kshemadarçin: XII, 3879.

**Kosalādhīpa<sup>2</sup>** (do.) (do.) = Saudāsa (Kalmāshapāda): XIII, 326 (<sup>o</sup>ās).

**Kosalādhīpati<sup>1</sup>** (do.) (do.), the king of the Kosalas at the time of Yudhishthira. § 232 (Svayamvarap.): I, 186, 7002 (present at the svayamvara of Draupadi).—§ 280 (Bhīmasena): II, 30, 1075 (*Brāhadbalām*, vanquished by Bhīmasena on his digvijaya).—§ 281 (Sahadeva): II, 31, 1117 (the same?, vanquished by Sahadeva on his digvijaya).—§ 592 (Samçaptakavadvadhap.): VII, 23<sub>σ</sub>, 1004 (<sup>o</sup>āh *putraṇ Sukshatram*). Cf. Brāhadbala.

**Kosalādhīpati<sup>2</sup>** (do.) (do.) = Rūparṇa: III, 2877.

**Kosalaka** (C. Koç<sup>o</sup>), adj. ("belonging to the Kosalas"). § 578 (Bhīshmavadhap.): VI, 44, 1684 (*rājā*, i.e. Brāhadbala).

**Kosalārāja** (C. Koç<sup>o</sup>) ("the king of the Kosalas") = Brāhadbala: VII, 1880.

**Kosalēçvara** (do.) (do.) = Sudāsa: XIII, 7682.

**Kosalendra<sup>1</sup>** (do.) (do.) = Rāma Dāçarathi: III, 16332, 16344.

**Kosalendra<sup>2</sup>** (do.) (do.) = Brāhadbala: VI, 5406, 5407.

**Koshā**, a river. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9<sub>λ</sub>, 342 (only B., C. has *Koçā*).

**Koshthavat**, a mountain. § 782g (Guruçishyas.): XIV, 43<sub>η</sub>, 1174 (among the principal mountains).

**Kotarā**, a mātr. § 615<sub>u</sub> (Skanda): IX, 46<sub>θ</sub>, 2635.

**Kotaraka**, a serpent. § 564 (Mātaliyop.): V, 103<sub>γ</sub>, 3628 (enumeration).

**Kotiça**, a serpent. § 63 (Sarpasattra): I, 57, 2146 (of Vāsuki's race).

**Kotika** = Kotikāsyā: III, 15586, (15615).

**Kotikāsyā**, a prince, follower of Jayadratha. § 522 (Draupadīharaṇap.): III, 264, 15582 (*rājānam*), 15587; 265, (+15588), +15593 (*Surāhasya putrah*); 266, 15605 (*Surāhasya putram*); 267, 15612; 271, 15720, 15739 (is slain by Bhīmasena). Cf. Kotika.

**Kotitīrtha**, name of various tīrthas. § 358 (Tirthayātrāp.): III, 82, 4091 (*Mahākālām tato gacchen niyato niyatācanah | Kōm upaspr̄cya hayamedhaphalam labhet*).—§ 362 (do.): III, 83, 5087 (*tataḥ Pañcanādām galvā niyatāh niyatācanah | Kōm upaspr̄cya hayamedhaphalam labhet*).—§ 368 (do.): III, 83, 7071 (*abhirādyā tato Yakshaṇ dvārapālam Macakrukam | Kōm upaspr̄cya labhed bahusuvārṇakam*).—§ 370 (do.): III, 84, 8005 (*tatrābhīshēkam kurvita—i.e. at Gaṅgādvāra—Kōe samāhitāh | puṇḍarīkam avāpnoti kulañ caiva samuddhāret*), 8055 (<sup>o</sup>ānām snātvā arcayitvā *Guhām nṛpa | gosahasraphalam vindyāt tejasī ca bhaven narah*).—§ 372 (do.): III, 85, 8204 (<sup>o</sup>ānām snātvā gosahasraphalam labhet).

**krama** (a certain method of reciting the Vedas): XII, 13261 (<sup>o</sup>āksharavīt), 13262 (<sup>o</sup>āprāgah), 13263; XIII, 4107 (*pada-kōvibhūshitāh*, sc. rgvedah).

**Krama<sup>1</sup>** = Çiva (1000 names<sup>2</sup>). Do.<sup>3</sup> = Vishṇu (1000 names).

**Kramajit**, a prince. § 264 (Sabhākriyāp.): II, 4<sub>θ</sub>, 123 (waited upon Yudhishthira).

**Krami**, pl. (V, 2729); v. Kr̄mi, pl.

**Krātha<sup>1</sup>**, an Asura. § 130 (Amçāvat.): I, 67, 2665 (*mahāsurāh*, incarnate as king Parvatiya; only C., B. has *Kapālah*).

**Krātha<sup>2</sup>**, a king. § 130 (Amçāvat.): I, 67, 2697 (among the incarnations from the Krodhvavaça gana).

**Krātha<sup>3</sup>**, a king. § 280 (Bhīmasena): II, 30, 1081 (*Supārçvam abhitāh*, vanquished by Bhīmasena on his digvijaya). Cf. Krātha<sup>2</sup>.

**Krātha<sup>4</sup>**, a rishi. § 562 (Bhagavadyānap.): V, 83<sub>η</sub>, 2946 (worshipped Kr̄shṇa).

**Krātha<sup>5</sup>**, a Kuru warrior. § 599 (Jayadrathavadvadhap.): VII, 120<sub>δδ</sub>, 4768.

**Krātha<sup>6</sup>**, a warrior of Skanda. § 615<sub>u</sub> (Skanda): IX, 45, 2572.

**Krātha<sup>7</sup>**, pl. (<sup>o</sup>āh), a people. § 273 (Rājasūyārambhap.): II, 14, 585 (*vidyābalād yo vyājāt Pāṇḍya-Kō-Kaiçikān*, sc. Bhīshmaka).

**Krātha<sup>8</sup>**, son of the elder Dhṛtarāshṭra. § 154 (Pūruvāṇç.): I, 94, 3747.

**Krātha<sup>9</sup>** ("the king of the Krāthas"?), various princes.
