Krodhānā, a mātr. § 615a (Skanda): IX, 469, 2624.

Krodhavaça, pl. (°āh), a class of Rākshasas. § 432 (Saugandhikāharana): III, 153, 11361 (°ā nāma Rākshasāh); 154, †11385, 11392 (sought in vain to prevent Bhimasena from gathering saugandhikas, but 100 of them were slain).—§ 553 (Vaiyāhikap.): IV, 71, 2292 (°ān hatvā parvate Gandhamādāno, sc. Kreccha = Mahāpurusha (Mahāpurushastava).
