**Kṛtin**, a king. § 295 (Dyūtap.): II, 52, 1882 (*rājā Āśukardānām*, brought tribute to Yudhiṣṭhīra).

**Kṛtisuta** ("son of Kṛti") = Ruciparvan: VII, 1177 (*R<sup>o</sup>*).

**Kṛttikā**, pl. (*ōāh*), the six wives of the seven ṛshis, name of a constellation (the Pleiads). § 116 (Vasu, pl.): I, 68, 2588 (*ōabhyupapatteś ca Kārttikeya iti smṛtah*, sc. Skanda).—§ 370 (Tirthayātrāp.): III, 84, 8029 (*ō-Maghayoṣ caiva tīrtham*).—§ 412 (Ashṭāvakriya): III, 134, 10663 (*shat*).—§ 488 (Āngirasa): III, 217, 14103 (*Radrāo ca sambhuto Gaṅgāyām K<sup>o</sup>asu ca*, sc. **Kshapā** = Sūrya (the Sun): III, 150.—Do.,<sup>3</sup> pl. (*ōāh*) = Cīva (1000 names<sup>2</sup>).

**Kshapācara**, pl. ("night-walkers") = Rākshasa, pl.: III, 16506.—Do. sg.: III, 16497 (= Rāvana); V, 7539 (= Sthūna).

\***kshapanaka**, a religious mendicant: I, ††789, ††790.

**Kshara** = Vishṇu (Kṛṣṇa): XII, 13115; XIII, 7000 (1000 names).

**Kshatradeva**, son of Āśukhaṇḍin. § 561 (Yānasandhip.): V, 57o, 2263 (has joined the Pāñḍavas).—§ 572 (Rathā-tirathasaṅkhyānap.): V, 171, 5902 (among the rathas of the army of the Pāñḍavas).—§ 573 (Ambopākhyānap.): V, 196χ, 7646.—§ 585 (Bhīṣmavadhap.): VI, 93ψ, 4152 (followed Bhīmasena); 95δ, 4254, (εε), 4271, 4309 (Bhagadatta pierced his right arm).—§ 589 (Dronābhīṣhekāp.): VII, 10λ, 358.—§ 590 (do.): VII, 14, 543 (fought with Lakshmana).—§ 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 21κ, 904 (fought with Drona), 910; 23o, 955 (Cāikhaṇḍīḥ, description of his horses), 974 (Cāikhaṇḍīḥ putram, description of his horses).—§ 604 (Karnap.): VIII, 6, 176 (Cāikhaṇḍītanayāḥ, has been slain by Lakshmana). Cf. Cāikhaṇḍī, Cāikhaṇḍītanaya.

**Kshatradharman**, son of Dhṛṣṭadyumna. § 572 (Rathā-tirathasaṅkhyānap.): V, 171, 5899 (*Dhṛṣṭadyumnaś tanayāḥ*, is a half ratha).—§ 585 (Bhīṣmavadhap.): VI, 93ψ, 4152.—§ 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 21κ, 903 (attacked Drona); 23o, 954 (goṇāçvāḥ).—§ 593 (Abhimanyuvadhap.): VII, 35δ, 1509 (proceeded against Drona).—§ 598 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 85δ, 3049 (*Saumakīḥ*).—§ 599 (do.): VII, 125, 5079, 5082 (is slain by Drona).—§ 604 (Karnap.): VIII, 6, 175 (had been slain by Drona). **Kshatrahan**, a Pāñḍava warrior. § 573 (Ambopākhyānap.): V, 196, 7646 (*ōhā Kshatradevaś ca*, C.; but B. has *Kshatradeva-Brahmadeva*, in the rear of the army of the Pāñḍavas).

**Kshatrañjaya**, a Pāñḍava warrior. § 589 (Dronābhīṣhekāp.): VII, 10λ, 358 (son of Dhṛṣṭadyumna?, attacked Drona).

**Kshatravarman** = Kshatradharman (?). § 589 (Dronābhīṣhekāp.): VII, 10λ, 358 (attacked Drona).—§ 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 25, 1073, 1074 (only B., C. has by error *Kṛtav<sup>o</sup>*), 1076 (fought with Jayadratha).
