Kṛttikā, pl. (*°āḥ*), the six wives of the seven ṛshis, name of a constellation (the Pleiads). § 116 (Vasu, pl.): I, 66, 2588 (*°abhyūpapatteç ca Kārttikeya iti smṛtaḥ*, sc. Skanda).—§ 370 (Tīrthayātrāp.): III, 84, 8029 (*°Maghayoç caiva tīrtham*).—§ 412 (Aštāvakra): III, 134, †10663 (*shaḥ*).—§ 488 (Āngirasa): III, 217, 14103 (*Radrāo ca sambhūto Gaṅgāyām K^oāsu ca*, sc. Kshapācara, pl. ("night-walkers") = Rākshasa, pl.: III, 16506.—Do. sg.: III, 16497 (= Rāvana); V, 7539 (= Sthūpa).

***kshapanaka**, a religious mendicant: I, ††789, ††790.

Kshara = Vishṇu (Kṛshṇa): XII, 13115; XIII, 7000 (1000 names).

Kshatradeva, son of Çikhaṇḍin. § 561 (Yānasandhip.): V, 57*o*, 2263 (has joined the Pāṇḍavas).—§ 572 (Rathā-tirathasaṅkhyānap.): V, 171, 5902 (among the rathas of the army of the Pāṇḍavas).—§ 573 (Ambopākhyānap.): V, 196*χ*, 7646.—§ 585 (Bhīshmavadhap.): VI, 93*ψ*, 4152 (followed Bhīmasena); 95*δδ*, 4254, (*°e*), 4271, 4309 (Bhagadatta pierced his right arm).—§ 589 (Dronābhishekap.): VII, 10*λ*, 358.—§ 590 (do.): VII, 14, 543 (fought with Lakshmana).—§ 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 21*κ*, 904 (fought with Droṇa), 910; 23*o*, 955 (*Çaikhaṇḍiḥ*, description of his horses), 974 (*Çikhaṇḍināḥ putram*, description of his horses).—§ 604 (Karnap.): VIII, 6, 176 (*Çikhaṇḍitanayaḥ*, has been slain by Lakshmana). Cf. Çaikhaṇḍi, Çikhaṇḍitanaya.

Kshatradharman, son of Dhṛshṭadyumna. § 572 (Rathā-tirathasaṅkhyānap.): V, 171, 5899 (*Dhṛshṭadyumnasya tanayaḥ*, is a half ratha).—§ 585 (Bhīshmavadhap.): VI, 93*ψ*, 4152.—§ 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 21*κ*, 903 (attacked Droṇa); 23*o*, 954 (*çonāçvaḥ*).—§ 593 (Abhimanyuvadhap.): VII, 35*δ*, 1509 (proceeded against Droṇa).—§ 598 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 85*δ*, 3049 (*Saumakiḥ*).—§ 599 (do.): VII, 125, 5079, 5082 (is slain by Droṇa).—§ 604 (Karnap.): VIII, 6, 175 (had been slain by Droṇa). Kshatrahana, a Pāṇḍava warrior. § 573 (Ambopākhyānap.): V, 196, 7646 (*°hā Kshatradevaç ca*, C.; but B. has *Kshatradeva-Brahmadevau*, in the rear of the army of the Pāṇḍavas).

Kshatranjaya, a Pāṇḍava warrior. § 589 (Dronābhishekap.): VII, 10*λ*, 358 (son of Dhṛshṭadyumna?, attacked Droṇa).

Kshatravarman = Kshatradharman (?). § 589 (Dronābhishekap.): VII, 10*λ*, 358 (attacked Droṇa).—§ 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 25, 1073, 1074 (only B., C. has by error *Kṛtav^o*), 1076 (fought with Jayadratha).
