Continuation of the discourse between *Pañcālikha* and the king on the topic of existence and non-existence after death. The *Mithila* king (*Maithilena*), beholding his city burning in a conflagration, himself proclaimed (*gitam*), “in this conflagration nothing of mine is burning.” The king gave up his sorrows, etc. He who reads this discourse attains to emancipation (XII, 219).
