

(Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 77¹, 3389 (by means of the *P.* Drona neutralized the Pramohana weapon).

Prakāṣṭa¹, a ḥshi. § 736b (Vitahavyop.): XIII, 30, 2002 (son of Tamas), 2003 (father of Vāgīndra).

Prakāṣṭa² = Āīva (1000 names³).

Prakāṣṭakarman, *Prakāṣṭakartr*, q.v. = Sūrya.

Prakāṣṭana, *Prakāṣṭatman* = Vishṇu (1000 names).

Prakāṣṭana, a serpent. § 63 (Sarpasattra): I, 57, 2147 (of Vāsuki's race).

Prakṛtingavat, a ḥshi. § 615ii (Vṛddhakanyā): IX, 52, 2993 (*Gālavasambhavaḥ*, married the old daughter of Kuni Garga). Cf. *Gālavasambhava*. *Gālavi*.

Prakkoṣala, pl., v. Kosala, pl.

Prakkoṭaka, pl. (°ah), a people (?). § 281 (Sahadeva): II, 31, 1117 (misprint in B. *Prakot*^o, C. *Prakkoṭal*ⁿ).

Prakṛṣṭārī = Āīva (1000 names²).

***prakṛti** ("the original substance") : I, 2430 (= Kṛshṇa); VI, 977, 1179, 1322, 1341–2, 1355; XII, 7481–3, 7666, 7668, 11335, 11354, 11646, 13044.—Do. personif.: V, 111, 3825 (°yā Purushāḥ sārdham, on the top of Himavat); XII, 341, 13044; XIII, 598.

prakṛti (do.), pl. (°ayah). XII, 7670 (*mula*^o), 11552 (*ashtau*), 11554 (do.), 12725 (*sapta*, i.e. the seven ḥshis, Manu is the eighth), 12737 (–do.), 13041 (*ashtau*, i.e. the seven ḥshis (Marici, etc.) and Manu), 13042 (*ashtabhyaḥ*); XIII, 1060, 1091 (*ashtau*), 1100 (°inām layānām osā gatis teṣām, sc. Āīva).

Pralamba, an Asura. § 93 (Ampāvat.): I, 65, 2537 (son of Danu).—§ 589 (Dronābhishhek.): VII, 11^μ, 386 (had been slain by Kṛshṇa).

Pralambahan ("the slayer of Pralamba") = Balarāma: IX, 2740, 3358.

Pramadvarā, wife of Ruru. § 19 (Paulomap.): I, 5, 872 (wife of Ruru and mother of Īunaka).—§ 21 (cf. Paulomap.): Menaka dropped her child by Viçvāvasu, *P.* near the hermitage of Sthūlaka, who took it up and reared it. *P.* was betrothed to Ruru, but a few days before the nuptials she was killed by a snake: I, 8, 940, 950, 951, 953.—§ 22 (dō.): Svastyā-treya, etc. (a), (the inhabitants of the forest) came to see her (I, 8).—§ 23 (do.): Ruru retired into a deep wood and, weeping aloud, cried to the gods to resuscitate *P.* A devadūta (messenger of the gods) told him to resign to her half of his own life, which he did. Then the king of the *Gandharvas* (i.e. Viçvāvasu) and the devadūta obtained from Dharma the favour that *P.* revived endued with a moiety of Ruru's life; then they were married and became happy: I, 9, 965, 968, 972, 974, 976, 977, 978.—§ 736b (Vitahavyop.): XIII, 30, 2004 (mother of Īunaka).

Pramāṇa, name of a banyan-tree. § 308 (Āranyakap.): III, 1, 41 (°ākhyām mahāvāṭam, on the banks of the Gaṅgā).

Pramāṇa(m) = Āīva (1000 names³).—Do.² = Vishṇu (1000 names).

Pramāṇakoti, name of a place. § 71 (Ādivamcāvatārapap.): I, 61, 2241 (all. to § 197).—§ 197 (Bhīmasenarasapāna): I, 128, 4996, 5015 (there Duryodhana poured poison into the food of Bhīmasena).—§ 317 (Arjunābhigamanap.): III, 12, 542 (all. to § 197, Nil. : *Pramāṇākhyo Gaṅgātrastho vata-viçeshas tatpradece*).—§ 608 (Karnap.): VIII, 83, 4251 (all. to § 197).—§ 615 (Gadāyuddhap.): IX, 56, 3149 (do.).

Pramardana = Mahāpurusha (Mahāpurashastava).

Pramataka, a ḥshi. § 59 (Sarpasattra): I, 53, 2047 (among the sadasyas at the snake-sacrifice of Janamejaya).

Pramatha, a son of Dhṛtarāshṭra. § 182 (Dhṛtarāshṭra-putranāmak.): I, 117, 4552 (enumeration).

Pramatha, pl. (°ah), a kind of Rākshasas, followers of Āīva. § 730 (Ānuçāsanik.): XIII, 14, 983 (°ānām gāṇīp . . . parivāritām, sc. Āīva).—§ 766 (do.): XIII, 195^a, 5924; 130, 6141, (6145).

Pramāṭha¹, a companion of Skanda. § 615u (Skanda): IX, 45, 2532 (given to Skanda by Yama).

Pramāṭha² (VII, 6938), v. **Pramāṭhin**¹.

Pramathānātha = Āīva (1000 names¹).

Pramāṭhin¹, a son of Dhṛtarāshṭra. § 182 (Dhṛtarāshṭra-putranāmak.): I, 117, 4552.—§ 600 (Ghaṭotkacavādhap.): VII, 157^a, 6938 (C. has °thaç cograyāyy api, but read with B. °thy Ugre 'nuyāyy api).

Pramāṭhin², a Rākshasa, brother of Dūshāna and Vajravega. § 538 (Kumbhakarnāraṇagamana): III, 286, 16405 (*Dūshanāvaraṇau Vajravega-Pōau*), 16407 (*Vajravega-Pōau*).—§ 539 (Kumbhakarnādivadha): III, 287, 16430, 16433, 16435 (*Dūshanāvaraṇam*, slain by the monkey Nala).

Pramāṭhin³, a Rākshasa. § 585 (Bhīsmavadhap.): VI, 91^v, 4083 (slain by Duryodhana).

Pramāṭhini, an Apsaras. § 191 (Arjuna): I, 123, 4819 (danced at the birth of Arjuna).

Pramati, a ḥshi, father of Ruru. § 19 (Paulomap.): I, 5, 871 (son of Cyavana and father of Ruru).—§ 21 (Pramadvarā): I, 8, 939 (son of Cyavana and Sukanyā), 940 (begot Ruru on Ghṛtāci), 952 (demanded Pramadvarā as wife for Ruru).—§ 22 (do.): I, 8^a, 963.—§ 25 (Sahasrapad.): I, 11, 1004 (*Rurur nāma Pōer atmajah*), 1005 (*Ruruh kṛyātā Pōer atmajah*).—§ 35 (Āstikap., Aruna): I, 24, (1266), (1277).—§ 69 (Āstikap., Sarpasattra): I, 58, 2195 (told Ruru the Āstikaparvan).—§ 734 (Ānuçāsanik.): XIII, 284, 1762 (among the ḥshis who came to see Bhīshma).—§ 736b (Vitahavyop.): XIII, 30, 2003 (son of Vāgīndra and father of Ruru). Cf. Bhārgava.

Prāṇu = Vishṇu (1000 names).

Pramlocā, an Apsaras. § 191 (Arjuna): I, 123, 4821 (sang at the birth of Arjuna).—§ 269 (Vaiçravāṇasabhāv.): II, 10, 393 (in the palace of Kubera).

Pramoda¹, a serpent. § 65 (Sarpasattra): I, 57, 2152 (of Airāvata's race).

Pramoda², a warrior of Skanda. § 615u (Skanda): IX, 45^v, 2567.

Pramodana = Vishṇu (1000 names).

Pramohanāstra, name of a weapon. § 583 (Bhīsmavadhap.): VI, 77⁵, †3380, †3381, (†), 3386 (employed by Dhṛṣṭadyumna).

Pramuca, a ḥshi. § 665 (Mokshadh.): XIII, 208, 7595 (one of the ḥshis of the south). Cf. next.

Pramucu, a ḥshi. § 770 (Ānuçāsanik.): XIII, 151^v, 7112 (one of the seven Dharmarājartvijah).—§ 775 (do.): XIII, 166^d, 7665 (one of the ḥshis of the south). Cf. the prec.

Prāṇa¹ ("breath"). § 116 (Vasu, pl.): I, 66, 2586 (son of Varcas (or of Varcasvin, BR.) and Manoharā). § 270 (Brahmasabhāv.): II, 11, 443 (in the palace of Brahmān).

Prāṇa² (do.), name of fires. § 491 (Āngirasa): III, 220, 14156 (*Prāṇah Prāṇaputrakah*), 14165 (father of Anudatta).

***Prāṇa**³, one of the five vital breaths. § 485 (Pativrataop.): III, 213, 13961, 13962, 13964, 13970, 13972, 13976 (the whole exposition is nearly identical with § 660c).—§ 560 (Sanatsujātap.): V, 46, 1757, 1760.—§ 579 (Bhagavad-gītāp.): VI, 29, 1062 (*prāṇapānau*).—§ 595 (Shodaçarāj., v.
