

Suçarman², a Pāñdava warrior. § 570 (Sainyaniryāṇap.): V, 151 ϵ , 5163 (in the army of Yudhiṣṭhīra, B. has Sudharmā). — § 587 (Bhīṣmavadhap.): VI, 116, 5402, 5403 (fought with Citrasena); 118 v , 5555. Cf. next.

Suçarman³, a Pāñcāla prince. § 608 (Karṇap.): VIII, 56 vv , 2735 (attacked by Karṇa).

Suçobhanā, daughter of the frog king Āyu(s) and wife of king Parikshit of Ayodhyā. § 461 (Vāmadevacarita): III, 162, †13173.

Suçravā, daughter of a Vidarbha king. § 156 (Pūruvamç.): I, 95, ††3770 (*Vaidarbīm*, wife of Jayatsena).

Suçruta, a son of Viçvāmitra. § 721 b (Viçvāmitrop.): XIII, 4 β , 254.

Sudakshina¹, a Kāmboja prince. § 232 (Svayamvarap.): I, 186, 6995 (*Kāmbojāḥ*, present at the svayamvara of Draupadi). — § 555 (Sainyodyogap.): V, 19 δ , 590 (*Kāmbojāḥ*, accompanied by Yavanas and Çakas S. came to Duryodhana with one akshauhinī of troops). — § 562 (Bhagavadyāṇap.): V, 95 v , 3403 (*Kāmbojāḥ*, in the army of Duryodhana). — § 570 (Sainyaniryāṇap.): V, 155 θ , 5274 (*Kāmbojam*, do.). — § 572 (Rathātirathasaṅkhyāṇap.): V, 166, 5748 (*Kāmbojāḥ*, a ratha in the army of Duryodhana). — § 576 (Bhagavadgītāp.): VI, 16 a , 622 (*Kāmbojāḥ*, had an akshauhinī of troops); 17, 622 (*Kāmbojāḥ sa-S°āḥ*). — § 578 (Bhīṣmavadhap.): VI, 45 19 , 1734 (*Kāmbojāṇāḥ mahāratham*), 1735 (fought with Çrutakarman the son of Sahadeva); 51 χ , 2108 (*Kāmbojāḥ*, on the right flank of Bhīṣma's krauñcavayūḥa). — § 580 (do.): VI, 59 μ , †2584. — § 581 (do.): VI, 65 v , 2928 (*Kāmbojāḥ*). — § 586 (do.): VI, 99 a , 4501 (do., in the van of Bhīṣma's sarvatobhadra array); 102 ι , 4666 (*Kāmbojāḥ*). — § 587 (do.): VI, 108 a , 5007 (*Kāmbojarājāḥ*), (δ), 5051 (*Kāmbojam*); 110, 5108 (*Kāmbojāḥ*, resisted Abhimanyu); 111, 5159. — § 589 (Dronābhishhekāp.): VII, 75, 182 (*Kāmbojāḥ S°purāhsarāḥ*). — § 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 20 ϵ , 801 (*Kāmbojāḥ*, in the left wing of Droṇa's gāruḍavayūḥa). — § 596 (Pratijñāp.): VII, 74 β , 2628 (*Kāmbojāḥ*, will protect Jayadrathā). — § 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 92, 3277 (*Kāmbojam*), 3321 (*Kāmbojarājasya putrāḥ*), 3326, 3330, 3334, 3337 (*Kāmbojam*, is slain by Arjuna); 93, 3338 (*hate*); 94, 3410 (*Kāmbojasya dāyāde hate*), 3438 (*nihataḥ*, sc. by Arjuna). — § 600 (Ghatotkacavadhap.): VII, 158 w , 7036 (among the slain). — § 604 (Karṇap.): VIII, 5 ζ , 109 (*nihataḥ Savyasācinā*). — § 608 (do.): VIII, 56, 2802 ($^{\circ}\text{ād} \text{avarajāḥ}$), 2804 ($^{\circ}\text{ād} \text{avarajāḥ} \text{Kāmbojam}$, the younger brother of S. attacked Arjuna but was slain by him); 72 vvv , 3612 (*Kāmbojam*). — § 609 (Çalyap.): IX, 2, 74 (*Kāmbojāḥ*, had sided with Duryodhana), 90 (*hataḥ*). — § 611 (do.): IX, 24 vv , 1300 (*Kāmboje*, sc. *hate*). — § 619 (Strīvilāpāp.): XI, 20, 601 (*Kāmbojam*). Sudakshina², a Pāñdava warrior. § 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 21 κ , 910 (pierced by Droṇa).

Sudāmā, name of two mātrs. § 615 u (Skanda): IX, 46 θ , 2623 (only C., B. has Dāmā), 2628.

Sudāman¹, a king. § 279 (Arjuna): II, 27, 1020 (in the north, vanquished by Arjuna on his digvijaya). — § 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 23 σ , 996/7 (only B.)

Sudāman², king of the Daçārnas. § 350 (Nalopākhyāṇap.): III, 69, 2707 (*sute Daçārnādhipateḥ S°nāḥ*, i.e. the wives of the Vidarbha king Bhīma and the Cedi king Virabahu).

Sūdāman, pl. ($^{\circ}\text{mānāḥ}$), a people. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9 μ , 362.

Sudarça¹, a Kuru warrior. § 604 (Karṇap.): VIII, 7, †207 (? adj. ? among those who were still alive). Cf. next.

Sudarça², a son of Dhṛtarāshṭra (= Sudarçana). § 611 (Çalyap.): IX, 27, 1443 (only B., C. has Durdharsa; S. and Duryodhana were the only two of Dhṛtarāshṭra's sons who were yet unslain). Cf. the prec.

Sudarçana¹, the discus (eakra) of Vishnu (Krṣṇa). § 28 (Amṛtamāñthana): I, 19, †1178, †1186 (employed by Nārāyaṇa). — [§ 257 (Khānduvadahanap.): I, 225, 8196 (*eakram*), given to Krṣṇa by Agni, d: having a hard nave (? *vajranābham*), and being a fiery weapon (*Āgneyam astram*) through it Krṣṇa should be superior in battle to men, gods Rākshasas, Piçācas, Daityas, and Nāgas, and it would always return into his hand.] — § 320 (Saubhavadhop.): III, 22, 881 (b: S. burns Yakshas, Rākshasas, and Dānavas), 883 (Krṣṇa cut Saubha in twain by means of the S.). — § 561 (Yānasandhip.): V, 54, 2132 (*eakrāṇam*, sc. *varāṇi*). — § 580 (Bhīṣmavadhap.): VI, 59, †2599 (in the hand of Krṣṇa). — § 589 (Dronābhishhekāp.): VII, 7, 197 (*eakrāṇam*, sc. *varāṇi*). — § 600 (Ghatotkacavadhap.): VII, 175 $\delta\delta\delta$, 8195 (*eakram*, held by Krṣṇa) — § 608 (Karṇap.): VIII, 89 ξ^1 , †4569. — § 730d (Mandāra): Krṣṇa's discus was given to him by Mahādera (i.e. Çiva) when the latter had slain a Daitya who lived in the water. Originally it was created by Vṛṣhāṅka (i.e. Çiva). Only Pinākin (i.e. Çiva) can gaze at it. Bhava (i.e. Çiva) gave it the name Sudarçana: XIII, 14, 668. Cf. Cakra (add the foll.: III, 178 (*sunābham*); V, 2524' (*Vāsudevaya*); VI, 2596' (*sunābham*); X, 625 (do.)).

Sudarçana², a prince. § 264 (Sabhākriyāp.): II, 4 β , 123 (? PCR. takes this as an adj. ("handsome") to *Kramajit*).

Sudarçana³, the chariot (?) of Indra. § 552 (Goharaṇap.): IV, 56, 1761 (*Çakrah . . . samāruhya S°m*).

Sudarçana⁴, a prince (so Nil.). § 561c (Krṣṇa Vāsudeva): V, 48, †1882 (having vanquished the Gāndhāras and the sons of Nagnajit Krṣṇa liberated S., *devatānāṁ lalitām*).

Sudarçana⁵, name of a dvīpa = Jambudvīpa. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 5, 188 (*dvīpam*), 191 ($^{\circ}\text{dvīpah}$).

Sudarçana⁶, the Jambu tree on Meru. § 574t (Jambū): VI, 7, 273 (*jambārkshāḥ*). Cf. Sudarçanā².

Sudarçana⁷, son of Dhṛtarāshṭra. § 583 (Bhīṣmavadhap.): VI, 77 κ , 3343. — § 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 127 vv , 5177 (among several sons of Dhṛtarāshṭra who attacked Bhīmasena), (ζζ), 5210 (slain by Bhīmasena). — § 600 (Ghatotkacavadhap.): VII, 156 κ , 6852 (the same?).

Sudarçana⁸, a Kuru warrior. § 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 118, †4689 (*rājavaraḥ*), †4691, †4692, †4693, †4696, †4697 (slain by Sātyaki); 119, 4702 ($^{\circ}\text{m} \text{nihatā}$)

Sudarçana⁹, a Pāñdava warrior. § 600 (Ghatotkacavadhap.): VII, 158 χ , 7011 (brother of Virāṭa?)

Sudarçana¹⁰, a Mālava king. § 603 (Nārāyanāstramokshap.): VII, 200 $\gamma\gamma$, 9330 (*Mālavāḥ*, attacked Açvatthāman), †9340 (Açvatthāman cut off his head); 201, 9400 (*ishvastriśidhi-sampanne Mālave*, sc. *hate*). Cf. Mālava.

Sudarçana¹¹, son of Agni and Sudarçanā. § 720b (Sudarçanop.): XIII, 2, 120 (*Āgneyāḥ*), 123 (married Oghavati), 131, 132 (*Agniputra*), 145, 147, 151, 180 ($^{\circ}\text{caritām}$), (in the shape of a brahmaṇ Dharma put S. to the test). Cf. Āgneya Agniputra, Pāvakasuta, Pāraki.

Sudarçana¹² = Çiva (1000 names²). — Do.¹³ = Vishnu (1000 names).

Sudarçanā¹, daughter of king Duryodhana of Māhishmati and the river Narmadā. § 720b (Sudarçanop.): XIII, 2, 104 (*rājakanyāṇi*), 106, 118 (married to Agni to whom she bore Sudarçana¹¹, cf. II, 30). Cf. Duryodhanasutā
