

Suçarman², a Pāṇḍava warrior. § 570 (Sainyaniryānap.): V, 151_ε, 5163 (in the army of Yudhishtīra, B. has *Sudharmā*).—§ 587 (Bhīshmavadhap.): VI, 116, 5402, 5403 (fought with Citrasena); 118_v, 5555. Cf. next.

Suçarman³, a Pāṇḍava prince. § 608 (Kārṇap.): VIII, 56_{vv}, 2735 (attacked by Kārṇa).

Suṣobhanā, daughter of the frog king Āyu(s) and wife of king Parikshit of Ayodhyā. § 461 (Vāmadevacarita): III, 162, ††13173.

Suṣravā, daughter of a Vidarbha king. § 156 (Pūruvaṃṣ.): I, 95, ††3770 (*Vaidarbhīn*, wife of Jayatsena).

Suṣruta, a son of Viçvāmītra. § 721_b (Viçvāmītrop.): XIII, 4_β, 254.

Sudakshina¹, a Kāmboja prince. § 232 (Svayamvarap.): I, 186, 6995 (*Kāmbojah*, present at the svayamvara of Draupadī).—§ 555 (Sainyodyogap.): V, 19_δ, 590 (*Kāmbojah*, accompanied by Yavanas and Çakas *S.* came to Duryodhana with one akshauhiṇī of troops).—§ 562 (Bhagavadyānap.): V, 95_v, 3403 (*Kāmbojah*, in the army of Duryodhana).—§ 570 (Sainyaniryānap.): V, 155_θ, 5274 (*Kāmbojam*, do.).—§ 572 (Rathātīrathasankhyānap.): V, 166, 5748 (*Kāmbojah*, a ratha in the army of Duryodhana).—§ 576 (Bhagavadgītāp.): VI, 16_a, 622 (*Kāmbojah*, had an akshauhiṇī of troops); 17, 622 (*Kāmbojah sa-S°āh*).—§ 578 (Bhīshmavadhap.): VI, 45¹⁹, 1734 (*Kāmbojanām mahāratham*), 1735 (fought with Çrutakarman the son of Sahadeva); 51_χ, 2108 (*Kāmbojah*, on the right flank of Bhīshma's krauñcavyūha).—§ 580 (do.): VI, 59_μ, †2584.—§ 581 (do.): VI, 65_v, 2928 (*Kāmbojah*).—§ 586 (do.): VI, 99_a, 4501 (do., in the van of Bhīshma's sarvatobhadra array); 102_ι, 4666 (*Kāmbojah*).—§ 587 (do.): VI, 108_a, 5007 (*Kāmbojarājah*), (δ), 5051 (*Kāmbojam*); 110, 5108 (*Kāmbojah*, resisted Abhimanyu); 111, 5159.—§ 589 (Droṇābhishekap.): VII, 7_ζ, 182 (*Kāmbojah S°purahsarāh*).—§ 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 20_ε, 801 (*Kāmbojah*, in the left wing of Droṇa's gāruḍavyūha).—§ 596 (Pratijñāp.): VII, 74_β, 2628 (*Kāmbojah*, will protect Jayadratha).—§ 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 92, 3277 (*Kāmbojam*), 3321 (*Kāmbojarājasya putrah*), 3326, 3330, 3334, 3337 (*Kāmbojam*, is slain by Arjuna); 93, 3338 (*hate*); 94, 3410 (*Kāmbojasya dūyāde hate*), 3438 (*nihatāh*, sc. by Arjuna).—§ 600 (Ghaṭotkacavadhap.): VII, 158_ω, 7036 (among the slain).—§ 604 (Kārṇap.): VIII, 5_ζ, 109 (*nihatāh Savyasācinā*).—§ 608 (do.): VIII, 56, 2802 (*°ād avarajāh*), 2804 (*°ād avarajam Kāmbojam*, the younger brother of *S.* attacked Arjuna but was slain by him); 72_{vvv}, 3612 (*Kāmbojam*).—§ 609 (Çalyap.): IX, 2, 74 (*Kāmbojah*, had sided with Duryodhana), 90 (*hatah*).—§ 611 (do.): IX, 24_{vv}, 1300 (*Kāmboje*, sc. *hate*).—§ 619 (Strivilāpāp.): XI, 20, 601 (*Kāmbojam*). Cf. Kāmboja, Kāmbojarāja.

Sudakshina², a Pāṇḍava warrior. § 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 21_κ, 910 (pierced by Droṇa).

Sudāmā, name of two māṭrs. § 615_u (Skanda): IX, 46_θ, 2623 (only C., B. has *Dāmā*), 2628.

Sudāman¹, a king. § 279 (Arjuna): II, 27, 1020 (in the north, vanquished by Arjuna on his digvijaya).—§ 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 23_o, 996/7 (only B.).

Sudāman², king of the Daçārnas. § 350 (Nalopākhyānap.): III, 69, 2707 (*sute Daçārnādhipateh S°nah*, i.e. the wives of the Vidarbha king Bhīma and the Cedi king Virabāhu).

Sūdāman, pl. (*°mānaḥ*), a people. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9_μ, 362.

Sudarça¹, a Kuru warrior. § 604 (Kārṇap.): VIII, 7, †207 (? adj. ? among those who were still alive). Cf. next.

Sudarça², a son of Dhṛtarāshṭra (= Sudarçana). § 611 (Çalyap.): IX, 27, 1443 (only B., C. has Durdharsha; *S.* and Duryodhana were the only two of Dhṛtarāshṭra's sons who were yet unslain). Cf. the prec.

Sudarçana¹, the discus (*cakra*) of Vishnu (Kṛshṇa). § 28 (Amṛtamānthana): I, 19, †1178, †1186 (employed by Nārāyaṇa).—[§ 257 (Khāṇḍavadāhanap.): I, 225, 8196 (*cakram*), given to Kṛshṇa by Agni, *d*: having a hard nave (? *vajranābham*), and being a fiery weapon (*Agneyam astram*) through it Kṛshṇa should be superior in battle to men, gods Rākshasas, Piçācas, Daityas, and Nāgas, and it would always return into his hand.]—§ 320 (Saubhavadhōp.): III, 22, 881 (*b*: *S.* burns Yakshas, Rākshasas, and Dānavas), 883 (Kṛshṇa cut Saubha in twain by means of the *S.*).—§ 561 (Yānasandhip.): V, 54, 2132 (*cakrānām*, sc. *varam*).—§ 580 (Bhīshmavadhap.): VI, 59, †2599 (in the hand of Kṛshṇa).—§ 589 (Droṇābhishekap.): VII, 7, 197 (*cakrānām*, sc. *varam*).—§ 600 (Ghaṭotkacavadhap.): VII, 175_{δδδ}, 8195 (*cakram*, held by Kṛshṇa)—§ 608 (Kārṇap.): VIII, 89_ζ¹, †4569.—§ 730_d (Mandāra): Kṛshṇa's discus was given to him by *Mahādeva* (i.e. Çiva) when the latter had slain a Daitya who lived in the water. Originally it was created by *Vṛshāṅka* (i.e. Çiva). Only *Pinākin* (i.e. Çiva) can gaze at it. *Bhava* (i.e. Çiva) gave it the name *Sudarçana*: XIII, 14, 668. Cf. *Cakra* (add the foll.: III, 178 (*sunābham*); V, 2524¹ (*Vāsudevasya*); VI, 2596¹ (*sunābham*); X, 625 (do.)).

Sudarçana², a prince. § 264 (Sabhākriyāp.): II, 4_β, 123 (? PCR. takes this as an adj. ("handsome") to *Kramajit*).

Sudarçana³, the chariot (?) of Indra. § 552 (Goharānap.): IV, 56, 1761 (*Çakraḥ . . . samāruhya S°m*).

Sudarçana⁴, a prince (so Nil.). § 561_c (Kṛshṇa Vāsudeva): V, 48, †1882 (having vanquished the Gāndhāras and the sons of Nagnajit Kṛshṇa liberated *S.*, *devatānām lalāmam*).

Sudarçana⁵, name of a dvīpa = Jambudvīpa. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 5, 188 (*dvīpam*), 191 (*°dvīpāh*).

Sudarçana⁶, the Jambu tree on Meru. § 574_t (Jambū): VI, 7, 273 (*jambuvṛkshah*). Cf. Sudarçanā².

Sudarçana⁷, son of Dhṛtarāshṭra. § 583 (Bhīshmavānap.): VI, 77_κ, 3343.—§ 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 127_{vv}, 5177 (among several sons of Dhṛtarāshṭra who attacked Bhīmasena), (ζζ), 5210 (slain by Bhīmasena).—§ 600 (Ghaṭotkacavadhap.): VII, 156_κ, 6852 (the same?).

Sudarçana⁸, a Kuru warrior. § 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 118, †4689 (*vajavarah*), †4691, †4692, †4693, †4696, †4697 (slain by Sātyaki); 119, 4702 (*°m nihatyā*).

Sudarçana⁹, a Pāṇḍava warrior. § 600 (Ghaṭotkacavadhap.): VII, 158_χ, 7011 (brother of Virāṭa?).

Sudarçana¹⁰, a Mālava king. § 603 (Nārāyaṇāstramokshap.): VII, 200_{γγ}, 9330 (*Mālavaḥ*, attacked Açvatthāman), †9340 (Açvatthāman cut off his head); 201, 9400 (*ishvastravidhīsampanne Mālave*, sc. *hate*). Cf. Mālava.

Sudarçana¹¹, son of Agni and Sudarçanā. § 720_b (Sudarçanop.): XIII, 2, 120 (*Agneyah*), 123 (married Oghavati), 131, 132 (*Agniputro*), 145, 147, 151, 180 (*°caritam*), (in the shape of a brahman Dharma put *S.* to the test). Cf. *Agneya Agniputra*, Pāvakasuta, Pāvaki.

Sudarçana¹² = Çiva (1000 names?).—Do.¹³ = Vishṇu (1000 names).

Sudarçanā¹, daughter of king Duryodhana of Māhishmatī and the river Narmadā. § 720_b (Sudarçanop.): XIII, 2, 104 (*vajakanyam*), 106, 118 (married to Agni to whom she bore Sudarçana¹¹, cf. II, 30). Cf. Duryodhanasutā
