**Surāsurapati** = Brahmán (?) : V, 2984 (<sup>o</sup>s̄ *sakhd*, i.e. Rāma Jāmadagnya).

**Surāsureṣa** = Çiva: XIII, 903 (only B., C. *survasureṣaya*).

**Suratā**, an Apsarā. § 103 (Aṃçāvat.): I, 65, 2558 (daughter of Prādhā).

**Suratha<sup>1</sup>**, a prince. § 130 (Aṃçāvat.): I, 67, 2697 (among the incarnations from the Krodhvavaça gāṇa).

**Suratha<sup>2</sup>**, an ancient king. § 267 (Yamasabhāv.): II, 8, 322 (in the palace of Yama).

**Suratha<sup>3</sup>**, the father of Koṭikāṣya. § 522 (Draupadīharanap.): III, 265, †15593 (<sup>o</sup>s̄ *syā putrā*, i.e. Koṭikāṣya), †15605 (<sup>o</sup>s̄ *syā putram*).

**Suratha<sup>4</sup>**, a Trigarta king, follower of Jayadratha. § 522 (Draupadīharanap.): III, 271, 15733 (*Trigartarājāḥ*), 15735 (fought with Nakula and was slain).

**Suratha<sup>5</sup>**, a Kuru warrior. § 592 (Samçaptakavadvhap.): VII, 18a, 741 (among the Samçaptakas, fought with Arjuna).

**Suratha<sup>6</sup>**, a son of Drupada. § 600 (Ghaṭotkacavadvhap.): VII, 156, 6910 (*Drupadasya sutam . . . Catruñjayam S°syānujan*, slain by Acvatthāman).

**Suratha<sup>7</sup>**, a Pāñcāla prince. § 611 (Çalyap.): IX, 14, 740, 741 (*Pāñcālānām mahārājāḥ*), 743, 745 (slain by Acvatthāman).

**Suratha<sup>8</sup>**, son of Jayadratha. § 785 (Anugitāp.): XIV, 78, 2276 (<sup>o</sup>s̄ *syā sutam*, i.e. the grandson of Jayadratha and Duḥgalū), 2288 (had died when he heard of the arrival of Arjuna).

**Surathākāra**, a varsha in Kuçadvīpa. § 575 (Bhūmip.): VI, 125, 454.

**Surāva**, name of a horse. § 382 (Agastyop.): III, 99, 8631 (given to Agastya by Ilvala).

**Suravara** = Çiva: VII, 9537.

**Suravarcas**, a god. § 492 (Āngirasa): III, 220, 14168 (among the 15 yajñamushaḥ).

**Suravarottama** = Vishṇu: III, 13576.

**Suravidvish**, pl. (<sup>o</sup>aḥ) ("enemies of the gods") = Asura, pl.: III, †8798 (*Kāleyasañjñān*).

**Suravīthī** ("way of the gods"). § 336 (Indralokābhig.): III, 43, 1767 (*nakshatramārgam vipulam S°lti virutam*).

**Suretarā**, pl. (<sup>o</sup>aḥ) ("others than Suras") = Asura, pl.: VIII, 1429, 1435 (C. by error 's°).

**Surocanā**, a mātṛ. § 615u (Skanda): IX, 46δ, 2647.

**Suroman**, a serpent. § 64 (Sarpasattra): I, 57, 2151 (of Takshakā's race).

**Surottama<sup>1</sup>** = Brahmán: VII, 2077; VIII, 1334.

**Surūpā**, name of a cow. § 564 (Mātalīyop.): V, 102, 3609 (Saurabhi, supporting the eastern quarter).

\***Sūrya<sup>1</sup>** (the sun), identified with Savitṛ and Vivasvat, and = Āditya. [§ 3 (Anukram.): I, 1, 42 (the twelve forms (sons) of Vivasvat (cf. Āçāvaha) seem to be forms of the sun)].—§ 4 (do.): I, 1, †185 (*yadā Vāyuh Çakra-Sūryau ca yuktau Kaunteyanām anulomā jayāya*).—[§ 11 (Parvasangr.): I, 2, 419 (*Ravoh*), 420 (*Tigmāñçum*), (all. to § 310)].—§ 28 (Amṛtamānthana): I, 19, 1162 (*Candra-S°ābhyañ*), 1166 (do., Rāhu swallows up the sun and the moon [at the eclipses] because they discovered him drinking amṛta).—§ 33 (Garuḍa): I, 23, 1249 (*Tapanah*, Garuḍa is identified with S.).—§ 34 (do.): I, 24, 1264 (S. would burn the world).—§ 35 (Aruna): I, 24, 1270 (Aruna was placed before S. as his charioteer and took away his energy (*tejah*)).—§ 81 (Karna): I, 63, 2427 (father of Karna, cf. § 131, etc.).—§ 92 (Aṃçāvat.): I, 65, 2535 (*devānām Sūryā-Candra-masau*, different from the Dānavas of the same names).—[§ 131 (Kunti): I, 67, 2771 (*Arkaṁ*, begat Karna on Kunti, cf. § 175 and § 547)].—[§ 131b (Karna): I, 67, 2784 (*Divākarasya . . . ançām*, sc. Karna)].—§ 175 (Karna-sambhava): I, 111, (4393) (begat Karna on Kunti, cf. § 131 and § 547).—[§ 208 (Astradarçana): I, 136, 5381 (*Bhāskarasya . . . ançāh Karnaḥ*), 5383 (*Bhāskarasyātmasambhavaḥ = do.*), 5402 (*Bhāskarah*, assisted Karna by dispersing the clouds)].—§ 222 (Tāpatyup.): I, 171, 6527, 6530; 173, 6595 (bestowed his daughter Tāpati on Saṃvaraṇa).—[§ 246 (Sundopasundop.): I, 211, 7682 (*Candrādityau*)].—§ 270 (Brahmasabhāv.): II, 11, 429 (took Nārada with him to the palace of Brahmán).—§ 310 (Āranyukap.): III, 3, 146 (having described the activity of the sun (b: from compassion with the hungry creatures the sun during his northern course draws up water, and during his southern course he enters
