**Udra**, pl. (°āh), a people. § 284 (Sahadeva): II, 31, 1174 (°-Koralaīh, in the south, vanquished by Sahadeva). — § 342 (Indralokābhigamanap.): III, 51, 1988 (*sa-Pauñdroān*, had been present at the rājasūya of Yudhiṣṭhīra). — § 578 (Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 50π, 2084 (in the army of Yudhiṣṭhīra, only C., with the reading *Udrāh*, B. has *Colāh*). — Cf. Odra.

**Udrapāraka**, a serpent. § 67 (Sarpasattra): I, 57, 2158 (of Dhṛtarāshṭra's race).

**Udrarājā** ("the king of the Udras"). § 264 (Sabhākriyāp.): II, 4β, 119 (*Pāñdyodrarājau*, waited upon Yudhiṣṭhīra).

**Udumbara** = Vishnu (1000 names).

**Udupa** ("lord of the stars") = Soma (the Moon): III, 11149 (*ira*).

**Udupati** (do.) = Soma (the Moon): IX, 2030 (*ira*), 2925.

**Udurāj** (do.) = Soma (the Moon): II, 1322 (*ira*); V, 1149 (*ira*); IX, 2009; XII, 1879 (*ira*); XIII, 837 (*ira*); XIV, 1897 (*ira*).

**Udvaha**<sup>1</sup>, a prince. § 130 (Ampāvat.): I, 67, 2700 (among the incarnations from the Krodhvāca gana).

**Udvaha**<sup>2</sup>, name of a wind. § 714j (Çukakṛtya): The wind which causes Soma (the Moon) and other luminaries to arise (in the body called *Udāna* (so C.)), and which sucks up the waters in the oceans and imparts them to the clouds and thereafter to *Parjanya*, is called *U*: XII, 329, 12404.

**Udayat**, a mountain. § 370 (Tīrthayātrāp.): III, 84, 8071 (*Udyantam . . . parvataṁ*).

**Udyoga** = Udyogaparvan. § 4 (Anukram.): I, 1, 89 (°*Virāto-sāravān . . . Bhāratadrumāh*). — § 10 (Parvasaṅgr.): I, 2, 333 (= Sainyodyogaparvan?). — § 585 (Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 98, 4484 (allusion to Ambopākhyānap.): — § 795c (Mahābhārata): XVIII, 6ρ, 278. Cf. VI, 1614.

**Udyogaparvan** ("the book relating the preparations for war"), the fifth book of the Mhbhr. § 10 (Parvasaṅgr.): I, 2, 329 (= Sainyodyogaparvan?). — § 11 (do.): I, 2, 492, 517 (said to comprise 6698 çlokas). Cf. Udyoga.

**Ugra**<sup>1</sup>, a son of Dhṛtarāshṭra. § 130 (Ampāvat.): I, 67, 2738 (enumeration). — § 182 (Dhṛtarāshṭraputranāmak.): I, 117, 4551 (do.). — § 581 (Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 64κ, 2838, 2843 (slain by Bhīmasena). — § 600 (Ghaṭotkacavadhap.): VII, 157ο, 6938 (only C.: *Ugro 'nuyāti*, but B. has *Ugrayāti*).

**Ugra**<sup>2</sup>, a prince. § 554 (Sainyodyogap.): V, 4γ, 75.

**Ugra**<sup>3</sup>, a son of Kavi. § 747b (Suvarṇotpatti): XIII, 85ι, 4150 (eighth son of Kavi).

**Ugra**<sup>4</sup> = Çiva, q.v. — Do.<sup>5</sup> = Vishnu (1000 names).

**ugra**, name of a caste: XII, 10868 (pl.); XIII, 2568 (pl.).

**Ugraçravas**<sup>1</sup>, son of Lomaharshana and generally named

Sauti, who recited the Mhbhr. to Çaunaka. § 1 (Anukram.): I, 1, 1 (*Lomaharshaputra U°āh Sautiḥ*). — § 18 (Paulomap.): I, 4, †851 (*Lomaharshaputra U°āh Sautiḥ Paurāṇikāh*). — § 51 (Parikshit, Āstikāp.): I, 40, 1659. — § 775 (Ānuçāsanik.): XIII, 166ζ, 7673 (among the ḍshis of the north).

**Ugrasena**<sup>2</sup>, a Devagandharva. § 101 (Ampāvat.): I, 65, 2550 (*Bhīmasenoau*, among the sons of Muni). — § 191 (Arjuna): I, 123, 4811 (do., present at the birth of Arjuna). — § 552 (Goharāp.): IV, 56ξ, 1771 (came to see the encounter).

**Ugrasena**<sup>3</sup>, a prince. § 130 (Ampāvat.): I, 67, 2649 (incarnation of the Asura Svarbhānu).

**Ugrasena**<sup>4</sup>, a son of Dhṛtarāshṭra. § 130 (Ampāvat.): I, 67, 2735 (enumeration). — § 182 (Dhṛtarāshṭraputranāmak.): I, 117, 4548 (do.).

**Ugrasena**<sup>5</sup>, son of the elder Parikshit. § 154 (Pūruvāp.): I, 94, 3743.

**Ugrasena**<sup>6</sup> (probably the same as Āhuka), king of the Vṛshnis, father of Kamsa. § 252 (Subhadrāharanāp.): I, 219, 7913 (*rāja Vṛshṇinām*). — § 262 (Bhagavadyāna): II, 2, 54 (*Yaduçreshṭhair U°mukhaih*). — § 264 (Sabhākriyāp.): II, 4β, 116 (the same? waited upon Yudhiṣṭhīra). — § 320 (Saubhavādhop.): III, 15, 647 (°*oddharādibhih*). — § 556 (Sañjayayānap.): V, 28, †805 (°*ādayaḥ*). — § 561c (Krṣṇa Vāsudeva): V, 48, †1885 (°*sya sutam*, i.e. Kamsa; when Krṣṇa had slain Kamsa, *U*. was made king). — § 641 (Rājadh.): XII, 81, 3040 (*Babhrūyoḥ*). — § 676 (Mokshadh.): XII, 231, 8455 (°*sya saṃvādaṁ Nārada Kēcavaśya ca*), (8456) (discourse between *U*. and Krṣṇa). — § 785 (Anugītāp.): XIV, 83, 2480 (*Vṛshṇyandhakapatiḥ*). — § 795 (Svargārohanāp.): XVIII, 5μ, 163 (among those who after death entered the deities).
