

*Keçava* each with seven *ross*. *Keçava* conferred eightfold *aicvarya* (superhuman power), etc., on them, and then disappeared, therefore that tirtha became known by the name of *Saptacarū*: III, 82, 5034.

**Vadavā**, a river. § 494 (Āngirasa): III, 222, 14232 (among the rivers who are mothers of fires).

**Vadavāgni** = *Vadavāmukha*<sup>1</sup>. § 490 (Āngirasa): III, 219, 14149 (*piḅaty ambho yaḥ*).

**Vadavāmukha**<sup>1</sup>, name of the submarine fire at *Vadavāmukha(m)*. § 306 (Samudra): I, 21, 1220 (*°diptāgnes toyahavyapradah*, sc. the ocean).—§ 552 (Goharaṇap.): IV, 50, 1580 (*agniḥ*).—§ 616 (Sauptikap.): X, 6, 226 (*pāvakaḥ*).—§ 717b (Nārāyaṇīya): XII, 339, †12864 (*agniḥ* = Mahāpuruṣa). Cf. *Vadavāvakra*.—Do.<sup>2</sup> = *Çiva* (1000 names<sup>2</sup>).

**Vadavāmukha**<sup>2</sup>, a r̥ṣi. § 717b (Nārāyaṇīya): XII, 343, XIII, †13222 (*mahar̥ṣiḥ*, incarnation of Nārāyaṇa, cursed the ocean, saying that its water should only be drinkable for the *vadavāmukha*).

**Vadavāmukha(m)** (the mare's head, in the ocean). § 571 (Ulūkādūtāgamanap.): V, 160, 5529 (*Kāmoja-v °ṇ*, sc. *puruṣhodadhīn*); 161, 5574 (do.).—§ 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 135, 5556 (*°madhyasthaḥ . . . mānavah*).—§ 603 (Nārāyaṇāstramokṣhap.): VII, 202, 9608 (*°eti (!) oyākhyātāṃ pivāms* (°at, B) *toyamayam havih*, one of the faces of *Çiva*).—§ 704 (Mokhadh.): XII, 302, 11168 (*°sāgarāṃ*).—§ 717b (Nārāyaṇīya): XII, 343, XIII, †13222 (*°sañjñitena*, drinks the water of the ocean).—§ 742 (Ānuçāsanik.): XIII, 38, 2230.—§ 773d (*Çiva*): XIII, 162, 7531 (the face of *Çiva*). Cf. *Vadavāvakra(m)*.

**Vadavāvakra**, a fire = *Vadavāmukha*<sup>1</sup>. § 459 (Mārkaṇḍeyas.): III, 189, 12961 (*agniḥ*).

**Vadavāvakra(m)** = *Vadavāmukha(m)*. § 745c (Cyaṇa-Kuçikasamv.): XIII, 56, 2909 (there Ūrva will throw the fire of his wrath; cf. *Aurvopākhyāna(m)*).

**Vāddhika** (VI, 1708) error in C. for *Bāhika* (see additions).

**Vadha** = *Çiva* (1000 names<sup>2</sup>).

**Vadhna**, pl. v. *Vadhra*, pl.

**Vadhra**, pl. (°āḥ), a people. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9μ, 363 (only B., C. has *Vadhnāḥ*).

**Vadhryaçva**, an ancient king. § 267 (Yamasabhāv.): II, 8, 323 (in the palace of Yama).

**Vadhūsarā**, a river. § 20 (Pulomā): I, 6, 904 (arose from the tears of Pulomā, Brahman gave it the name V.).—[§ 383 (Paraçurāma): III, 99, 8684 (*nadīm . . . Vadhūsarakṛtāhvayām*).]

**Vadhyā** = *Brahmavadhya* (personif.): XII, 10159.

**Vāduli**, see *Vāhuli*.

**Vāgātman** = *Kṛṣṇa*: XII, 1635.

**Vāgindra**, a brahman. § 736b (*Vitahavyop*): XIII, 30, 2003 (of *Vitahavya*'s race, son of *Prakāça* and father of *Pramati*).

**Vāgmin**<sup>1</sup>, a prince. § 150 (*Pūruvaṃç*): I, 94, 3697 (son of *Manasyu* and *Sauvirī*).—Do.<sup>2</sup> = *Vishṇu* (1000 names).

**Vāheyika**, **Vahi**, **Vāhika**, v. *Bāheyika*, etc.

**Vāhikapuṅgava**, so B. for *Bāhika*<sup>o</sup> (q.v.).

**Vāhini**<sup>1</sup>, wife of *Kuru*. § 154 (*Pūruvaṃç*): I, 94, 3740.

**Vāhini**<sup>2</sup>, a river. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9λ, 341.

**Vahitr sarvabhūtānām** = *Çiva* (1000 names<sup>2</sup>).

**Vahni**<sup>1</sup> = *Agni*, q.v.

**Vahni**<sup>2</sup>, an ancient king (an Asura?). § 673b (*Bali-Vāsava-samv.*): XII, 227 a, 8264 (among the ancient rulers of the earth).

**Vahni**<sup>3</sup>, = *Vishṇu* (1000 names).

**Vahnidaivata**, adj. ("whose deity is *Vahni*"). § 253 (*Haraṇāharāṇap.*): I, 221, 8045 (*nakṣatra*, i.e. the *Kṛttikās*).—§ 502 (*Manuṣyagrahak*): III, 230, 14464 (*nakṣatram*, do.).

**Vahniloka** ("the world of *Vahni*"): XIII, 6557 (only B. C. has *Brahma*<sup>o</sup>).

**Vahninandana** ("son of *Vahni*") = *Skanda*: III, 14626.

**Vāhuli**, a son of *Viçvāmītra*. § 721b (*Viçvāmītrop*): XIII, 4β, 252 (B. has *Vāduliḥ*).

**Vāhyālaya**, abode of out-castes, i.e. the country of the *Vāhikas* (cf. *Bāhika*, pl.): VIII, 2085 (B. *Vāhyanaṇa*).

**Vaicitravīrya** = *Dhṛtarāshṭra*<sup>1</sup>, q.v.

**Vaicitravīryaka**, adj. ("belonging to *Vaicitravīrya*"). § 788 (*Āçramavāsap*): XV, 28, 755 (*°o kṣatṛo*, sc. *jātaḥ*, sc. *Vidura*).

**Vaicitravīryin** = *Dhṛtarāshṭra*<sup>2</sup>: IX, 2319 (*DN*<sup>o</sup>).

**Vaiçākha**, name of a month. § 759 (*Ānuçāsanik*): XIII, 108β, 5155; 109, 5377 (*°mās*).

**Vaiçākhi**, the day of full moon in the month of *Vaiçākha*. § 746 (*Ānuçāsanik*): XIII, 68, 3413 (*°paurṇamāsyām*).

**Vaiçālāksha**, adj. ("belonging to *Viçālāksha* [= *Çiva*]"). § 641 (*Rājadh*): XII, 59, 2203 (sc. *çāstram*, composed by *Çiva* for abridging the *daṇḍanīti* of *Brahman*; C. has by error *Vī*<sup>o</sup>).

**Vaiçāleya**, pl. (°āḥ), a family of serpents. § 608 (*Karṇap*): VIII, 87 x', 4116 (*bhoginah*, sided with *Arjuna*).

**Vaiçālī** ("daughter of the king of *Viçālā* (?)") = *Bhadra*<sup>2</sup>: II, 1570 (*BK*<sup>o</sup>).
