

Vaidehī—Vairāja.

Vaidehī¹ ("the daughter of the king of the Videhas") = Maryādā: I, †3776 (*M*^o).

Vaidehī² (do.), the wife of Ātānīka² (the son of Janamejaya). § 160 (Pūruvaṃṣ): I, 95, †3838.

Vaidūryaṣikhara, a mountain. § 377 (Dhaumyatīrthak): III, 89, 8359 (*girivaraḥ*, in the west, description); cf. next.

Vaidūryaparvata, a mountain. § 377 (Dhaumyatīrthak): III, 88, 8343 (in the south).—§ 404 (Tīrthayātrāp.): III, 121, 10306, 10310 (near Narmadā, visited by Yudhishtira, etc.).

***vaidya**¹, adj. ("conversant with the Vedas"): I, 6143; II, 667; III, 11634; V, †800, 1491, 3456 (*brāhmaṇāh*), 4485; XII, 532, 2863, 2905, 3200 (*brāhmaṇān*), 8868, 9360; XIII, 1539, 1565, 5820.—Do.², mostly pl. Vaidya⁵ = Çiva (1000 names²).—Do.⁶ = Vishṇu (1000 names).

Vaihāra, a mountain near Girivraja (the present Baibhār, i.e. Vaibhāra). § 277 (Jarāsandhavadhāp.): II, 21, 799 (among the four mountains which surround Girivraja).

Vaiḥyasa¹, pl. (*āh*), a class of ṛshis. § 421b (Ākāça-Gaṅgā): III, 142, 10903.

Vaijayanta¹, the standard of Indra. § 277 (Jarāsandhavadhāp.): II, 22, 872 (*Āndraḥ*, Nil. takes it = *prāsāda*).—§ 335 (Indralokābhigamanap.): III, 42, 1721 (*dhvajam*).

Vaijayanta², a mountain. § 717d (Brahma-Rudrasamv.): XII, 351, 13721 (*kshīrodāsya santudrāsya madhye . . . V^oa Ni khyātaḥ parvataḥ*), 13722, 13734.

***vaijayanti**¹ ("triumphal") adj., said of garlands: I, 2348 (*mālān*); VII, 1274 (*mālā*); IX, 2667 (*mālā*).

Vaijayanti², dual (*yau*), name of the bells of Airāvata. § 505 (Skandayuddha): III, 231, 14531 (given to Skanda by Indra).

Vaikartana = Karṇa, q.v.

Vaikhāna = Vishṇu (1000 names).

Vaikhānasa¹, pl. (*āh*), a class of ṛshis. § 246 (Sundopasundop.): I, 211, 7683.—§ 377 (Dhaumyatīrthak.): III, 89, 8369 (*Pushkaram . . . Vaikhānasa² = Mahāpurusha (Mahāpurushastava).

Vaikhānasa³, adj. ("belonging to the Vaikhānasas"). § 772l (Vasishṭha): XIII, 156, 7280 (*sarāh*, there the gods (*Ādityāh*) performed a sacrifice; B., however, has *saro vai Mānasam*).

Vaimānika¹, name of a tīrtha. § 733k (Ānuçāsanik.): By bathing in *V.* and *Kīnīkīkaçrama* one acquires the merit of repairing everywhere at will. The merit of bathing in *Kālikāçrama*, etc.: XIII, 25, 1709.

Vainavin (B. *V^o*) = Çiva (1000 names²).

Vainya ("the son of Vena") = Prthu: I, 466 (*Prthor V^oya . . . Vainya, v. Vainya.

Vainyopākhyāna ("the episode relating to Vainya"). § 10 (Parvasaṅgr.): I, 1, 33^r (entered among the parvas of the fifth book of the Mbhṛ., but not found there).

Vairāja¹, pl. (*āh*), a class of pitṛs. § 270 (Brahmasabhāv.): II, 11, 462 (in the palace of Brahmān).
