

Vaidehi—Vairāja.

Vaidehi¹ ("the daughter of the king of the Videhas") = Maryādā : I, †3776 (*M^o*).

Vaidehi² (do.), the wife of Cātānīka³ (the son of Jana-nejaya). § 160 (*Pūrvavṛapç.*) : I, 95, †3838.

Vaidūryaparvata, a mountain. § 377 (Dhaumyatiṛthak.) : III, 88, 8343 (in the south).—§ 404 (Tīrthayātrāp.) : III, 121, 10306, 10310 (near Narmadā, visited by Yudhiṣṭhīra, etc.).

***vaidya**¹, adj. Vaihāra, a mountain near Girivraja (the present Baibhār, i.e. Vaibhāra). § 277 (Jarāsandhvadhap.) : II, 21, 799 (among the four mountains which surround Girivraja).

Vaijayantī², dual (*gau*), name of the bells of Airāvata. § 505 (Skandayuddha) : III, 231, 14531 (given to Skanda by Indra).

Vaikhāna = Vishṇu (1000 names).

Vaikhāna¹, pl. Vaikhānasa² = Mahāpurusha (Mahāpurushastava).

Vaikhānasa³, adj. ("belonging to the Vaikhānasas"). § 772l (Vasishtha) : XIII, 156, 7280 (*sarah*, there the gods (*Ādityāḥ*) performed a sacrifice ; B., however, has *saro vai Mānasam*).

Vaimānika¹, name of a tīrtha. § 733k (Ānuçāsanik.) : By bathing in *V.* and *Kiñčinikāçrama* one acquires the merit of repairing everywhere at will. The merit of bathing in *Kālikāçrama*, etc. : XIII, 25, 1709.

Vainavīn (B. *V^oe*) = Çiva (1000 names²).

Vainyopākhyāna ("the episode relating to Vainya"). § 10 (Parvasaṅgr.) : I, 1, 332 (entered among the parvans of the fifth book of the Mhbhr., but not found there).
