

## Vakradanta—Vāmadeva.

113 (came to the svayamvara of the daughter of the Kaliṅga king Cīrāṅgada). Cf. Dantavakra (?), Karūshādhipati (?).

Āstikap.): Caunaka asked some questions on the omens foreboding fear (cf. § 44). Sauti related (“as described in the *Purāṇa*”): Once when *Kaçyapa* was sacrificing from desire of offspring, assisted by the rshis, gods, and Gandharvas, *Indra*, who had been appointed to bring the sacrificial fuel together with the *V.*, and the other deities insulted the *V.*, whose bodies were of the size of a thumb, all together carrying one single stalk of a palāça leaf (*butea frondosa*), and much afflicted when sunk in the water collected in the footstep of a cow. The *V.* then sacrificed to effect that there should be another *Indra*. *Indra* repaired to *Kaçyapa*; he reminded them that Brahmā himself had made *Indra* the lord of the three worlds; the *V.* then declared that their effort had also been meant for the son wished for by him.
