

Vandi—vārāha.

Vandi or **Vandin** (*B°*, *B.*), a sūta, son of Varuṇa. § 11 (Parvasaṅgr.): I, 2, 449.—§ 412 (Aśṭāvakriya): III, 132, †10600 (^oim), †10601 (do.), †10602 (do.), †10612; 133, 10625 (^osh), 10633, 10634, †10638, †10639, †10640, †10641, †10642, †10650; 134, †10651 (^oim), †10652, †10656 (^oim), †10657, (^o10658), (^o10660), (^o10662), (^o10664), (^o10666), (^o10668), (^o10670), †10670, †10673, (^o10674), †10679, 10680, (^o10681), †10687 (having defeated many brahmans in controversies and let them be thrown into water, he was himself defeated by Aśṭāvakra, and merged then into water, having declared that he was the son of Varuṇa, and that the brahmans had been drowned in order that they might see the great sacrifice of Varuṇa). Vāneya, pl. (^oah), a class of munis: IX, 2183 (*muniibhiḥ*).

Vaneyu, a prince. § 150 (Pūruvamç.): I, 94, 3700 (fifth son of Raudrācva and Ghṛtāci).

Vāṅga¹, a prince. § 170 (Dirghatamas): I, 104, 4219 (born by Sudeshnā, the wife of Bali from Dirghatamas). 4220 (after him the country of the Vāṅgas is named).

Vāṅga², a Vāṅga king of the past. § 277 (Jarāsandhavadhap.): II, 21, 804 (*Anga-V°ādayaḥ* . . . *purā*). Cf. the prec.

Vāṅga³, the Vāṅga king at the time of Yudhishṭhira. § 264 (Sabhākriyāp.): II, 4β, 119 (*Anga-V°au*, waited upon Yudhishṭhira), 120.—§ 287 (Rājasūyikap.): II, 34, 1270 (came to the rājasūya of Yudhishṭhira).—§ 585 (Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 92, 4104 (*rajña*).

Vāṅga⁴, the country of the Vāṅgas. § 170 (Dirghatamas): I, 104, 4220 (named after Vāṅga¹).

Vāṅga (mostly *B°* in *C.*), pl. (^oah), a people. § 249 (Arjuna-vanavāsap.): I, 215, 7820 (*Anga-V°-Kalingeshu yāni tīrthāni*).—§ 273 (Rājasūyārambhap.): II, 14, 584 (^oPuṇḍra-Kirāteshu rājā . . . *Puṇḍrako Viśudevah*).—§ 290 (Çīçupālavadhap.): II, 44, 1527 (*V°āngavishayā-dhyaksham* . . . *Karṇap*).—§ 295 (Dyūtap.): II, 52, 1872 (brought tribute to Yudhishṭhira), 1874.—§ 342 (Indralokā-bhigamanap.): III, 51, 1988 (*sa-V°āṅgān*, had been present at the rājasūya).—§ 515 (Karnadigvijaya): III, 254, 15243 (vanquished by Karna on his digvijaya).—§ 561g (Sahadeva): V, 50, 1896 (only *C.* (*B°*), *B.* has *Angān*, had been vanquished by Sahadeva).—§ 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9μ, 353.—§ 585 (Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 91, 4074 (*ānām adhipah*); 92, 4102 (do., fought with Ghaṭotkaca), 4107 (^oānām īvaraḥ, do.).—§ 589 (Dronābhishhekap.): VII, 11ν, 396 (had formerly been vanquished by Kṛṣṇa).—§ 592 (Samaptakavadhap.): VII, 24, 1052 (had sided with Duryodhana).—§ 595 (Shoḍaçarāj. v. Rāma Jāmadagnya): VII, 70β, 2436 (*Anga-V°-Kalingān*, had been slain by Rāma).—§ 600 (Ghaṭotkacavadhap.): VII, 161δ, 7206.—§ 604 (Karṇap.): VIII, 8, 236 (had been vanquished by Karna and caused to pay tribute to Duryodhana).—§ 605 (do.): VIII, 17, †671 (*Kalinga-V°āṅga*); 22ζ, 863.—§ 608 (do.): VIII, 70, †3500 (*Kalinga-V°āṅga*).—§ 785 (Anugītāp.): XIV, 82, 2464 (*samudratitreṇa*, vanquished by Arjuna when he guarded the sacrificial horse).

Vangādhipa ("the king of the Vāṅgas"). § 238

(*Svayamvarap.*): I, 187, †7020 (sought to win Draupadī at her svayamvara).

Vāṅgarāja (do.): § 280 (Bhimasena): II, 30, 1097 (vanquished by Bhimasena on his digvijaya).

Vāñi¹, a river. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9λ, 328 (only *B.*, *C.* has *Vīñān*).

Vāñi² ("speech") = Sarasvatī¹: II, 451 (*saptavidhā*); IX, 2389 (do., the river Sarasvatī identified with *V.*), 2471 (*kovalā*).

Vanija = Çiva (1000 names²).

Vāñkshu, a river, probably the Oxus. § 295 (Dyūtap.): II, 51, 1840 (*rāsabhan* . . . *V°tīrasamudbhavdn*), 1846 (*rāsabhan* . . . *V°tīranivedsinah* [*Vāñku*-^o and *Vāñkshu*-^o], only *C.*).—§ 775 (Ānuçāsanik.): XIII, 166a, 7648 (*B.* *Oakshu*).

Vāpu, an Apsaras. § 191 (Ārjuna): I, 123, 4819 (danced at the birth of Arjuna).

Vāpus = Çiva (1000 names²).

Vāpushmatī, a mātri. § 615u (Skanda): IX, 46, 2629.

Vāpushtamā, the wife of Janamejaya Pārikshita. § 52 (Janamejaya): I, 44, †1809 (daughter of the Kāci king Suvarṇavarman), †1810 (married to Janamejaya), †1812.—§ 160 (Pūruvamç.): I, 95, ††3838 (by Janamejaya, mother of Çatāñika and Çāñkukarṇa).

Vara = Çiva: XII, 10378 (1000 names²); XIII, 1144 (1000 names²), 1151 (do.), 1210 (do.), 1251 (do.), 1252 (do.); XIV, 197, 210.

Varā, a river. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9λ, 333.

***Varada**¹, adj. ("boon giving") said of various gods: = Çiva (1000 names¹⁻²), = Indra: XII, ††1821 (*I°*), = Sūrya: III, 154, = Vishnu (1000 names).—Do. fem. (^oa), said of a goddess: = Durgā (*Umā*): IV, 194; VI, 811.

Varada², a warrior of Skanda. § 615u (Skanda): IX, 45η, 2566.

Varadā, a river. § 370 (Tīrthayātrāp.): III, 85, 8177 (*saṅgama*, a tīrtha).

Varadāna, a tīrtha. § 358 (Tīrthayātrāp.): III, 82, 5005, 5006.

Varadhāna (V, 2405), error in *C.* for Vaṭadhāna.

Varāha¹, a muni. § 264 (Sabhākriyāp.): II, 4a, 112 (waited upon Yudhishṭhira).

Varāha², a mountain. § 277 (Jarāsandhavadhap.): II, 21, 799 (near Girivraja).

Varāha³, an Asura (?). § 678 (Bali-Vāsavasamv.): XII, 227a, 8264 (among the ancient rulers of the earth; *Varāha* *grah*, *C.*, *B.* has *Varāhācvah*).

Varāha⁴ ("the boar") = Vishnu (Kṛṣṇa) (in his avatāra as a boar): I, 1216 (-*orūpiṇā*); III, 10927 (*Vā*^o both *C.* and *B.*, *ekāgrīngā*), 10944 (*ekāgrīngā*, the story of the avatāra related in full), 15830 (^o*vāpusham*, the story of the avatāra related in full), 17205 (*Vā*^o, *C.* = Kṛṣṇa); VI, 3027 (= Kṛṣṇa); XII, 1506 (do.), 1635 (*yajñāngāḥ*), 7617, 7621, 18114 (*ekāgrīngāya*, = Kṛṣṇa), 18450 (*māhā*^o); XIII, 6013 (cf. 6008), 6858 (*māhā*^o).—Do. (dō.) = Çiva (1000 names²).

Varāha⁵ (III, 10927, 17205) v. *Varāha*⁴.

Varāha⁶ ("named after the boar"), name of one or more tīrthas. § 362 (Tīrthayātrāp.): III, 83, 5088 (*tīrthān*, there Vishṇu formerly stood in the form of a boar).—§ 377 (Dhaumyatīrthak.); III, 88, 8332 (*tīrthe*, on Payoshṇī, there Nṛga performed sacrifices).

Varāha, adj. ("relating to the boar", scil. *rāpam*, etc., viz. Vishṇu's): III, 5088, 8757, 12960, 15829; XII, 7619, 7633, 13252, 13410, 13673; XIII, 6016.—Do., said of mātri: IX, 2656.
