

gukrá, *a.* clear, bright, 76⁹. [v̄guc, 1188a, 216.7.]

guklá, *-1. a.* clear; bright; white; *with pakṣa*, the bright lunar half-month, from new to full moon; *-2. as m. (sc. pakṣa)*, the bright lunar fortnight, 65⁵. [see 1189 and 2.]

gukla-pakṣa, *m.* fortnight of the waxing moon.

guklapakṣādi, *a.* having the bright lunar fortnight first, beginning with the bright lunar fortnight. [ādi, 1302c 1.]

guklāmbara, *a.* having a white garment. [ambara.]

v̄gue (gócati, -te; gucóca; ágocit; gocis-yáti; gócitum; gócitvá). *-1. flame*, light, beam; glow, burn; *-2. fig.* suffer burning pain; grieve; grieve at (*loc.*), 66¹³; *-intens.* flame brightly. [for mg 2, cf. v̄tap, dagdha and v̄dah.]

+ apa, *intens.* [1002a], drive away by flaming brightly, 72⁸.

+ abhi, burn, *trans.*

+ à, bring hither by flaming, 72⁸.

gúci, *a.* *-1. flaming, beaming; fig. beaming* (of a smile); light, bright; *-2. fig.* clear, pure; holy (of a god), 80⁵; honorable (in business), 25²; pure (in a ritual sense), 62¹⁰. [v̄gue, 1155.2a, 216.2.]

guci-smita, *a.* having a beaming smile, bright-smiling.

guddhá, *a.* pure. [ppl. of v̄gudh, 160.]

guddha-mati, *a.* pure-minded.

gudh or Gundh (gúndhati, -te; gúdhyati; guddhá). *-1. gúndhati, -te: act. purify; mid. become pure; -2. gúdhyati, become pure.* [orig., perhaps, ‘to clear,’ and akin w. v̄geand, q.v.]

+ vi, vígudhyati, become entirely pure; víguddha, perfectly clear.

guná, *a.* grown, prosperous, fortunate; *as n.* [cf. 1176a], growth, prosperity; luck. [perhaps fr. v̄gū, 1177a.]

v̄gundh, *see* gudh.

gundhyú, *f.* -yú [355e], *a.* pure; unblemished; fair. [v̄gundh, 1165b.]

v̄gubh or gumbh (gúmbhate). glide along lightly; move onward, 73⁹. [perhaps akin w. κοῦφος, ‘light, nimble.’]

v̄gubh or gumbh (góbhate; gúmbhate;

gumbháti; gugubhé; gobhisyáti). *act. adorn; mid. adorn one's self, 73¹²; look beautiful, appear to advantage, shine (fig.).*

1 gúbh, *f.* a gliding onward, esp. through the sky; onward progress; *so, perhaps*, 78⁵; course, 73⁴; *dat., infinitively* [982], so as to glide onward, 79¹¹. [v̄gubh.]

2 gúbh, *f.* beauty; *so, perhaps*, 78⁶. [v̄gubh.]

gubha, *a.* *-1. fair, 911; beautiful, agreeable to the eyes, 15¹³, 45¹⁸, 62¹³; -2. agreeable (to other senses than the eyes); gubhán gandhán, perfumes; -3. agreeable in general, 20¹³; -4. of good quality, 64¹²; -5. fortunate, auspicious, 12¹³.* [v̄gubh, ‘adorn.’]

gubhānāna, *a.* fair-faced. [ānana.]

gubhāgubha, *a.* agreeable and disagreeable, agreeable or disagreeable; good and bad, good or bad, *in ethical sense*, 65¹⁹. [agubha, 1257.]

gubhāgubha-phala, *a.* having agreeable or disagreeable fruit, resulting in weal or woe.

gubhrá, *a.* beautiful; clear (of sounds). [v̄gubh, ‘adorn,’ 1188a.]

v̄gus (gósyati; -gósyá). be dry, dry up. [for *suṣ (see gaga), as shown by Avestan v̄hush, ‘dry’: cf. ašw, ‘dry’; Syraean σαυ-κός, ‘dry’; AS. seārian, ‘dry up,’ denom. of seār, Eng. sear.]

gúška, *a.* dry. [v̄gus, 1186²: see 958.]

gúšma, *m.* *-1. whistling, 73⁵, 78⁷; -2. exhalation, i.e. (fragrant) odor (of the Soma), 73¹⁰; -3. (exhalation, breath, and so, like Eng. spirit) courage, impetuosity, 82⁴.* [v̄gvas, 252, 1166.]

v̄gú or gvá or gvi (gváyati; gúśáva [786⁴]; gúná [957a]; gváyitum). swell; be greater or superior or victorious.

[orig. sense of root, ‘swell,’ but with two diverse ramifications:

*-1. negatively, ‘be swollen, i.e. hollow, empty’; cf. gúna, ‘vacuum’; κύ-αρ, ‘hole’; Lat. cavus, ‘hollow’; caelum, *cav-i-lu-m, ‘heaven’s hollow vault’; κοῖλος, ‘hollow’;*

-2. positively, ‘be swollen, i.e. full, strong’; with special reference: (a) to
