

sūrī, m. (*prop.* impeller, inciter, *i.e.*) he who engages priests to perform a sacrifice for his own benefit and pays them for it, a sacrifice-master; the same as *maghavan* (*q.v.*) and the later *yajamāna*. [ $\sqrt{2}$  *su*, ‘impel,’ 1191.]

sūrya, m. the sun, *selection xl.*; the Sun, *personified, selection xxxiii.*; sūryā, f. —1. the Sun, *personified as a female*; —2. the hymn of Sūrya’s wedding, RV. x. 85, *selection lviii.* [fr. svār (sūr), 1212a.]

sūryā-vid, a. knowing the Sūryā-hymn, RV. x. 85.

$\vee$  sṛ (sīsarti; sasāra, sasré; áśarat; sariṣyáti; sṛtā; sārtum; sṛtvā; -sṛtya; sārāyati, -te). run swiftly, glide, flow; *caus. act.* set in motion. [cf. ḏr̥-μή, ‘rush, onset, spring,’ whence ḏr̥māw, ‘rush on’; ḏλ-μα, ‘spring’; ḏλλοματ, ‘spring’; ḏλ-το, ‘leaped’; Lat. *salire*, ‘spring’; cf. *saras*, ‘pool,’ *sarit*, ‘stream,’ and, for the root with l, *sal-ila*, ‘flowing’ and ‘fluid, *i.e.* water.’]

+ a nū, run or go after.

+ a pa, go off; *caus.* remove; take out.

+ a va, go down, *in avasara*.

+ ā, run unto; run.

+ u pa, go unto, approach.

+ n is, go out; *caus.* drive out or away.

+ pra, go forth; *caus.* stretch forth or out.

+ sam, —1. flow together; —2. go about, wander, *sam intensive*, 1077b end; *esp.* wander from one existence to another (of the soul).

sṛkā, m. *perhaps* missile, lance.

sṛgālā, m. jackal.

$\vee$  sṛj (sṛjáti, -te; sasárja, sasṛjé; ásrāk-ṣit; srakṣyáti, -te; sṛṣṭā; srásṭum; sṛṣṭvā; -sṛjya; sīsṛksati). —1. let loose (from the hand), dart, hurl; throw; —2. let go, pour out (streams, rain), discharge; —3. let loose (herds); —4. spin or twist (cord or garland); —5. (discharge from one’s self, *cf.* 57<sup>1</sup>, *and so*) procreate, engender; create.

+ a va, —1. shoot off (arrows); throw or put in, 57<sup>2</sup>; —2. let loose (streams); loose (from a bond), 78<sup>19</sup>; deliver over, 84<sup>12</sup>; —3. (*like Eng. colloq.* let slide) let pass unnoticed, forgive, 78<sup>18</sup>.

+ u d, —1. cast; hurl (a bolt); —2. pour out, 103<sup>18</sup>; —3. cast off; lay down (a corpse); —4. let go, 3<sup>5</sup>.

+ s a m - u d, let go, discharge.

+ u pa, (hurl at, *and so*) plague, distress, vex; āditya upaṛṣṭas, sc. rāhuṇā, the sun vexed by Rāhu, *i.e.* eclipsed.

+ vi, —1. throw away, 105<sup>17</sup>; —2. discharge; (let go from the hand, *i.e.* lay down, 103<sup>20</sup>); *mid.*, w. vācam, let go the voice, *i.e.* break silence by saying ‘·’, 100<sup>8</sup>; —3. create, 57<sup>8</sup>, *cf.* simple verb.

+ s a m, (let go together) mix, unite.

sṛj, vbl. creating. [ $\sqrt{sṛj}$ .]

$\vee$  sṛp (sārpati, -te; sasárpa; ásrpat; sarpsyáti, srapsyáti; sṛptā; sārpitum; sṛptvā; -sṛpya; sīsṛpsati). creep, crawl; glide; used of gentle and cautious motion. [cf. ἐρπω, ‘creep, go’; Lat. *serp-ere*, ‘creep’; *repere*, \**srep-ere*, ‘creep,’ *rep-ti-lis*, ‘creeping’; AS. *sealf*, Eng. *salve*, so named from its slipperiness, like *sarpis* and *sṛpra*, see these; cf. also ἐρπ-ερδω and Lat. *serpens*, ‘snake’: no connection w. Eng. *slip*.]

+ u d, creep out or up; rise; *desid.* wish to rise.

+ u pa, go gently unto, approach gently.

+ vi, —1. move asunder, disperse; —2. move about.

sṛprā, a. slippery, fatty; smooth. [ $\sqrt{sṛp}$ , 1188a.]

1 sénā, f. a missile; weapon. [ $\sqrt{2}$  si, ‘hurl,’ 1177a.]

2 sénā, f. line of battle; acies; army. [akin with sitā, ‘furrow,’ simán, ‘parting of the hair’: from these a root \*sī, ‘draw a straight line,’ may perhaps be inferred.]

sṛṣya, a. with jealousy; -am, adv. with jealousy. [sa + īrsyā.]

$\vee$  sev (sévate; sisévā, sisévé; sevisyáti; sevitá; sévitum; sevitvā; -sévyā). —1. stay by (*loc.*, *the opp.* of *tyaj*); —2. stay by, *and so* (*like Eng.* wait upon) serve or reverence, 30<sup>17</sup>; —3. devote one’s self to; practice, 21<sup>8</sup>, 66<sup>2</sup>, 68<sup>9</sup>. [no connection w. σέβομαι, ‘reverence,’ *see*  $\sqrt{tyaj}$ .]

+ u pa, reverence; be devoted to.

+ ni, be devoted to, *i.e.* cohabit with.

+ s am, practice.
