पलव *m.* A kind of net for catching fish.

पलांडु *m. n.* An onion.

पलाप *m.* **१** The temples of an elephant; **२** a halter.

पलावन् *n.* Running away, flight, escape, Bg. xviii. 43, R. xix. 31.

पलायित *a. (f. ता)* Fled, retreated, run away.

पलाल *m. n.* Straw, husk. Comp. —**सोहस** *m.* the mango tree.

पलाली *f.* A heap of flesh.

पलाश *I m.* Name of a tree otherwise called *kins'uka*, सयः स्यतपलाशपशुपुट्टिकापात्रे प. विचकृते Sant. S. iv. 11. II. **n.** **१** A leaf, a petal; **२** the blossom of the *palas'a* tree, बालेदुवकाण्यविकाशभावादभूः प-लाशाः यतिनोहितानि K. S. III. 29; **३** the green colour.

पलाशिन् *m.* A tree.

पलिङ्गी *f.* **१** An old grey-haired woman; **२** a cow which has calved for the first time.

पलिंघ *m.* **१** A glass-vessel; **२** a wall, a rampart; **३** a cowpen; **४** an iron club. Cf. परिधि.

पलित *I a. (f. ता)* Grey, hoary, old, aged, तत्स्य मे पलितमैंनि-निरस्तकाङ्गे (शिरसि) Ve. iii. II. **n.** **१** Hoariness of the hair consequent on old age, R. xii. 2, M. vi. 2; **२** mud, mire; **३** benzoin; **४** much or ornamented hair. Comp. **पलितंकरण** *n.* rendering grey. **पलितंभविष्णु** *a.* becoming grey.

पल्लव्यन् *n.* **१** A saddle; **२** a rein, a bridle.

पल्ल *m.* A large granary.

पल्लव *m. n.* **१** A sprout, a sprig, a twig, R. i. 83, II.

पल्लि *m.* **१** 15, III. 7, Am. S. 32; **२** a bud, a blossom; **३** expansion; **४** the red dye called *alakta* q. v.; **५** strength, power; **६** a bracelet, an armlet; **७** love, amorous sport; **८** unsteadiness. Comp. —**अकुर**, आधार *m.* a branch. —**अस्त्र** *m.* an epithet of the god of love. —**द्रु** *m.* the *as'oka* tree.

पल्लवक *m.* **१** A libertine, the paramour of a harlot; **२** the *as'oka* tree; **३** a kind of fish.

पल्लिक *m.* **१** A libertine, a gallant; **२** a catamite.

पल्लित *I a. (f. ता)* **१** Sprouting, having young shoots; **२** extended; **३** dyed red with lac. II *m.* Lac-dye.

पल्लिविन् *I a. (f. नी)* Having young shoots, K. S. III. 54. II *m.* A tree.

पलि (*ली*) *f.* **१** A small village; **२** a hut, a house; **३** a city (at the end of a compound); **४** a house-lizard.

पल्लि *m.* **१** A small village; **२** a house-lizard.

पल्लि *n.* **१** A small pool, a tank, (अर्थं सरः पल्लि स्यात् Bhāvaprakāś'a), R. II. 17, III. 3, Na. I. 117. Comp. —**आवास** *m.* a tortoise. —**पंक** *m.* the mud of a pool.

पवि *I m.* **१** Wind; **२** purification. II *n.* Cow-dung.

पवन *I m.* Air, wind, R. I. 42, II. 13, Megh. I. 8, 14, Bg. x. 31. II *n.* **१** Purification; **२** winnowing; **३** a sieve, a strainer; **४** water; **५** a potter's kiln. Comp. —**आवान**, भुज् *m.* a serpent. —**आवन्ज** *m.* fire; **२** an epithet of Hanumat; **३** of Bhima. —**भास** *m.* a serpent, a snake. —**नाश** *m.* **१** an epithet of Garuda; **२** a peacock.

—**तनय**, सुत *m.* **१** an epithet of Hanumat; **२** of Bhima. —**व्यापि** *m.* **१** an epithet of Uddhava, a friend and counsellor of Krishna, प्रापयत् पवनव्याप्तेर्गत्तरपक्षताम् Sis. II. 15; **२** rheumatism.

पवान *m.* **१** Air, wind; **२** the sacred fire called *Ga'rhapatiya*.

पवाका *f.* A whirlwind, a hurricane.

पवि *m.* The thunderbolt of Indra.

पवित्र *I a. (f. ता)* Purified. II *n.* Black pepper.

पवित्रि *I a. (f. ता)* **१** Holy, sacred, sanctified, R. II. 2;

२ pure; **३** purified by the performance of religious rites. II *n.* **१** A couple of *kus'a* blades used in sprinkling ghee; **२** a ring of *kus'a* grass worn on the fourth finger on certain occasions, M. III. 235; **३** the sacred cord worn by the members of the first three Hindu castes; **४** rain; **५** copper; **६** water; **७** rubbing, cleansing; **८** a vessel in which the *arghya* is presented; **९** clarified butter; **१०** honey. Comp. —**आरोपण**, आरोहण *n.* investiture with the sacred cord. —**पाणि** *a.* holding *darbha* grass in the hand. —**धान्य** *n.* barley.

पवित्रक *n.* Thread of which nets are made.

पवात्य *a. (f. व्या)* **१** Fit or suitable for cattle, Yaj. I. 321; **२** relating to cattle; **३** possessed of cattle; **४** brutish.

पशु *m* **१** Cattle (singly and collectively), M. IX. 327; **२** an animal in general; **३** a brute, a beast; (sometimes contemptuously applied to a man, e. g. पुरुषपशोश पशोश).
