

पांचालिका *f.* A doll, a puppet, स्त्रयस्याग्रभृति समुखी देतपांचालिकेव क्रोडायोगं तदनु विनयं प्रापिता वर्धता च M. M. x. **पांचाली** *f.* 1 A woman of the *Pacha'la's*; 2 a name of Draupadi, the wife of the Pāṇavas; 3 a doll, a puppet; 4 a particular style of composition, (in rhetoric) [thus defined in S. D. वर्णे: वर्णे: (*i. e.* other than माधुर्यव्यजक and ओजःप्रकाशक) प्रुनर्दयोः। समस्तपञ्चपदो वंधः पांचालिका मता].

पाट *ind.* An interjection used in calling.

पाटक *m.* 1 A splitter, a divider; 2 part of a village; 3 loss of capital; 4 a kind of musical instrument; 5 a bank, a shore; 6 a flight of steps leading to water; 7 throwing dice.

पाटचर *m.* A thief, a robber, पश्चिनापरिमलालिपाटचरैर्गोरुः Bh. V. II. 75.

पाटन *n.* Splitting, breaking, cutting to pieces.

पाटल I *a.* (*f. ला*) Pale-red, of a pale-red colour, अत्रे भीनखपाटलं कुरबकम् Vikr. II., R. II. 29, I. 83, VII. 27. II *m.* 1 The pale-red colour, *e. g.* कपोलपाटलदेवि बभृत् रघुचेष्टितम् R. IV. 68; 2 the trumpet-flower, पाटलसंस्मिसुर्तभवनवातः Sak. I. III. n. 1 The blossom of this tree, R. XVI. 52, XIX. 46; 2 rice; 3 saffron. COMP.—**उपल** *m.* a ruby. —**इम** *m.* name of a tree. See II (2) above.

पाटला *f.* 1 The red *lodhra*; 2 the trumpet-flower, (either the tree or its blossom); 3 an epithet of Durgā.

पाटलि *f.* The trumpet-flower. COMP.—**पुत्र** *n.* name of an ancient city, the capital of Magadha, situated near the

confluence of the S'ona and the Ganges, identified with the modern Pātnā. It is also known by the name of *Pushpopura* in Sanskrit literature. See R. VI. 24, Mud. II. III.

पाटलिक *m.* A pupil.

पाटल्या *f.* A multitude of *pa'ta'la* flowers.

पाटव *n.* 1 Sharpness, acuteness; 2 cleverness, eloquence, पाटवं संस्कृतं किञ् Hit. I.; 3 quickness, rashness.

पाटविक *a.* (*f. की*) 1 Clever, skilful; 2 cunning, fraudulent.

पाटित *a.* (*f. ता*) 1 Torn, split, broken; 2 pierced, R. XI. 31.

पाटी *f.* Arithmetic. COMP.—**गणित** *n.* arithmetic.

पाटीर *m.* 1 Sandal, पाटीरं तव

पटीयाइ कः परिपात्रामिमामुरीक-
त्तेम् Bh. V. I. 12; 2 a field; 3 tin.

पाठ *m.* 1 Reciting, recitation, *e. g.* पाठदोषाभनुर्देशः; 2 reading, perusal, study; 3 one of the five daily *yajnyas*, *viz.* that of reciting the Vedas (वेदायत्ता): 4 the text of a book, a reading, a variant, *e. g.* कांशिकायां तु पंजराज-
ति क्वचित्कः पाठः। 1 अपपाठः स-
इति हरदतः. See अपपाठ. COMP.—**अंतर** *n.* another reading, a variant. —**छेद** *m.* a pause, caesura. —**रोष** *m.* a false reading. —**निश्चय** *m.* settling the text (of a passage). —**शाला** *f.* a school, a college.

पाठक *m.* 1 A teacher, a preceptor; 2 a public reader of religious or mythological books; 3 a scholar, a student. COMP.—**मंजरी**, शालिनी *f.* the *S'a'rika*' bird.

पाठन *n.* Teaching, lecturing.

पाठित *a.* (*f. ता*) Taught, instructed.

पाठीन *m.* 1 A public reader of mythological books; 2 a kind of fish, विहृतपाठीनपरा-
हतं पयः Kir. IV. 5.

पाण *m.* 1 Trade, traffic; 2 a trader; 3 an agreement, a contract; 4 praise; 5 the hand.

पाणि I *m.* The hand, R. III. 68, XI. 31. II *f.* A market. COMP.—**पाणीकरण** *n.* marriage. —**गृहीती** *f.* a wife married according to the ritual.

प्रह *m.*, प्रहन *n.* marrying, marriage, R. VII. 29, VIII. 7, K. S. VII. 4. —**प्रहीट**, प्राह *m.* a bridegroom, a husband.

बाये पितुवंशे तिष्ठेत् पाणिप्राहस्य
यौनने M. V. 148. —**घ** *m.* 1 a drummer; 2 a workman, a handcraftsman. —**घात** *m.* A blow with the hand. —**ज** *m.* a finger-nail, पाणिजराविद्रः Git. G. XXI. —**तल** *n.* the palm of the hand. —**धर्म** *m.* marriage according to the proper form. **पाणिधन**, पाणिधय *a.* blowing through the hands. —**पीड़न** *n.* marriage. **पाणीपीड़नविवेन्तरम्** K.S. VIII. 1. —**प्राणिती** *f.* a wife. —**चध** *m.* marriage. —**सुज** *m.* the sacred fig-tree. —**सुन्त** *n.* a missile thrown with the hand. —**रुह** *m.* a finger-nail. —**चाद** *m.* 1 clapping the hands together; 2 playing on a drum. —**सर्वा** *f.* rope.

पाणिनि *m.* Name of a great grammarian, the founder of that school of grammar, which goes by his name.

पाणिनीय I *a.* (*f. आ*) Relating to Panini or composed by him. II *m.* A follower of Panini, *e. g.* प्रतिशानुनासिक्यः

पाणिनीया: S. K. III *n.* The grammar of Panini.
