**विनिमय m.** १ Exchange, barter, संपादनिमयिनोनै दधनभूवन-दूयुः R. i. 26; २ a pledge, a deposit.

**विनिमेष m.** Twinkling of the eyes.

**विनेश्वरी m.** १ Entrance; २ impression.

**विनिश्चय m.** १ Ascertainment; २ resolution, decision.

**विनिष्ठास m.** Sighing, a sigh.

**विनिष्पेष m.** Grinding, bruising.

**विनिहत I a** (*f. ता*) १ Struck, wounded; २ killed. II *m.* १ An unavoidable calamity; २ a portent, a comet.

**विनीत I a.** (*f. ता*) १ Removed, taken away; २ sent away, dismissed; ३ educated, disciplined, well-behaved; ४ modest, gentle; ५ gentleman-like, decent, decorous; ६ governable, tractable; ७ tamed; ८ self-subdued; ९ lovely, handsome, (*pp.* of नी with वि *q. v.*) II *m.* १ A trained horse; २ a merchant.

**विन्ध्य m** १ Name of a range of mountains joining the northern extremities of the Western and Eastern Ghāts and separating Northern India from the Dekkan; it is one of the seven principal mountains and forms the southern boundary of A'ryāvarta, M. ii. 21, It. xi. 31; २ a hunter. COMP.—अदर्श *f.* the great Vindhya forest. —कूट, दूटन *m.* an epithet of Agastya. —वासनी *f.* an epithet of Durgā.

**विन्दा *a.* (*f. ता*)** १ Known; २ obtained, gained; ३ discussed, investigated; ४ married; ५ placed, fixed.

**विनाक m.** An epithet of Agastya.

**विन्द्यस्त *a.* (*f. स्ता*)** १ Deposited; २ inlaid; ३ laid down, put down; ४ offered, presented.
