विप्रकृति *f.* **1** Injury, offence ; **2** insult, abuse ; **3** retaliation on.
विप्रकृष्ट *a.* (*f.* ष्ट) **1** Drawn away, removed ; **2** protracted, lengthened. (Also **विप्रकृष्टक**).
विप्रतिकार *m.* **1** Contradiction, opposition ; **2** retaliation.
विप्रतिपत्ति *f.* **1** Perplexity, confusion ; **2** mutual contrariety, contest, dispute, conflict ; **3** mutual relation ; **4** dissent, objection.
विप्रतिपन्न *a.* (*f.* ज्ञा) **1** Confused, bewildered ; **2** disputed, contested ; **3** mutually connected.
विप्रतिषेध *m.* **1** The conflict of two courses of equal importance, हरिर्विप्रतिषेधं तमाचक्षे विशक्षणः Sis. ii. 6 ; **2** the conflict of two rules by which two different operations can be undertaken, (in gram.).
विप्रतिसार } *m.* **1** Anger,
विप्रतिसार } **wrath ; 2** repentance ; **3** evil, wickedness.
विप्रसुष्ट *a.* (*f.* ष्टा) **Dissolute, corrupt, vitiated.**
विप्रसृक्त *a.* (*f.* क्ता) **1** Set free, loosened, liberated ; **2** shot, discharged.
विप्रसृक्त *a.* (*f.* क्ता) **1** Separated, disunited, severed ; **2** freed from, released from ; **3** deprived of.

विप्रयोग *m.* **1** Disunion, dissociation, severance ; **2** separation (of lovers), मा भूद्वं क्षणमपि च ते विवृता विप्रयोगः Megh. ii. 52, 1.10 ; **3** quarrel, disagreement.
विप्रलब्ध *a.* (*f.* ष्या) **1** Cheated, deceived ; **2** disappointed.
विप्रलब्धा *f.* A woman disappointed by her lover's breaking his appointment, (considered as a character in drama); (S. D. thus defines her: - प्रियः कृत्यापि संकेतं यस्या नायाति संनिधिम् । विप्रलब्धेति सा ज्ञेया).
विप्रलभ *m.* **1** Deceiving, deceiving by breaking a promise ; **2** quarrel, disagreement ; **3** disunion, disjunction ; **4** separation of lovers, शुभे भियजनस्य कातरं विप्रलभपरिष्कारिणो वचः R. xix. 18 ; **5** the sentiment of love in separation, (*op.* to संभोग *q. v.*), (यूनेरयुक्तयोर्भावी युक्तयोर्वाथवा मिथः । अभीष्टालिङ्गनादान्मनशात्तौ महस्यते । स विप्रलभो विज्ञेयः).
विप्रलभ *m.* **1** Idle discourse, nonsense ; **2** contradiction, contradictory speech ; **3** infraction of a promise.
विप्रलय *m.* Annihilation, dissolution, destruction, प्रलयश्च विवर्तनां कापि विप्रलयः कृतः Ut. vi.
विप्रलप्त *a.* (*f.* ता) **1** Snatched away, carried away ; **2** disturbed, interrupted.
विप्रलोभिन् *m.* The *As'oka* tree.
विप्रवास *m.* Residence in a foreign country, staying abroad.
विप्रसिका *f.* A female fortune-teller.
विप्रहीण *a.* (*f.* णा) Deprived of, destitute of.
विप्रिय **1** *a.* (*f.* या) Unpleasant, disagreeable, distasteful. **II n.** Offence, कृतवानसि विप्रियं न

मे प्रतिक्लं न च ते मया कृतम् K. S. iv. 7, R viii. 52.
विप्रुष . **1** A drop (of water or any other liquid), द्विषद्द्वेषोपरकांगसंगिनीः त्वेदविप्रुषः Sis. ii. 18, viii. 40 ; **2** a mark, a spot, a dot.
विप्रोषित *a.* (*f.* ता) Dwelling abroad, absent, banished, विप्रोषितकुमारं तद्वाज्यमस्तमितेधरम् R. xii. 11. **Comp.** — **भर्तृका** *f.* a woman whose husband is away from home.
विप्रव *m.* **1** Floating about, floating in different directions ; **2** confusion, perplexity ; **3** disturbance, scuffle ; **4** sin, wickedness ; **5** loss, destruction, प्रतियोजयितव्यवहृत्कीसमवस्थामथ सन्वाविभवात् R. viii. 41 ; **6** deluging ; **7** evil, calamity ; **8** danger from an enemy ; **9** the rust (of a mirror), अपवर्जितविश्वे शुचौ मतिरादसौ इवाभिरुदयते Kir. ii. 26.
विघ्राव *m.* **1** A horse's gallop ; **2** deluging, inundating.
विधुत *a.* (*f.* ता) **1** Disturbed, confounded ; **2** ruined, disgraced, dishonoured ; **3** disappeared ; **4** ravaged, devastated ; **5** drowned, deluged ; **6** disfigured, obscured ; **7** dissolute, guilty of lewdness, (*pp.* of शु with वि *q. v.*).
विधुष *f.* The same as विप्रुष *q. v.*
विफल *a.* (*f.* ला) Fruitless, useless, vain, ineffectual, विफलत्वमेति बहुसाधनता Sis. ix. 6, K. S. vii. 66, Megh. ii. 5.
विबन्ध *m.* Constipation.
विबाधा *f.* Pain, agony, anguish.
विबुद्ध *a.* (*f.* द्धा) **1** Aroused, awakened, wide awake ; **2** blossomed, expanded ; **3** clever, skilful.
