शमनी *f.* Night. COMP.—शर *m.* a demon, a goblin.

शमल *n.* १ Feces, ordure; २ sin, impurity.

शमित *a.* (*f.* शा) १ Appeased, calm, pacified; २ alleviated, relieved, cured; ३ relaxed.

शमित्र *a.* (*f.* नी) १ Calm, tranquil, pacific; २ one who has subdued his senses, Bt. VII. 5.

शमी (*f.*) *f.* १ Name of a tree, अभिगमी शमीमिष Sak. IV., Yaj. I. 302; २ a legume, a pod. COMP.—शर्म *m.* १ an epithet of fire; २ a Brahmana of the sacerdotal order. —धान्य *n.* any podded grain. शमा (*f.*) *m.* A small variety of the 's'ami' tree.

शंपा *f.* Lightning.

शह *vt.* 1. P (*pres.* शंबति) To go, to move.

शंब *I a.* (*f.* शा) १ Poor, indigent; २ happy, fortunate. II *m.* १ Indra's thunderbolt; २ the iron head of a pestle; ३ an iron chain worn round the loins; ४ ploughing in the ordinary direction. (शंबाकु 'to plough twice'.)

शंब (श) *m.* १ Name of a demon killed by Pradyumna; २ a mountain; ३ a sort of deer; ४ war. II *n.* १ Wealth; २ water; ३ religious observance. COMP.—अरि, सूहन *m.* an epithet of the god of love.—अस्त्र *m.* the demon S'ambara. शंतिर् *m.* an epithet of the god of love.

शंचि *f.* Illusion, jugglery.

शंबल *m. n.* १ A bank, a shore; २ provision for a journey, viaticum; ३ envy, jealousy.

शंकूक *m.* १ A bivalve shell; २ a snail; ३ name of a S'u'dra who practised penance contrary to the duties of his caste and was slain by Rāma; See Ut. II.; ४ the frontal protuberance of an elephant.

शंभ *m.* १ A happy man; २ Indra's thunderbolt.

शंभली *f.* A bawd, a procuress.

शंस्या *f.* १ A wooden stick; २ the pin of a yoke; ३ a sacrificial vessel.

शंश *! a.* (*f.* या or यी) (generally at the end of a compound) Lying down, sleeping, e.g. उतानश्य, दिवाश्य. II *m.* १ Sleep; २ a snake; ३ a bed, a couch; ४ abuse, imprecation; ५ a hand.

शंशय *m.* १ Death; २ a boar; ३ a fish; ४ a sort of snake.

शंशन *n.* १ Sleeping, sleep; २ a bed, a couch, R. I. 95, M. VI. 40; ३ copulation. COMP.—अगर *m. n.* शूरु *n.* a bed-chamber.—एकाशशा *f.* the eleventh day of the first half of A'sha'-dha when Vishnu sleeps. —सखी *f.* a bed-fellow. —स्थान *n.* a sleeping-apartment.
